- Last time SU played in Shreveport was in 2012 Vs. PVU. SU lost 49-29.
- The Fall of 2020 was the 1st time SU did not play football in the Fall since 1943 when WWII canceled the season. That's (76) straight seasons of playing football.
- The SWAC will add Bethune Cookman and Fla. A&M in the Fall. It's the 1st time since 1999 new teams are added.

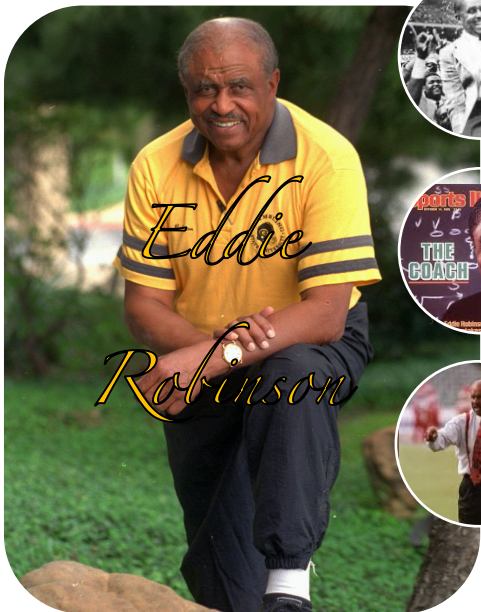

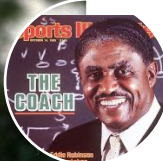

SOUTHERN JAGUARS GAME NOTES

Southern Vs. Grambling St. Before the Bayou Classic

Southern University started playing Grambling St. in 1932 in Monroe, La. Southern won that game, 20-0. In fact, the Jaguars would win for the 1st eight games in the series from 1932-1946 before the Tigers would end that streak in 1947 with a 21-6 win at Grambling. This series was a “Home” campus game for each school until 1972 with a political unrest on the campus of Southern University which led to a forfeit by the Jaguars. The game was then moved to Shreveport the next year in 1973. Southern led the series at that time, 15-10.

Bayou Classic History

The Bayou Classic’s 1st game was in 1974 at Tulane Stadium in New Orleans and would move to the Superdome the very next year in 1975. This is only 2nd time in Bayou Classic history that the game will be not be played in New Orleans. The only other time was in 2005 when Hurricane Katrina moved the game to Houston at the NRG Stadium. The longest winning streak in the Bayou Classic is owned by Southern University when they won 8 games between 1993-2000 under Coach Pete Richardson. Grambling St. had won the 1st (5) games in this series from 1974-1978. The Bayou Classic Series is tied at 23-23 with the winner of today’s game gaining control again but it might not be cherished too long because for the 1st time in this series-they will be 2 Bayou Classic games played in 1 calendar year.

Where It All Began

This series has had a lot of history leading up to the Bayou Classic. The term “Classic” was 1st used for this game in 1948 when Southern upset Grambling St. in front of 10,000 fans, 18-0. A brawl broke out after the game and the teams did not meet again until 1959. Another milestone was in 1972 when the game was supposed to be played in Baton Rouge at Southern but a political unrest led Southern to forfeit the game. Then the schools decided to move the game to Shreveport where 40,000 fans attended the game. At that point, both Southern University and Grambling St. decided this game was too big to be in Shreveport and moved the game to Tulane Stadium the very next year and called it “The Bayou Classic” known as the “Granddaddy” of them all. The “Battle of the Bands” started in the Endzone of the Shreveport game and has been a big hit since. No bands will be allowed for today’s game but the battle and the game are set to return to New Orleans this Fall.

NBC-Sports Network Carries Today’s Game

NBC-Sports Network will carry today’s 47th Annual Bayou Classic. It’s been on this network since 2015 and will also cover the game when it returns to New Orleans this November. The game had been on the “main” network (NBC) from 1991-2014. NBC-Sports Network has announced that it will close operations at the end of 2021. The contract with the NBC Sports Network had already set to expire with the Bayou Classic at end of 2021. No word at this time if NBC will extend its contract after 2021 or the game would be moved to another network.

Barajas Kicks Career Long FG

Southern University’s FG #30 **Cesar Barajas** kicked his career long Field Goal against the Tigers of Jackson St. 2 weeks ago of 49 yards. **Barajas** is perfect for the season at (4-4) for 100%. His previous long FG was a 47-yarder he kicked in his 2nd season at Southern against Grambling in the Bayou Classic in 2018. So far in his career, he is (7-14) from the (40-49) yard range and overall he is (16 for 28) in FG’s for 57%. In his last 2 years, he is (8 for 11) for 73%. In addition to kicking FG’s this year he’s also the Punter with an average (41.4) yards per punt with a long punt for 52 yards. He also Kicks-Off for the Jaguars with an average of (51.6) yards per kickoff, has 3 Touchbacks and none kicked Out of Bounds. His 4th duty is PAT’s which he is (17 for 17) for 100%.

