Stat Leaders

The Holy Cross women's basketball team is set for three games in five days against Boston University, beginning on Wednesday, Feb. 17 at 6 p.m. in Boston.

The Crusaders will return home for their Senior Day contest on Saturday, Feb. 20 at 1 p.m., and then travel to Boston for a 2 p.m. tipoff on Sunday.

All three games will be broadcasted live on ESPN+.

HOLY CROSS NOTES:

- In Holy Cross' most recent contest, the Crusaders pulled away in the second half for a 61-40 victory over Colgate on Saturday, Feb. 13.
- The Crusaders held the Raiders to just 12 points in the second half to earn their third victory this season by a margin of 20 or more points. Of the Crusaders' six wins this season, five have come by a double-digit margin.
- Holy Cross posted season highs in blocks (5), assists (17), 3-pointers made (10) and 3-point percentage (.455) in the win, while also holding Colgate to the fewest points by a Holy Cross opponent this year.
- Four Crusaders finished in double figures in the win over Colgate, led by freshman Bronagh-Power Cassidy, who had 13 points and was named the Patriot League Rookie of the Week for the second consecutive week and third time this season. Juniors Avery LaBarbera (12 points), Oluchi Ezemma (10 points) and Madison Demski (10 points) also hit double digits, with Demski matching her career high.
- Prior to Saturday's contest, Holy Cross will recognize senior center Shannon Murphy as part of Senior Day.
- Holy Cross continues to lead the Patriot League in offensive rebounding, averaging 12.7 per game. Ezemma ranks first in the league and 24th nationally with an average of 3.9 offensive re-

bounds per game; Ezemma also ranks third in the Patriot League with an average of 8.3 rebounds per contest.

- Eight different Crusaders have recorded double figures in at least one game this season, led by eight double-figure performances from LaBarbera.

LAST TIME THEY MET:

- In the opening series of the 2021 season, Boston University came out on top in both games; the Terriers won 76-54 in Boston on Jan. 4 before earning a 72-56 win on Jan. 5.
- Freshman Cara McCormack hit double figures in both games, with 11 points in the opener and 18 points – including four 3-pointers – in the Jan. 5 contest.
- Nelson led the way for the Terriers in that series, recording a total of 37 points between the two games.

OPENING ARMY SERIES:

- The Crusaders swept Army West Point in a historic weekend series, earning an 80-46 victory on Saturday, Jan. 9 at West Point and a 61-42 win on Sunday, Jan. 10 in Worcester.
- The 80-46 victory, in which five Crusaders scored in double figures, marked Holy Cross head coach Maureen Magarity's first win with the program; Magarity also emerged victorious in the first father-daughter head coaching matchup in Division I history.
- The 34-point win was the largest margin of victory by Holy Cross since the 2011 season, when the Crusaders recorded an 83-46 win against Lafayette on Feb. 5.
- Army's 25 turnovers on Saturday

were the most that Holy Cross has forced in a single game since Feb. 1, 2017, when they forced 27 against Colgate.

2019-20 IN REVIEW:

- Holy Cross posted a 19-11 overall record with an 11-7 mark in Patriot League play to finish tied for third in the Patriot League standings. As a result, the Crusaders hosted a Patriot League quarterfinal match-up for the first time since 2015.
- The Crusaders' 19 wins were their most in a single season since 2013-14.
- Senior Lauren Manis, the leading scorer in the Patriot League, earned her third All-Patriot League first team selection and fourth overall all-league selection, and was additionally an All-Defensive Team selection.
- Then-sophomore Avery LaBarbera earned second team honors from the Patriot League, her second straight all-league selection after receiving third team and Rookie of the Year honors in 2018-19.
- As a team, Holy Cross led the Patriot League in rebounding, with an average of 40 boards per game, while out-rebounding its opponents by a +5.7 margin. The Crusaders ranked third in the league in offense, with an average of 64.9 points per game, while also ranking second in 3-point percentage (.360).
- Manis (first, 18.6 points per game) and LaBarbera (fifth, 13.7 points per game) both ranked in the top five in scoring in the Patriot League.
- During the regular season, Holy Cross had players lead the Patriot

League in points per game (Manis), field-goal percentage (senior Megan Swords, .545), assists (senior Madalyn Smith, 138), free throw percentage (LaBarbera, .827) and 3-point percentage (Manis, .446).

