The Holy Cross men's basketball team returns home this weekend to face Siena on Saturday, Dec. 11, at 2:00 p.m. The contest between the Crusaders and the Saints will be televised live by NBC Sports Boston, and can be seen online through the Patriot League on ESPN+.

The Holy Cross Varsity Club will be formally inducting its Classes of 2020 and 2021 this weekend, and the 11 honorees will be recognized at halftime of Saturday's game. Included among the inductees are former men's basketball coach **Ralph Willard** and standout guard **Jave Meade**.

Holy Cross enters the Siena game with an overall record of 2-8 on the year. The Crusaders are coming off a 74-59 setback at Fairfield on Wednesday and will be looking to snap a four-game losing streak. Holy Cross currently leads the Patriot League in blocked shots (4.2 blocks per game), while standing second in three-point field goal percentage (37.7 percent) and fourth in steals (6.9 steals per game).

Freshman guard **Kyrell Luc** has led the Crusaders by averaging 12.4 points, 3.2 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game, while hitting 46.4 percent (13 of 28) of his attempts from three-point range. Sophomore guard **Judson Martindale** has also been playing well, with averages of 11.8 points and 4.5 rebounds per contest. In addition, senior forward **Gerrale Gates** has averaged 11.0 points and 7.4 boards per game.

Siena currently has a 3-6 overall record this season, with a 1-1 mark in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. The Saints are coming off a 60-58 victory at St. Peter's on Sunday. Junior guard Colby Rogers has led the team by averaging 13.9 points per game while hitting 42.6 percent (26 of 61) of his shots from beyond the three-point arc. Senior forward Jackson Stormo is also off to a strong start this season, averaging 10.8 points and 7.1 rebounds per contest.

After the game with Siena, Holy Cross will take a week off for finals before returning to action at Harvard on Sunday, Dec. 19, at 2:00 p.m.

**LUC STARTS COLLEGIATE CAREER STRONG:** Freshman guard **Kyrell Luc** has made an immediate impact in the Holy Cross backcourt this season. In 10 games played, he is averaging 12.4 points, 3.2 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.2 steals per contest, while hitting 46.4 percent (13 of 28) of his three-point attempts. During the Fairfield game, Luc led the team with 16 points and two steals. Previously at Central Connecticut, he tallied 11 points, two rebounds and two steals. Luc also played well against New Hampshire, recording 11 points, six rebounds and two steals. A few of his other top games this season have been against Bryant (18 points, six rebounds, three assists), at Boston College (18 points, three assists, two rebounds), against Air Force (15 points, four rebounds) and at Quinnipiac (14 points, five rebounds, two assists). Luc came to Holy Cross from the Brimmer and May School in Chestnut Hill, Mass., where he was named the New England Preparatory School Athletic Council Class AA Player of the Year in 2019-2020.

**THE SERIES WITH SIENA:** This will be the 17th meeting between the Crusaders and the Saints on the hardwood, with Siena leading the all-time series 10-6. Holy Cross has won two of the last three games in the series, but Siena came out on top in seven of previous eight meetings. The schools first played on Feb. 6, 1990, with Holy Cross winning 103-76 at the Hart Center.

**GATES LOOKS TO BUILD OFF STRONG SEASON:** Senior forward **Gerrale Gates** is once again among the top players in the Patriot League this year. In seven games played so far this season, Gates is averaging 11.0 points and 7.4 rebounds per contest with three double-doubles. During the La Salle game, he totaled 10 points and a season-best 12 rebounds. Previously at Central Connecticut, Gates posted 16 points and 11 boards. He also had 18 points and 11 rebounds against Mount St. Vincent, while recording 14 points and eight rebounds against Air Force. In 2020-2021, Gates earned third team All-Patriot League honors during his first season in a Holy Cross uniform. In 14 games played a year ago, he averaged a team-best 16.4 points and 7.6 rebounds per contest, while hitting 47.6 percent of his field goal attempts and 74.3 percent of his free throws. Some of Gates' top performances last season came against Lehigh on Jan. 24 (27 points, four rebounds), against Colgate on Jan. 30 (24 points, 11 rebounds), against Lehigh on Jan. 23 (23 points, 10 rebounds) and at Colgate on Jan. 17 (22 points, 11 rebounds). During his time with the Crusaders, he has now totaled 307 points, 159 rebounds, 34 assists, 14 steals and 12 blocked shots. Gates came to Holy Cross after playing two seasons at the University of New Orleans, where he was named the 2019 Southland Conference Freshman of the Year. In his entire collegiate career, he has recorded 819 points, 480 rebounds and 43 blocked shots.