Southern Is The “Home” Team for the 47th Bayou Classic

The Jaguars will be the “Home” Team today and when they are labeled as the home team they are (11-12). Under **Coach Dawson Odums** the Jaguars are (3-1). As the “Road” team, Southern is (2-2) under **Odums** and overall Southern is (12-11).

SU Athletes Get Their COVID Shots

This month, Our Lady of the Lake Regional Medical Center in Baton Rouge and Southern University Athletics teamed up to give Southern University Athletes and faculty the COVID Shot. It was the Johnson & Johnson shot so only one shot is needed. The event happened in the basketball arena known as the FG Clark Activity Center. Several athletes took the shot with lines snaked inside the arena.

Southern Usually Don’t Lose After A Bye Week

In the **Coach Odums**’ era, Southern is 15-2 after a Bye Week with the only losses coming against Grambling St. in 2015 and 2017. Since 2017, Southern has won (7) in a row thanks to the win over Jackson St.

#32 Jordan Lewis is the Sack Master

Junior DE **#32 Jordan Lewis** has become an “Master” at coming off the edge and sacking whoever gets in his way. In the 24 games he’s played so far in his career he has 27 ½ Sacks for 212 yards and 38 ½ Tackles For Losses for 236 yards. This year he already has 9 ½ Sacks for 67 yards and 14 TFL’s for 76 yards. He had 12 Sacks in his Freshman year and had 6 last year in an injury plagued season his Soph. season. With this year not counting as far as NCAA eligibility, he could get close to the FCS All-Time record of 42 ½ sacks set by James Cowser of Southern Utah (2012-15). Right now in the 24 games he’s played, he’s averaging 1 Sack per game. The FCS record for Sacks in a Season is 23 ½ set by Chris Gocong of Cal Poly in 2005. **Lewis** leads the nation in Sacks this season with 9 ½.

Ladarius Skelton MVP in Both Bayou Classic Games Played

QB **Ladarius Skelton** has played in 2 Bayou Classics and not only is the R-SR (2-0) but he’s also been named the MVP in both games. His first Bayou Classic (2018), he Passed for 217 yards and 3 TD’s and Rushed for another 106 yards. In his 2nd Classic (2019), he Passed for 181 yards with 2 TD’s and Rushed for 68 yards. In the 2 games he’s played: **Skelton** has Passed for a combined 398 yards with 5 TD’s and Rushed for another 174 yards.

Caleb Carter Starting to Come Around

When the 2019 season ended, **#47 Caleb Carter** finished 2nd on the team in Tackles with 81. The R-SR’s routine was broken when the Jaguars didn’t play in the Fall. So this year it’s been a slow process for **Carter**. He had 4 Tackles against Alabama St. back in February, 6 against Ark. Pine Bluff and 5 against Texas Southern. In the Jackson St. game, he finished with a Season & game High 7 Tackles and for the Spring Season he now is 2nd on the team again with 22 Tackles. For his career, he has 153 Tackles and 10 TFL’s in 39 games played at Southern University.

The Jaguars Crack the Top 25

The Southern Jaguar football team is back in the Top 25 National Poll for the 1st time since October 2nd, 2007. Southern was ranked #20 before dropping out the very next week. The highest the Jaguars have been ranked was #3 in the Sports Network Poll on October 19th, 1999. The Jaguars were ranked #25 by the FCS Coaches Poll last week for their victory over Jackson St. and has a record of 4-1 in Spring Football.

1st Time Southern University Plays in the Spring

For the 1st time since 2005, the Southern Jaguars did not kick-off in the 1st week of September. That year, Hurricane Katrina delayed the start of the season. This year it’s been COVID-19. Southern University hasn’t missed a Fall season of football since 1943 when World War II canceled the entire season. This is the 1st time ever that the Jaguars are playing a season in the Spring. **AD Roman Banks** says postponing Fall Sports affected 1/3 of the budget but it was more of a wear and tear physically and emotionally for his coaches and student athletes. **Banks** made Headlines by being upset that Alcorn St. canceled football in the Spring. **Banks** said that Alcorn St. will play the next (2) seasons at Southern because they pulled out. That means, the Jaguars will not return to Lorman, Miss. until the 2023.