- The Crusaders closed out their season on a four-game winning streak; their final game of the year was a 52-33 Patriot League quarterfinal victory over Lafayette on March 9. The Patriot League Tournament was canceled on March 12 due to COVID-19 concerns; Holy Cross had been scheduled to face top-seeded Bucknell in Lewisburg, Pa., in a semifinal matchup that evening.

BU AT A GLANCE:

- BU posted a pair of victories against Army West Point over the weekend, recording an 82-41 win on Saturday and a 65-53 win on Sunday, Feb. 14. Maggie Pina led the Terriers with a 15-point and 11-point performance in the two games, respectively.
- After not playing any games from Jan. 18 until Feb. 6, the Terriers are undefeated in their last three games. BU's lone loss this season came back on Jan. 17 against Army.
- The Terriers boast the league's best defense, holding their opponents to an average of just 50.9 points per game. BU also leads the Patriot League with a .464 field goal percentage as a team while also averaging a conference-best 9.2 steals per game.
- Katie Nelson leads the Patriot League with an average of 4.8 assists per contest and a 2.5 assist-to-turnover ratio.

SCHEDULE NOTES:

- Consistent with the prioritization of health and safety, the 2020-21 schedule format features a significant reduction in travel and

overnight stays. No teams will be permitted to fly to games. Instead of the league's traditional double round-robin format, teams will play an increased number of games against league opponents in closer geographic proximity.

- As a result, Holy Cross' regular season schedule includes just 16 games and four different opponents this year. The Crusaders are part of the North mini-conference in the Patriot League, along with Army West Point, Boston University and Colgate.
- The 2021 Patriot League Tournament is scheduled to include the top eight teams in the conference.

KEY RETURNERS:

- Poised to make the biggest impact for Holy Cross in 2020-21 will be a core group of four juniors, a quartet recently named team captains.
- Preseason All-Patriot League and two-time All-Patriot League selection Avery LaBarbera will surely draw the most attention from fans and opposing defenses. Last year, LaBarbera ranked fifth in the Patriot League in scoring with 13.7 points per game, the second most among all returning players in the conference. She led the conference in free throw percentage (.827) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1), ranking 42nd in Division I in the latter.
- Forward Oluchi Ezemma, after two seasons in a key sixth man role, will look to take on an even larger role during her junior season. In her first two seasons, she has averaged 5.7 points and 5.4 boards in 18.7 minutes per contest.
- Guard Kelly Petro has appeared in only 21 career games through her first two seasons, but is set to see a significant increase in playing time as a junior. On numerous occasions as a sophomore, Petro provided a

much-needed spark off the bench – including being credited as the key to the Crusaders' turnaround in a historic comeback against Lehigh on Feb. 12. With Holy Cross trailing by 24 points with 4:37 left in the third quarter, Petro entered the game and recorded a plus-11 rating to help guide the Crusaders to a 65-62 victory – the fifth-largest comeback in NCAA history.

- Forward Madison Demski will look to embrace a larger role this year after missing the 2019-20 season with injury. In 21 games as a freshman in 2018-19, Demski recorded 51 points, including 12 3-pointers, and 29 rebounds.

- Beyond the junior class, there is an opportunity for other Crusaders to step up and contribute. Senior center Shannon Murphy will provide key depth and height for the Crusaders.

- Sophomore guard Addisyn Cross appeared in 28 games off the bench during her freshman campaign, while her classmate, guard Kerry Flaherty, played in 10 contests in 2019-20.

KEY LOSSES:

- Forward Lauren Manis, one of the greatest players in school and Patriot League history, is the most notable graduate from last year's team. A four-time All-Patriot League selection, Manis is the first player in Holy Cross history, men's or women's, to record more than 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds, and became the first WNBA Draft selection in school history back in April. She was one of just three Division I players in 2020 with 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds.

- Center Megan Swords led the Patriot League with a field goal percentage of .538 while averaging 11.2 points and 7.4 rebounds per game.

