The Holy Cross football team travels this weekend to face Syracuse in an FBS showdown on Saturday, Sept. 28. Kickoff is scheduled for 12 p.m. at the JMA Wireless Dome.

Holy Cross comes off of a heartbreaking loss after Yale scored a touchdown with 12 seconds remaining to defeat the Crusaders, 38-31, on Saturday, Sept. 21 at Fitton Field during a Family Weekend matchup.

Senior quarterback Joe Pesansky passed for 279 yards, while sophomore running back Jayden Clerveaux scored three rushing touchdowns and totaled 49 rushing yards. Junior receiver Max Mosey reeled in five catches for a career-best 129 yards, the most by a Crusader this year. Sophomore receiver Maxwell Warren scored his first career touchdown on a 74-yard reception.

Senior linebacker Frankie Monte had a career-best 17 tackles — the most by a Patriot League player this season — with a quarterback hurry, and earned Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week honors. So far this year, Monte ranks second in the Patriot League and tied for seventh among all FCS players with 40 total tackles. Sophomore linebacker Cam Santee had a career-high seven tackles in the setback against Yale while recording 1.5 tackles for loss.

Sophomore placekicker Daniel Porto hit a 45-yard field goal as time expired in the first half against the Bulldogs, marking the longest field goal by a Holy Cross player since the 2022 season.

Holy Cross' three losses this year have been a series of heartbreakers, all coming in one-score games. Defensively, the Crusaders have come up with a number of impressive plays, with 11 forced fumbles on the year. Holy Cross ranks fifth in FCS with five fumble recoveries. The Crusaders have secured a total of seven turnovers while only turning the ball over twice, with their turnover margin of 1.25 ranking fifth in all of FCS.

Senior Curtis Harris-Lopez is one of three players in FCS with a kickoff return for a touchdown this season.

Pesansky is averaging 16.78 yards per completion so far this year, ranking fourth in all of FCS. Mosey's 22.78 yards per reception ranks 10th in FCS.

Holy Cross and Syracuse will meet five years to the day since their last meeting; the Crusaders and Orange last faced off on Sept. 28, 2019, with the Orange securing a 41-3 victory.

The Crusaders' most recent win over an FBS opponent came in 2022, when Holy Cross earned a Hail Mary victory at Buffalo on Sept. 10, 2022.

**THE SERIES WITH SYRACUSE:** This will be the 30th meeting all-time between the Crusaders and the Orange on the gridiron. Syracuse has won the last 13 games played in the series, with the teams' matchup in 2019 marking the first game between the two programs since 1973. Holy Cross' last win over the Orange came in 1958 (14-13 at Fitton Field).

**WITH A WIN, HOLY CROSS WOULD:** Earn its third win over an FBS opponent since 2021...defeat Syracuse for the first time since 1958...give Dan Curran his first head coaching win over an FBS opponent.

**LAST TIME THEY MET:** Syracuse's Tommy DeVito passed for 269 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Orange to a 41-3 victory over the Holy Cross football team at the Carrier Dome on Sept. 28, 2019. The Orange opened the scoring at the 11:46-mark of the first quarter on a 14-yard touchdown pass from DeVito to Aaron Hackett. Syracuse added a 17-yard scoring strike from DeVito to Trishton Jackson and a 52-yard field goal by Sterling Hofrichter to make the score 17-0 after the first quarter. Early in the second quarter, placekicker Derek Ng booted a 48-yard field goal to put the Cru-

saders on the board. The Orange responded with a 19-yard touchdown run by Abdul Adams and led 24-3 at the break. In the third quarter, Syracuse used a 26-yard field goal by Andrew Szmyt and a 47-yard scoring strike from DeVito to Taj Harris to go in front 34-3. The Orange then concluded the scoring with a 70-yard touchdown pass from DeVito to Luke Benson early in the fourth quarter. Syracuse finished the day with 429 yards of total offense while picking up 10 first downs. Holy Cross was able to total just 138 yards and 10 first downs. Wide out Tenio Ayeni led the Crusaders with four receptions for 64 yards, while running back Peter Oliver added 41 yards on 15 carries. Defensive back Joe Lang posted a game-high 12 tackles with one tackle for loss.