The SWAC is Growing

For the 1st time since 1999 when Alabama A&M joined the conference, the SWAC will add 2 more teams in the Fall of 2021. Bethune Cookman and Florida A&M will start with football. FAMU has a history with Southern University playing against the Rattler’s in 2019 but hasn’t played Bethune Cookman since 2006. FAMU leads the series with Southern 35-26-1, however, the Jaguars are 5-0 against the Wildcats of Bethune Cookman. The SWAC also added Ark. Pine Bluff in 1997 and before that the most recent addition was Alabama St. in 1982. Southern University joined the SWAC in 1935 and the very 1st member of the SWAC was Prairie View A&M in 1920.

More on Grambling St. Tigers

The Grambling St. Tigers haven’t played a game since March 20th when they played the University of Arkansas Pine Bluff Golden Lions on March 20th. That’s a 3-week break for the Tigers. GSU is (0-3) this Spring losing to Jackson St., (33-28), Prairie View A&M (17-10) and Ark. Pine Bluff (48-21). After the Prairie View loss, Offensive Coordinator Mark Orlando quit the team and Tiger legend Kendrick Nord took over for the UAPB game. After that loss, word is that Coach Fobbs was going to re-assign members of his coaching staff and Nord walked out and was later fired. Coach Fobbs will take over “play” calling duties today. The Tigers also got another blow when QB Jeremy Hickbottom entered the NCAA transfer portal. Hickbottom had played in 34 games in career for the Tigers passing for 4,233 yards and 31 TD’s. He’s also Rushed for another 1,324 yards and ran for 16 TD’s in his career. GSU averages 19.7 point per game, 124.7 rushing yds per game, 241 yards in passing per game for a total of 366.0 Yards Total per game. Listed as today’s starter is #3 Elijah Walker. He has 267 yards passing for the season with 1 TD. He’s thrown 55% of his passes complete going 21 of 38. The 2nd player listed on the Tigers’ Depth Chart is #11 John Paul Pierce. He played in 1 play in 2019 at Miss. Valley St. and handed the ball off before coming out before the next play. Their top Rusher is #9 CJ. Russell who has 114 yards on 27 carries for an average of 4.2 ypc. He has 1 TD for the year. On Defense, #23 Kenan Fontenot & #48 Bryan Powell leads the team with 21 Tackles each.

Southern Chances The SWAC Championship Game

The Southern University Jaguars have won the SWAC Western Division for 2 seasons in a row and still have a shot to make it 3 In-A-Row. Here is how that can happen: Southern beats Grambling St. today to finish at 4-1 in SWAC play. Then, Arkansas Pine Bluff would have to lose today to Prairie View and next week to Texas Southern. Prairie View would have to then lose to Jackson St. next week. The final standings in the West would look like this: Southern would be 4-1, Prairie View 3-1, and UAPB would finish 3-2. UAPB owns the tie-breaker over Southern thanks to the loss in Baton Rouge on March 6th.

Coach Dawson Odums (9th Year at Southern University) (62-35 overall & 54-20 in SWAC)

A native of Shelby, N.C., Odums began his coaching career returning to his high school alma mater, Crest High School, where he turned in a stellar playing career for the Eagles of North Carolina Central University in Durham. As a three-year starter, he became an All-CIAA selection his senior year, and also served as a team captain. Following his playing career, he earned a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Physical Education in 1997.

Odums joined the Jaguars defensive staff after three seasons in various positions at Mid-Eastern Atlantic Conference traditional power, North Carolina A& T. Prior to his arrival in Baton Rouge, Odums most recently served as the Aggies Defensive Coordinator in 2010 after having served as the schools defensive line coach and special team's coordinator in the previous two seasons.

In the history of Southern University Football, only two coaches have conquered such feats as winning the SWAC West Title, SWAC Championship and being named SWAC Coach of the Year in their first full season as head coach. Current Head Football Coach Dawson Odums holds that unique distinction as he looks to take the program to even higher heights as he embarks on his eighth season at Southern University here on the bluffs of the Mississippi River in 2019.

Coach Odums has coached (20) 1st Team All-Conference players, (12) 2nd Team All-Conference players, and 5 All American players which are Lee Doss, Dray Joseph, Willie Quinn, Lenard Tillery and Jodeci Harris. Also at his tenure at Southern University Coach Odums has been blessed to send 6 players to the NFL/CFL which are Rashaun Allen (Houston Texans), Arthur Miley (Miami Dolphins), Mike Jones and Willie Quinn (Hamilton Tiger-Cats), Lenard Tillery (Los Angeles Rams) and Danny Johnson (Washington Redskins).

With 19 years of coaching experience under his belt, Coach Odums lacks no motivation for the 2019 season as he looks to continue the winning ways Southern accumulated in his 4th season by instilling the core values of a Jaguar (Commitment, Discipline, Effort, Toughness & Pride) on a daily basis in all facets of the program.

Coach Odums has been married to his beautiful wife Audrey for 20 years, and reside in Zachary with their two daughters, Jasmine and Jaiden.