### FAIRFIELD RECAP

Kyrell Luc scored a game-high 16 points, but the Crusaders were defeated by Fairfield 74-59 at Webster Bank Arena on Dec. 8, 2021. Holy Cross made 45.8 percent of its field goal attempts on the night, but only connected on 38.1 percent of its shots in the second half. Fairfield hit 52.6 percent of its shots from the floor while holding a 36-23 rebounding advantage. The Stags started the game hot, jumping out to a quick 10-2 lead after the first three minutes of action. The Crusaders scored the next five points to close the gap, and later trailed 28-25 with five minutes remaining before the break. Holy Cross then closed out the half with an 8-0 run to take a 33-28 advantage into the locker room. The Crusaders were able to extend their lead to six points (38-32) early in the second half, and still led by four (46-42) with 11:55 left to play. Fairfield scored the next eight points to pull back in front, and later held a 54-50 edge with 7:45 on the clock. The Stags then used an 11-0 run to take control, and would lead by at last 13 points the rest of the way. Bo Montgomery finished the game with 13 points and two rebounds. Allan Jeanne-Rose led Fairfield with 15 points and two blocked shots.

**HOLY CROSS KNOCKS DOWN THREE-POINTERS:** The Crusaders have been a solid three-point shooting team this year, hitting 69 of 183 attempts (37.7 percent) from three-point range. Against Mount St. Vincent, Holy Cross knocked down a season-best 14 three-pointers on 31 attempts (45.2 percent). The Crusaders also hit 10 of 22 three-point shots (45.5 percent) at Quinnipiac. Last year, Holy Cross made 35.4 percent (111 of 314) of its shots from behind the arc. The Crusaders' hit a season-high 52.9 percent of their three-point shots against Boston University of Feb. 13, while knocking down a season-best 11 treys against Army on both Jan. 9 and Jan. 10.

**MARTINDALE MAKES AN IMPACT ON THE WING:** Sophomore guard **Judson Martindale** is once again a key player for the Crusaders on the perimeter. On the year, he is averaging 11.8 points and 4.5 rebounds per contest while knocking down 40.9 percent (18 of 44) of his three-point attempts. During the Central Connecticut game, Martindale led the team with 22 points, four rebounds and three assists. Previously against Mount St. Vincent, he recorded 21 points, five rebounds and three steals. A few of Martindale's other top games have come against Regis (career-high 24 points, four rebounds), Bryant (15 points, career-best nine rebounds, two blocks) and Quinnipiac (15 points, six rebounds, two steals). Last season, he averaged 6.2 points and 2.1 rebounds per contest, while connecting on 40.0 percent of his shots from three-point range. Martindale's top game in 2020-2021 came on Feb. 24 at Boston U., when he totaled 21 points and six rebounds. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has now totaled 217 points, 78 rebounds and 25 steals with a .404 three-point field goal percentage (38 of 94).

**HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS:** Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 393-188 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, with a 2-1 mark so far this year. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-07 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 37 out of 45 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 180-95 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 116-61 record against Patriot League foes.