- Guard Madalyn Smith started all 61 games of her junior and senior season, and led the Patriot League with 144 assists in 2019-20.

- Kathryn Pedi started 24 games for the Crusaders, and ranks fifth in program history in career 3-point percentage (.384).

- Nicole Morris appeared in 117 career games, providing a strong defensive presence for Holy Cross.

NEWCOMERS:

- Holy Cross welcomes four freshmen in 2020-21: forward Janelle Allen, guard Steph Davis, guard Cara McCormack and guard Bronagh Power-Cassidy.

- Allen played three varsity seasons at Marian Central Catholic in Illinois, recording over 1,000 career points and earning first team all-region honors in 2018-19 and 2019-20.

- Davis played four varsity seasons at Proctor Academy in Andover, N.H., and was a two-time NEPSAC All-Star (2017-18, 2018-19).

- McCormack played four varsity seasons at St. John the Baptist in West Islip, N.Y., where she was a four-time All-League honoree in Catholic League A and two-time league Player of the Year.

- Power-Cassidy, a Dublin, Ireland native, played one season with Marianapolis Prep in Thompson, Conn., after competing with the Irish National Team in FIBA European Championship in U16 B in 2016, U18 B in 2017, U18 A in 2018 and U20 A in 2020.

LABARBERA:

- LaBarbera was announced as a Preseason All-Patriot League selection on Dec. 28.

- Last season, LaBarbera ranked fifth in the Patriot League in scoring with 13.7 points per game, the second-most among all returning players in the conference. She led the conference in free throw percentage (.827) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1), ranking 42nd in Division I in the latter. Additionally, she ranked third in the Patriot League in 3-pointers made (70) and average minutes played (34.8).

- LaBarbera is the Crusaders' leading returner in minutes played, points per game, field goal percentage (.397), 3-point percentage (.365), free throw percentage, assists (101) and steals (40).

- In two seasons with the Crusaders, LaBarbera has recorded 895 points in 72 career games. She was named the Patriot League Rookie of the Year and to the All-Patriot League third team in 2018-19, and to the All-Patriot League second team in 2019-20.

MAGARITY:

- Maureen Magarity became the head coach of the Crusaders on April 14. Magarity brings a combined 21 years of Division I playing and coaching experience to The Hill, and served as the head coach of the University of New Hampshire from 2010-2020.

• The 2017 Kay Yow National Coach of the Year, she recorded 146 wins during her tenure in Durham – the second most by a head coach in program history.

COACHING STAFF:

- Joining Magarity's coaching staff is her former player at the University of New Hampshire, Kat Fogarty, an All-America East selection in 2017 who spent the 2019-20 season as the director of basketball operations for the University of Vermont.
- John McCray also arrives in Worcester as an assistant coach after a three-year stint as an assistant at the University of Florida.
- Assistant coach and recruiting coordinator Clare Fitzpatrick returns for her second season as a member of the Holy Cross staff.

HOME SWEET HOME:

- After posting an 11-3 record at home in 2019-20, the Crusaders have won 28 of their last 36 games at the Hart Center.
- The Crusaders are 4-1 at home in 2021.
- Holy Cross went undefeated in non-conference home play in 2019-20.
- The Crusaders' lone home losses in 2019-20 came vs. Bucknell on Jan. 11, BU on Feb. 8 and Colgate on Feb. 22.
- Holy Cross has now won its last three home openers. Prior to the win on Nov. 13, 2019 against BC, Holy Cross posted a 71-61 result against Rider on Nov. 11, 2018 and a 59-57 overtime victory over Bryant on Nov. 26, 2017.
- LaBarbera has averaged 17 points per game in her first two home openers.
- The Crusaders went 11-4 at home in 2018-19.

PRESEASON POLL:

- Holy Cross was selected to finish ninth in the Patriot League in a pre-season coaches' poll released Dec. 28.
- Bucknell took the top spot in the coaches' poll, earning 15 first-place votes and 160 points. Boston University was second, with five first-place votes and 145 points.
- The remaining teams in the Patriot League were ranked as follows: Lafayette (121), Lehigh (112), American (91), Colgate (69), Loyola Maryland (62), Army West Point (59), Holy Cross (58) and Navy (24).
- Lafayette's Natalie Kucowski was named the Patriot League Preseason

Player of the Year. Joining Kucowski on the Preseason All-Patriot League team were LaBarbera, Nelson, Bucknell's Abby Kapp and American's Jade Edwards.

