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PELICAN RELAYS MEET INFORMATION

The 2023 Pelican Relays held on Saturday, April 8, 2023, will be a college-only meet. Unattached athletes will be permitted by permission of meet management. This will be a scored meet in multiple formats depending on participating teams.

DATE: Saturday, April 8, 2023

SITE: A.W. Mumford Stadium, 1 Swan St. Baton Rouge, LA 70813

MEET SCHEDULE: See page 5.

FACILITY: A.W. Mumford Stadium is a 9-lane track with 28,500 seating capacity. The facility also includes two horizontal jump runways with sand pits, two javelin runways, a pole vault runway, shot put ring, and hammer cage located in Jaguar Park.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Entries must be completed using the Direct Athletics website www.directathletics.com. Updated meet information will be posted at <https://gojagsports.com/sports/track-and-field/schedule>. Please check back regularly for additional updates and information.

ENTRY FEE: **Teams:** The entry fee is \$400 per team (\$800 for both men and women). **Entry fees for any team with less than 16 athletes per gender will be \$20 per athlete.** Checks should be made payable to "Southern University Track and Field" and paid at packet pick-up.

ENTRY DEADLINE: **ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY TUESDAY, APRIL 4, 2023 AT 5:00 P.M.**

Packet Pick-Up Packets can be picked up in A.W. Mumford Fieldhouse, from 8:30am-3:00pm on Friday and 10:00am-3:00pm on Saturday. A wristband will be given to athletes, coaches, trainers, and managers to enter the building.

Unattached Individuals: Must contact Freddie Glover at freddie_glover@subr.edu to receive entry password. Entry fee for unattached athletes is \$40 per event/athlete and must be paid online through the Direct Athletics Website. Payment is due prior to the entry deadline. If payment is



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not received your entry will not be accepted and thus will not be entered into the meet. All individual/unattached athletes must register a valid & current USATF membership card when entering the meet. Coach passes will be available for \$20 for more than 1 pass.

Pre-Meet: Pre-Meet practice will be available by request only.

SCORING: This meet will not be scored.

RULES: NCAA rules will apply.

Starting Heights Starting heights will be determined depending on field sizes & performances and will be posted once final entries are received.

PARTICIPANT ENTRY & SEATING: All personnel (athletes, coaches, managers, trainers) must enter through the east side entrance of the fieldhouse. Team camps must be set up on the visitor's side of the stadium.

SPECTATOR ENTRY: Spectators must enter through the west side of the stadium. Admission for the general public is \$5. Admission for Faculty/Staff and H Association members is \$3, as well as tickets for groups of 10+.

OFFICE HOURS: The ticket office will be open 90 minutes prior to the first event and will remain open until the end of the 200-meter events.

WARM-UP AREA: Athletes should warm up outside (either on the grass field in Jaguar Park or on the Tennis Courts). In the event of inclement weather, athletes will be permitted to warm-up inside the Mini-Dome at the discretion of the meet management. Visiting team trainers should set up under the stadium on the visitor's side.

CHECK-IN: The clerk of the course is located at the end of the straightway on the south end of the track. Athletes in running events must check in 30 minutes before their event. Field Event athletes must check in at their respective event area 30 minutes before their events. Individual/unattached athletes will receive a wristband as proof of payment of entry fees which must be presented to meet officials at check to compete.

IMPLEMENTS:

Implements will be certified at the stadium, from 8:30-10am on Friday and Saturday from 7-9am. Implements will be impounded and taken to the ring by meet officials. Implements may be collected at the conclusion of the event.