**CRUSADERS VS. FBS:** Holy Cross has defeated two FBS opponents since 2021, with a 38-28 win over Connecticut on Sept. 4, 2021 and a 37-31 Hail Mary victory over Buffalo on Sept. 10, 2022. Holy Cross faced two FBS foes during the 2023 season, falling in a pair of three-point contests to Boston College (31-28, 9/9/23) and Army West Point (17-14, 11/11/23).

**PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:** Three different Crusaders have earned weekly honors from the Patriot League during the 2024 season...Senior running back Jordan Fuller was named the Offensive Player of the Week after rushing for 139 yards against Rhode Island on Aug. 31...senior Curtis Harris-Lopez was selected as Special Teams Player of the Week after returning a kickoff 95 yards for a touchdown against Bryant on Sept. 14...senior linebacker Frankie Monte earned Defensive Player of the Week after recording a career-best 17 tackles vs. Yale on Sept. 21.

**PATRIOT LEAGUE CHAMPIONS:** With a 31-10 victory over Georgetown on Nov. 18, 2023, Holy Cross clinched a share of the Patriot League crown in its regular-season finale — marking an unprecedented fifth straight league championship for the Crusaders. This marks the 11th Patriot League title in Holy Cross history; no other team in league history has ever won five consecutive conference titles. Ten of Holy Cross' 11 titles are outright, the most outright titles by any Patriot League team in history.

**NATIONAL RANKINGS:** Holy Cross received votes in both the Stats Perform (17) and American Football Coaches Association (20) polls ahead of the 2024 season.

**PRESEASON POLL:** Holy Cross was voted to finish second in this year's Patriot League preseason poll, selected by head coaches and football SIDs in the conference. 2023 co-champion Lafayette was selected as the conference champion. A full preseason ranking follows:

Additionally, four Crusaders earned Preseason All-Patriot League honors: senior running back Jordan Fuller, senior wide receiver Justin Shorter, senior linebacker Frankie Monte and sophomore defensive end William Robinson.

**FAMILY TIES:** There are a number of family ties within the Holy Cross football program...defensive coordinator Brian Vaganek's son Brian is a 2024 graduate of the College and was a starting defensive end for the Crusaders...senior running back Jordan Fuller's father, Jerome (Class of 1992), is a Holy Cross Varsity Club Hall of Famer...fifth-year center Christo Kelly's older brother Hugh played safety for the Crusaders from 2019 to 2023... junior safety Tommy Bestpitch's father, Tom (Class of 2000), played football at Holy Cross...fifth-year left tackle Declan McCauley's older brother Jack played for Holy Cross from 2018 to 2022 as a long snapper and offensive lineman...sophomore defensive lineman Keating Oliver is the son of Holy Cross strength and conditioning coach Jeff Oliver; his brother Peter (Class of 2023) was an All-Patriot League running back with the Crusaders and his sister Lydia is a member of the Holy Cross field hockey team.

**GOOD WORKS:** Fifth-year center and team captain Christo Kelly was named one of 22 student-athletes selected to the 2024 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, which recognizes college football athletes for their unwavering commitment to community service and their "good works" off the field. Kelly will serve as the co-president of the Holy Cross Student-Athlete Advisory Committee this fall after serving as SAAC vice president last year. He is the co-founder of the Holy Cross chapter of Uplifting Athletes, which raises funds and awareness for the rare disease community. He collaborated with the national organization to develop and implement new initiatives and has helped lead the team's annual "Lift For Life" event. With the Holy Cross football team, Kelly is a leader in the team's community service initiatives, including the program's work with Team IMPACT.

**ACADEMIC HONORS:** Jordan Fuller — selected as a 2023 Academic All-American by the College Sports Communicators — is a semifinalist for the 2024 William V. Campbell Trophy (the "Academic Heisman"). Fuller was also a Patriot League All-Academic Team selection, joined a season ago on the CSC Academic All-District Team by now-fifth year center Christo Kelly and now-junior tight end John Owens. Of Holy Cross' returners, 17 earned a spot on the 2023 Patriot League Academic Honor Roll.

