

- Southern University (4-6,3-4) host Grambling State University (3-7, 2-5) on Saturday, November 27th for the 48th Annual Bayou Classic at the Caesers Superdome in New Orleans, Louisiana on NBCSports.
- Grambling leads the series with a 31-30 overall record against SU which dates back to 11/30/1929.
- The last meeting between the two teams was 4/17/21 where the Jaguars took the victory with the score being 49-7.

NOTES

- Jordan Lewis is the active sack leader in the FCS with 34.
- Lewis is now third in the FCS in total sacks per game with 0.92.
- Glendon McDaniel was 16-24 with 176 passing yards and a touchdown in his last outing.
- Jerodd Sims had 25 carries for 104 vards and a touchdown, averging 3.9 yards a carry.
- Chase Foster was the teams leading tackler in the last outing(8).

The Bayou Classic is the annual college football game between the Southern University Jaguars and the Grambling State Tigers, first held under that name in 1974 at Tulane Stadium in New Orleans, although the series itself actually began in 1932. Since 1990 the game has been held the final Saturday in November at Caesars Superdome.

The 2005 game was moved from the Superdome to Reliant Stadium in Houston, Texas, due to the damage from Hurricane Katrina. This was the only time that the Bayou Classic was held outside of Louisiana. The 2006 Bayou Classic returned to the Superdome.

On last season due to the substantial scope of the phase 2 renovation work that began in January 2021 at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome in New Orleans, the annual home of the Bayou Classic between the Southern Jaguars and the Grambling Tigers had to be temporarily moved to Independence Stadium in Shreve-port.

The Bayou Classic is the annual legendary football game between Grambling State University and Southern University. The Bayou Classic has proven to be a steadfast beacon of legacy and tradition that extends beyond the HBCU community.

Fans from across the nation journey to witness the electrifying football game between Southern and Grambling, while eagerly awaiting the highly anticipated halftime show featuring two of the greatest marching bands in the nation.

A.W. MUMFORD STADIUM



A.W. Mumford Stadium is a 28,500 seat multi-purpose stadium on the campus of Southern University in Baton Rouge, LA. It opened in 1928 and is home to the Jaguars football team as well as the Southern men's and women's track and field teams.


The stadium is named after coach Arnett W. "Ace" Mumford who holds the record for most wins in SU football history, who coached the Jaguars from 1936-42 and 1944-61.

Almost 8 decades later, Mumford stadium has seen many changes. In 1938, SU built a grand-stand on the west side that included dormitories. In the 1960's the dormitories were converted into team meeting spaces and locker rooms. Another expansion for more seats and better lighting started in 1977 and forced the Jaguars off campus to use nearby Memorial Stadium for home games. The project was completed in 1982 and University Stadium was then renamed to A. W. Mumford Stadium.

A \$6.75 million renovation begun on A. W. Mumford Stadium's west side in 2000. With a double-decked press box that included two elevators, seven suites, additional restrooms, working press area, radio booths, coaching booths and camera decks.

In 2009 the north end zone addition known as the A.W. "Ace" Fieldhouse was completed adding an additional 2,300 seats along with an administrative offices, athletic training room, weight room, conference and meeting rooms, coaching offices, end zone suites, Track and field locker rooms, equipment room, laundry room, storage space and football locker room that allowed the Jaguars to move from the F.G. Clark Activity Center.

In 2016 UBU Sports synthetic field turf was installed. Southern students and the Human Jukebox sit on the west side of the stadium.





JORDAN LEWIS

Jordan Lewis is a 6-3, 195-pound junior from Ocala, Fl., ranked No. 1 during the 2021 spring season in tackles for loss (15), tackles for loss per game (3.0), tackle yardage for loss (82), sacks (10.5), sacks per game (2.1) and sack yardage (73).

The reigning Southwestern Athletic Conference's Defensive Player of The Year finished with 27 overall tackles (19 solo), posting season highs of 11 tackles, five tackles for loss, four sacks and a forced fumble in a victory at Alabama State.

He was named the Southwestern Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year, College Football Hall of Fame Mel Blount Defensive Player of the Year, Buck Buchanan Award winner, First Team All-SWAC Defensive team, BOXTOROW HBCU Defensive Player of the Year and All-First Team Defense just to name a few.



LAST TIME OUT...

BATON ROUGE, LA-- Southern drops a close one to Jackson State on senior night in front of a packed house at A.W. Mumford Stadium. Final score was 21-17.

The Jags took a seven point lead into the half, 14-7 and came out in the second half fighting blow for blow all the way to the last play. SU went for it all on fourth down to try to win the ball game but Glendon McDaniel pass was intercepted in the end zone by JSU's Shilo Sanders to seal the victory for Jackson State.