Joe Pridgen totaled 17 points and nine rebounds, but the Crusaders were defeated by Siena 74-62 at the Times Union Center on Dec. 29, 2019. Holy Cross made 47.3 percent of its field goal attempts on the afternoon, but connected on just 33.3 percent of its shots in the second half. Siena knocked down 53.7 percent of its attempts from the floor while committing just nine turnovers. The Crusaders opened the game by jumping out to an early 9-5 lead after the first 3:34 of action. Holy Cross was still up by one (21-20) with 8:58 left before the break, when the Saints went on a 12-2 run to pull in front. Siena eventually led 45-37 heading into the locker room at half-time. The Saints remained in front early in the second half, and were up 55-44 with 10 minutes remaining in regulation. The Crusaders then scored seven straight points to close to within four (55-51), and were later down by just five (63-58) with 2:40 left to play. But Siena scored the next six points to take control, and went on to post a 12-point victory. Connor Niego finished the day with 12 points and two rebounds, while junior guard added 11 points, four assists and three rebounds. Donald Carey led the Saints with 22 points and four assists.

**CRUSADERS AGAINST THE METRO ATLANTIC ATHLETIC CONFERENCE:** Holy Cross has an all-time record of 109-88 against the 11 schools which currently compete in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. Over the last eight years, the Crusaders are 7-9 against MAAC foes. Holy Cross stands 14-7 all-time against Canisius, 22-21 vs. Fairfield, 16-16 against Iona, 21-10 vs. Manhattan, 5-2 against Marist, 0-1 vs. Monmouth, 8-7 against Niagara, 3-2 vs. Quinnipiac, 14-13 against St. Peter's and 6-9 vs. Siena. The Crusaders played in the MAAC for seven seasons from 1983-1990, posting a 52-48 record in conference action. Holy Cross' top season in the league came in 1989-1990, when it recorded a 14-2 mark to win the MAAC North Division title.

**SWATTING THINGS AWAY:** The Crusaders have been an excellent shot blocking team this season, averaging 4.2 blocked shots per contest. Holy Cross has blocked at least three shots in nine of 10 games, with a high of eight blocks at Quinnipiac on Nov. 15. The Crusaders also blocked seven shots against Mount St. Vincent, while totaling five blocks in the Bryant game. Sophomore guard Judson Martindale leads the team with nine blocks this year, followed closely by sophomore forward **Louth-M Coulibaly** and freshman forward **Caleb Kenney** with eight blocks each.

### MONTGOMERY MAKES PRESENCE FELT IN BACK COURT:

Sophomore guard **Bo Montgomery** has developed into one of Holy Cross' top players in the back court. Overall this season, he is averaging 7.9 points, 2.1 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game. During the Fairfield game, Montgomery scored 13 points on five of eight shooting from the field. Previously against Mount St. Vincent, he posted 14 points, four assists and three steals. A few of Montgomery's other top performances came against Regis (career-high 19 points, three rebounds, three steals) and Quinnipiac (11 points, three rebounds). Last season, he played in all 16 games for the Crusaders, starting four times and averaging 4.3 points and 1.3 assists per contest. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Montgomery has now totaled 147 points, 39 rebounds, 35 assists and 23 steals.

**STEALING THE SHOW:** Holy Cross has totaled 69 steals during its first nine games this year, good for an average of 6.9 steals per contest. The Crusaders recorded a season-best 13 steals against Mount St. Vincent, while totaling 10 steals against Regis. Last year, the Crusaders ranked fourth in the Patriot League with an average of 6.9 steals per game. In 2020-2021, the Crusaders recorded a season-high 17 steals against Army on Feb. 21, after previously totaling 11 steals against Boston University (Jan. 4) and 10 steals at Army (Jan. 10). The 17 steals against the Black Knights were Holy Cross' most in a single game since it had 18 steals against Iona on Jan. 18, 2005.