**2023 IN REVIEW:** Holy Cross finished with a 7-4 record and 5-1 mark in league play in 2023, clinching a share of its fifth consecutive Patriot League title. The Crusaders' four losses were by just a combined 19 points — including a pair of three-point losses to FBS foes, Boston College (31-28 on Sept. 9) and Army West Point (17-14 on Nov. 11). The Crusaders had a total of six players earn 2023 All-America honors from various organizations.

**FCS PLAYOFFS:** After not winning a postseason game ever in program history until the 2021 season, the Crusaders won a FCS playoff game two seasons in a row. The Crusaders defeated New Hampshire, 35-19, in a rainy second-round matchup in 2022, to advance to the FCS quarterfinals for the first time since 1983. In the quarterfinals, the Crusaders tied with eventual national champions South Dakota State through three quarters, but the Jackrabbits pulled away late to hand Holy Cross its first loss of the season. Holy Cross made four consecutive trips to the FCS playoffs from 2019 to 2022; in 2021, the Crusaders won their first FCS playoff game in program history, after a historic touchdown reception from wide receiver Jalen Coker secured a 13-10 victory over Sacred Heart with 14 seconds left.

**ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE SELECTIONS:** The Holy Cross football team earned 11 All-Patriot League selections for the 2023 season. Additionally, quar-

terback Matthew Sluka and fifth-year linebacker Jacob Dobbs were named the Patriot League Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year, respectively. Others to earn All-Patriot League first team selections were running back Jordan Fuller, wide receiver Jalen Coker, right guard C.J. Hanson, left tackle Luke Newman and defensive tackle Dillon Springer. Tight end Sean Morris, right tackle Pat McMurtrie, left guard Eric Schon and cornerback Terrence Spence were second team honorees.

**THE CURRAN FILE:** Dan Curran was named the 29th head coach in the history of the Holy Cross football program in December. Curran most recently spent 11 seasons as the head coach at Merrimack, guiding the program through its transition to Division I. He is the all-time winningest coach in Merrimack history with 53 victories, and led the Warriors to the Northeast Conference championship game in 2022 and 2023. Curran's 2022 team also tied the school single-season record with eight victories, while posting a seven-game winning streak and receiving votes in the top 25 for four consecutive weeks in just the program's third full season at the Division I level. Throughout his career, Curran has recruited and mentored nine All-Americans, 50 all-conference players and 10 NFL free agents. Curran came to Merrimack after playing eight years of professional football. He spent time with the Seattle Seahawks and New Orleans Saints of the National Football League, as well as the New Orleans Voodoo and Georgia Force of the Arena Football League. A graduate of the University of New Hampshire, Curran earned All-Atlantic 10 honors after rushing for over 1,000 yards and scoring 16 touchdowns in his senior season for head coach Sean McDonnell and offensive coordinator Chip Kelly. The Chelmsford High School Hall of Famer was the Boston Globe Player of the Year as a senior after leading to a Super Bowl victory and its fourth consecutive Merrimack Valley Conference title.

**CAPTAINS:** Five Crusaders were selected by their teammates as captains for the 2024 season: senior quarterback Joe Pesansky, senior running back Jordan Fuller, fifth-year center Christo Kelly, senior safety Curtis Harris-Lopez and senior linebacker Frankie Monte.