Southern QB Glendon McDaniel finished the night going 16-of-24 for 176 yards and one touchdown pass to junior tight-end Gregory Perkins. Sophomore running back Jerodd Sims led the Jags rushing attack with 104 yards off 25 carries and a 32-yard TD run. Ethan Howard finished the night with five catches for a team-high 58 yards.

The Jaguars defense played a solid game all night led by senior All-American Chase Foster with eight tackles in his last home game of his career. Linebacker Ray Anderson held down the middle of the field with six tackles and 1.5 tackles for a total of 5-yard loss. Tyran Nash finished the night with four tackles, 1.5 tackles for 14-yard loss and one sack for a 12-yard loss.

JASON ROLLINS



Jason Rollins is entering his second season on the bluff and first as the Interim Head Coach.

He previously came from UTSA where he served as the defensive coordinator for two seasons and spent two years as associate head coach and linebackers coach.

In his first year as the defensive coordinator and safeties coach, UTSA displayed an aggressive scheme by recording 78 tackles for loss, 23 sacks and 19 turnovers, including 10 fumble recoveries, which ranked fourth in Conference USA and 36th nationally. Linebacker Josiah Tauaefa registered 113 tackles — the second-highest total in program history — en route to being named one of 10 semifinalists for the Butkus Award, second-team all-conference by Pro Football Focus (PFF) and honorable mention all-conference by the league's head coaches. Defensive end Lorenzo Dantzler picked up second-team all-conference honors by PFF, while safety C.J. Levine and defensive tackle Kevin Strong Jr. earned honorable mention all-conference accolades.

Rollins helped mentor one of the nation's top defenses in 2017, as the Roadrunners led C-USA in seven different statistical categories and ranked in the top 10 among all Football Bowl Subdivision teams in five. UTSA held eight of its 11 opponents to 300-or-less yards of total offense, including a school-record 149 allowed in the 51-17 win against Southern, and five foes rushed for 100-or-less yards, highlighted by a program-record 37 allowed in the 44-14 victory at Texas State. Linebacker La'Kel Bass earned honorable mention all-conference accolades after leading the team with 68 tackles to go along with 7.5 tackles for loss, two sacks and a pair of fumble recoveries.

In his first season with the Roadrunners, he helped guide the team to six wins and the program's first-ever bowl game, the 2016 Gildan New Mexico Bowl. His linebackers combined for 267 tackles, 24 tackles for loss, 12 sacks and 12 quarterback hurries. Josiah Tauaefa broke UTSA's single-season record for tackles with 115 en route to becoming the Roadrunners' first Freshman All-American (Football Writers Association of America), C-USA Freshman of the Year and a first-team all-conference selection. Bass tied the school standard for single-season tackles for loss with 11 as part of his 87 total stops.

Rollins came to San Antonio from Tulane, where he spent nine seasons as secondary coach, including serving as co-defensive coordinator in 2015 and special teams coordinator in 2014. He played a key role in the development of three All-Americans and four NFL players in draft picks Lorenzo Doss and Taurean Nixon, as well as free agents Derrick Strozier and Jordan Sullen.

In 2013, Rollins' secondary was a big reason why the Green Wave made their first bowl appearance since the 2002 season. Tulane ranked second nationally in turnovers forced with 35, including 19 interceptions with 15 by the defensive backfield. Doss, an All-America cornerback, picked off seven passes, returning a pair for touchdowns, and forced two fumbles. Additionally, Tulane allowed just 352.1 yards per game, which ranked 22nd in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS).

In 2014, Rollins helped lead the secondary to a combined 15 interceptions, seven fumble recoveries and a pair of forced fumbles, as the unit contributed to 22 of the team's 28 takeaways, which ranked 21st nationally. Parry Nickerson led the Green Wave and all FBS freshmen with six picks and garnered Freshman All-America accolades.

Rollins' impact on Tulane's secondary was immediate from the time he joined the staff prior to the 2008 campaign. In his first season in New Orleans, the group combined for 23 pass breakups, five interceptions, five forced fumbles and five recoveries.

During the next four years, his defensive backs combined for 31 interceptions and 120 pass breakups while helping the Green Wave defense consistently rank near the top of Conference USA in most major statistical categories.

Prior to his tenure at Tulane, Rollins was co-defensive coordinator and secondary coach at his alma mater, McNeese State, for two seasons (2005-06). He helped the Cowboys to a 23-10 record, two Southland Conference championships and a Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) playoff appearance in in his final season.

Rollins got his coaching start as an assistant coach for the defensive backs at McNeese State in 1997-98. He was an assistant coach in the Texas prepranks at Galveston Ball (1999-2000) and La Marque (2001).

He spent three seasons (2002-04) as the defensive backs coach at Northwestern State, where he helped the Demons to the 2004 Southland title on the strength of the top defense in the FCS.

Rollins was an all-state and all-district performer at Newton (Texas) High School and he went on to play safety at McNeese State where he earned his bachelor's degree in health and human performance from MSU in 1996.

He and his wife, Danna, have one son, Tieler.