**JOHNSON RETURNS AT THE POINT:** Sophomore guard **R.J. Johnson** looks to once again play a key role at point guard this year. In five games played this season, he has averaged 8.2 points, 1.6 assists and 1.6 steals per contest. During the La Salle game, Johnson posted 10 points, three rebounds and two assists. He previously recorded 10 points, three rebounds and two steals at Central Connecticut, while totaling 10 points and two steals against New Hampshire. During the 2020-2021 campaign, Johnson was selected to the Patriot League All-Rookie team after averaging 8.5 points and a team-best 4.3 assists per contest, while connecting on 89.5 percent of his free throws and 34.1 percent of his three-pointers. During last season's game against Lehigh on Jan. 23, he scored 17 points and handed out eight assists. A few of Johnson's other top games in 2020-2021 came at Boston University of Feb. 24 (14 points), against Colgate on Jan. 30 (13 points), against Boston University on Feb. 17 (12 points, six assists, three steals), at Boston University on Feb. 14 (12 points, two assists) and against Colgate on Jan. 31 (12 points, four assists). During his Holy Cross career, Johnson has now totaled 177 points, 77 assists, 31 rebounds and 19 steals.

**HOLY CROSS PICKED NINTH IN PRESEASON POLL:** In the 2021-2022 Patriot League preseason poll, Holy Cross was picked to finish in ninth place in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors. Boston University placed first in the poll with 154 total points and 11 first-place votes, followed by Colgate in second with 153 points and nine first-place votes. Navy placed third with 113 points, while Army West Point was fourth with 89 points and American came in fifth with 79 points. **TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE:** This year marks the 103rd season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,428-1,053, while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 11 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

**HUMPHREY RETURNS TO BACKCOURT:** Sophomore guard **DáJion Humphrey** has been a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt rotation this season. In eight games played, he is averaging 7.1 points and 1.5 rebounds per contest, while hitting 36.7 percent (11 of 30) of his three-point field goal attempts. During the New Hampshire game, Humphrey scored a career-high 13 points. He previously totaled 12 points, two assists and two steals against Bryant, while posting 12 points, five rebounds and three blocked shots at Quinnipiac. During the 2020-2021 campaign, Humphrey saw action in all 16 contests and averaged 3.4 points per game. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has now totaled 111 points, 19 rebounds, 12 steals and nine assists.

**CRUSADERS LOOKING FOR SIXTH PATRIOT LEAGUE REGULAR SEASON TITLE:** During the 2021-2022 campaign, Holy Cross will attempt to win the Patriot League regular season title for the sixth time in school history. The last championship for the Crusaders came in 2006-2007, when they tied for first place in the conference with Bucknell, as both teams posted 13-1 records in league play. Prior to that, Holy Cross won outright Patriot League regular season titles in 2000-2001, 2002-2003 and 2004-2005, while sharing the regular season championship in 1993-1994. The Crusaders' five total championships are tied for the third-most in conference history with Colgate (one outright, four shared), behind only Bucknell (nine outright, four shared) and Navy (two outright, four shared).

**DRIBBLES:** This year marks the 75th anniversary of the 1946-1947 season, when the Holy Cross men's basketball team won the NCAA Championship ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2011 through 2014, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 99 percent, tied for the best mark among all Division I schools ... Senior guard **Malcolm Townsel** came off the bench to score a career-best 15 points at Boston College, then had 12 points at Quinnipiac. On the season, he is averaging 6.7 points per game ... Sophomore forward **Louth-M Coulibaly** totaled 10 points and seven rebounds during the Air Force game, then blocked five shots against Mount St. Vincent. On the season, he is averaging 3.6 points, 4.4 boards and 0.9 blocks per contest ... Freshman forward **Caleb Kenney** scored 11 points and pulled down nine rebounds during the Mount St. Vincent game. He is now averaging 4.2 points and 4.9 rebounds per game ... Freshman forward **Austin Lewis** posted a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds during the season opener against Regis. He became the first Crusader to record a double-double in his collegiate debut in at least 34 years ... Senior guard **Malcolm Townsel** was named to the 2020-2021 National Basketball Coaches Association Honors Court. The team consisted of juniors and seniors with a cumulative grade point average of 3.2 or higher ... In October, Holy Cross added William Doherty as the newest member of its program. William came to Holy Cross through a partnership with Team IMPACT, whose mission is to improve the quality of life for children facing life-threatening and chronic illnesses through the power of team.