MAUREEN MAGARITY

Head Coach • 1st Season

Holy Cross Director of Athletics Marcus Blossom is pleased to introduce Maureen Magarity as the next head coach of the Crusader women's basketball program for the upcoming 2020-21 season. Magarity, who arrives on Mount St. James after spending the last 10 years leading the program at the University of New Hampshire, becomes the seventh head coach in program history.

"I'm excited to welcome Coach Magarity and her two daughters, Charlotte and Caroline, to the Holy Cross family," said Blossom. "Maureen is a highly respected teacher, mentor and coach who is committed to the athletic, academic and overall personal development of our women's basketball student-athletes. She has won championships as a student-athlete, assistant coach and head coach, and we look forward to competing for and winning Patriot League championships under her leadership."

Magarity brings a combined 21 years of Division I playing and coaching experience to The Hill, and has served as the head coach of the University of New Hampshire since 2010. The 2017 Kay Yow National Coach of the Year, she recorded 146 wins during her tenure in Durham – the second most by a head coach in program history.

"I'm extremely honored to be the next head women's basketball coach at Holy Cross," said Magarity. "I'm grateful for this incredible opportunity to lead these amazing young women and am excited to build relationships within the community and with the alumni that love this program."

The architect of a program-changing turnaround in Durham, Magarity made an instant impact upon arriving at UNH, posting winning records in three of her first five seasons and leading the Wildcats to the program's first winning season since 2005-06. She would go on to take a program that won just 33 games in the four years prior to her arrival and guide it to a 93-60 record from 2013-18, including a combined 45 wins from 2016-18, the most victories in a two-year span in UNH's history.

In 2016-17, Magarity led UNH to a 26-6 record en route to an America East regular-season title, also marking the program's first 20-win season in more than 33 years and the second-biggest turnaround in Division I that season. The Wildcats recorded a school-record 13 consecutive victories and won 19 of their final 20 regular-season games on their way to the program's first title since 1985. For its efforts, the team was awarded its first WNIT berth since 1999. Magarity, in addition to being named the Kay Yow National Coach of the Year, earned 2017 America East Coach of the Year honors, and was a finalist for the WBCA National Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 season also saw great success, with the team going 19-12 overall. Both the Class of 2017 and the Class of 2018 posted 74-48 career records, marking the winningest senior classes in program history. In total, Magarity saw 18 all-conference selections in her time at the helm in Durham, including the 2017 America East Player of the Year (Carlie Pogue) and 2019 America East Rookie of the Year (Kari Brekke).

Magarity is no stranger to the Patriot League, having spent four seasons on the coaching staff at Army West Point from 2006-10, including the 2009-10 season as associate head coach. In Magarity's four seasons at West Point, the Black Knights posted an overall record of 72-48, including a program-best 24-win campaign during the 2006-07 season. The Black Knights averaged 20 wins in each of her first three seasons on the staff, the best three-year span in program history.

Her coaching career began at Marist, where she was an assistant during the 2004-05 season. That season, the Red Foxes finished with a 22-7 record, the most wins in program history, and earned the regular-season MAAC title. Before joining the Army staff, Magarity also spent one season as an assistant at Fairfield.

Magarity played three seasons at Marist from 2001-04, serving as team captain her junior and senior seasons and leading the Red Foxes to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2004. She garnered two All-MAAC Second Team selections and was a 2004 MAAC All-Tournament Team honoree. She earned two MAAC Scholar-Athlete awards (2002, 2004) and received the James Pizzani Award for dedication and loyalty as a senior. Magarity began her collegiate playing career in 1999-00 at Boston College, where the Eagles reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Magarity earned a B.A. in communications and public relations from Marist in 2003 before earning her Master's degree in public administration while at Marist in 2005.

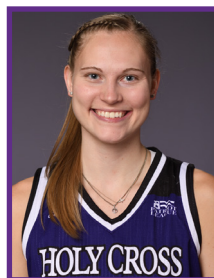