**FORDHAM:** The Crusaders posted a gritty 49-47 victory over Fordham on Oct. 28, 2023. Holy Cross retained possession of the Ram-Crusader Cup, earning their seventh consecutive win against the Rams. Fordham scored a touchdown with 54 seconds remaining to cut within two points, but the two-point conversion attempt failed; the Crusaders recovered the ensuing onside kick to preserve the victory. Making his first career start, junior quarterback Joe Pesansky completed 20 of his 33 attempts for 337 yards and a trio of touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Jalen Coker caught a touchdown and had 102 receiving yards. Junior running back Jordan Fuller rushed for 116 yards and two touchdowns, becoming the program's all-time leader with 38 career rushing touchdowns. Fifth-year running back Tyler Purdy had two touchdowns, one rushing and one receiving, with 115 total yards on the day, including 85 receiving yards. Defensively, fifth-year linebacker Jacob Dobbs totaled 10 tackles, with an eight-yard sack. Junior linebacker Frankie Monte had eight tackles and a pass breakup. Senior cornerback Matt Duchemin recorded five solo tackles and a game-sealing, 68-yard pick-six.

**CRUSADERS IN THE PROS:** C.J. Hanson '24 became the first Crusader

drafted since 1989 when he was selected by the Kansas City Chiefs in the seventh round of the 2024 NFL Draft...Hanson was named to the Chiefs' 53-man roster....Hanson, alongside wide receiver Jalen Coker, became two of four Holy Cross players ever to attend the NFL Combine in February... Coker was signed by the Carolina Panthers as an undrafted free agent and was elevated to the 53-man roster this week after beginning the season on the practice squad.... outside linebacker Benton Whitley '22 was named to the New York Giants' 53-man roster...Kalif Raymond '16 was an All-Pro selection as a punt returner for the Detroit Lions in 2022. He recently signed a contract extension with Detroit in August...linebacker Liam Anderson '23 was signed by the Indianapolis Colts as an undrafted free agent in April 2023, and is currently on the practice squad...along with wide receiver Ayir Asante '23 (Giants), Holy Cross had a total of six players in NFL training camps this summer...long snapper Adam Guillemette '23 was drafted by the Toronto Argonauts in the 2023 CFL Draft.

**TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE:** The 2024 campaign marks the 129th season of Holy Cross football. The Crusaders currently own an overall record of 673-547-54, good for a .550 winning percentage. Prior to the start of the 2024 season, Holy Cross' 672 all-time victories ranked as the 14th most among all FCS schools. Holy Cross has had 37 first team All-America selections, sent more than 90 players on to professional football, won five Lambert Cups, claimed 11 Patriot League championships, and was named the Division I-AA Team of the Year in 1987. The Crusaders also played in the 1946 Orange Bowl, losing to host Miami on the game's final play.

**ABOUT THE PATRIOT LEAGUE:** Now in its fourth decade as an all-sport conference combining academic and athletic excellence, the Patriot League sponsors championships in 24 men and women's sports. Initially started as an NCAA Division I-AA football conference in 1986, the Patriot League became an all-sport conference in 1990. Fellow football programs in the Patriot League include Bucknell, Colgate, Fordham, Georgetown, Lafayette and Lehigh. The Patriot League's mission is simple: to provide successful competitive athletic experiences while maintaining high academic standards, and to prepare its student-athletes to be leaders in society.

**ABOUT HOLY CROSS:** The College of the Holy Cross was founded in 1843 by the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) in Worcester, Massachusetts. Holy Cross is a highly selective, four-year, undergraduate, liberal arts institution and is ranked among the nation's leading four-year liberal arts colleges. Worcester (pronounced "wuh-stir," population 186,000) is located in Central Massachusetts 44 miles west of Boston. Holy Cross ranks No. 3 on Money Magazine's list of "10 Best Liberal Arts Colleges for Your Money" and No. 7 on its list of best small colleges. It is also among the 50 "most beautiful college campuses" in America, according to Architectural Digest and Condé Nast. Top majors at Holy Cross include economics, psychology, political science, history and English. Holy Cross has won NCAA championships in baseball (1952) and basketball (1947). Notable Holy Cross alumni include former Boston Celtics Bob Cousy (1950) and Tommy Heinsohn (1956); Dr. Anthony Fauci (1962), head of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, National Institutes of Health; U.S. Supreme Court Justice Clarence Thomas (1971); sports journalist Bill Simmons (1992); and Jon Favreau (2003), former chief speechwriter for President Barack Obama.
