Kermit Blount comes to JCSU after serving four years as Head Coach at Delaware State University. While with the Hornets, Blount guided the DSU program to a 6-5 mark in 2012, including a 5-3 MEAC record. That season marked the most successful year since 2007 when Delaware State won the MEAC, finishing with a 10-2 record. In Blount's third season with the Hornets in 2013, they also finished with a 5-3 MEAC record.

Prior to his appointment at Delaware State, Blount served as head coach at Winston-Salem State. While at WSSU, Blount notched a career record of 91-87-3, leading the Rams to an 8-2 record in his final season at the helm in 2009. He guided the Rams to two Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association Championships and a total of three CIAA Championship game appearances. He also led the Rams to two Pioneer Bowl appearances, winning in 1999.

Blount was honored as the CIAA Coach of the Year and as the Washington D.C. Pigskin Coach of the Year, as well as the 100% Wrong Club Coach of the Year in both 1999 and 2000.

Throughout his coaching career, Blount has been associated with programs that have experienced phenomenal success. In all, he has been in a leadership role with teams that have won a total of six conference titles at both the NCAA Division I and Division II levels. He has also served as President of the CIAA Football Coaches Association.

Prior to becoming head coach at WSSU, Blount served as an assistant coach for five seasons at South Carolina State from 1989-1993, coaching the quarterbacks, wide receivers and acting as the Bulldogs' Offensive Coordinator. Blount also coached the quarterbacks at Howard University (1984-1989) and at East Carolina University (1983-1984). While at Howard, the Bison finished 9-1 and won the 1987 MEAC championship.

Blount holds a B.S. in Health and Physical Education from Winston-Salem State University and later earned a Masters degree from East Carolina University.

A native of Richmond, Va., Blount is married to the former Ava Harris and has two children (April & Bryan) and one grandson (Micah).

2015 Preseason Outlook

The Johnson C. Smith University football team, under the direction of new head coach Kermit Blount, enters the 2015 season with a renewed spirit and energy surrounding the JCSU football program.

Led by a coach with multiple conference championships under his belt, JCSU looks to once again be in the mix for a CIAA Championship.

“Coach Blount comes to us with a wealth of experience on and off the football field,” said JCSU Athletics Director Steven Joyner, Sr. “He has a history of engaging and collaborating with the University community, community at large, alumni and football constituents at all levels.”

Defense

The Golden Bulls defense returns seven starters from a side that ranked second in the CIAA in fumbles recovered. The JCSU stoppers also managed 26 sacks on the season, good for 4th in league play.

Senior **Austin Jacques (Springdale, Md.)** led JCSU in total tackles with 133, including 72 solo and 61 assists. For his efforts in 2014, Jacques finished the season as the CIAA leader in solo tackles, assists, total tackles, and tackles per game (13.3). He was named first team All-CIAA at linebacker. Joining Jacques is defensive lineman **Jabari Carney (Sr., Decatur, Ga.)** and **Daryl Napper (Soph., Winston-Salem, N.C.)**. Carney returns after a 2014 season that saw him tally 41 total tackles, 8.0 for loss. Carney also recorded two sacks and forced one fumble while recovering one. Napper comes off a 2014 campaign that saw him register four tackles while playing in five games. Other players to watch on the defensive side of the ball include defensive back **Alan Carson (Sr., Atlanta, Ga.)** and defensive end **Brice Smith, Jr. (Sr., Atlanta, Ga.)**.

Offense

The JCSU offense will be returning five starters from a side that ranked 11th in the CIAA in scoring (119) and points per game (17.0). The immediate concern for JCSU will be finding a quarterback that can take over

for graduated signal callers Keahn Wallace and back-up Andrew Alexander, each of which saw significant action in 2014 and led the Golden Bulls passing attack to an average of 216.2 yards per game, good enough for fourth place in the league. Senior **Fred Scott (Stone Mountain, Ga.)** returns as the leading receiver from 2014. Scott hauled in a team-high 47 passes for 488 yards and six touchdowns in his junior campaign, averaging 10.4 catches per game for 48.8 yards. Scott also rushed 12 times for 63 yards in 2014.

Special Teams

JCSU will be strong on special teams in 2015, returning both their kicking specialists. Junior placekicker **Erik Amaya (Kannapolis, N.C.)** comes off a 2014 campaign where he converted 16 of 17 extra point attempts and knocked in four field goals on the season. Junior punter **Matias Lambrecht (Venice, Fla.)** will also return after averaging 41.4 yards per kick with a long of 73 yards. Lambrecht had 17 kicks of over 50 yards and pinned the JCSU opponents inside the 20 yard-line on 24 occasions. Handling the long snapping duties will be Division I transfer **Daron Wright (Atlanta, Ga.)** while Lambrecht will be the holder during kicking situations.

Newcomers

Joining the JCSU team will be a large number of newcomers, including eight transfers. Local product **Jordan Lane (Charlotte, N.C.)** is expected to fill in the role of quarterback. Lane threw for 2,091 yards as a high school senior and had 24 touchdown tosses while leading Victory Christian to their second straight NCISAA Division II State Championship in 2014. In his junior season, Lane connected for 2,450 yards and 22 touchdowns for the Kings.

A projected target for Lane looks to be incoming freshman **Desmond Covington (Pageland, S.C.)**. Other newcomers include defensive tackle **Kalyk Banks (Whiteville, N.C.)**, junior transfer offensive tackle **Billy Canty (Upper Marlboro, Md.)** and defensive back **Desmond Taylor (Picayune, Miss.)**



2015 Schedule

The Johnson C. Smith University Department of Athletics has finalized the dates and opponents for the upcoming 2015 football season.

The Golden Bulls, under the direction of first-year head coach Kermit Blount, will host four games inside the friendly confines of the Irwin Belk Complex, including the season opener on Sept. 2 against nearby rival Wingate. JCSU and Wingate last met on the gridiron in 2002 with the Bulldogs taking a 24-0 win over the Golden Bulls.

JCSU will then hit the road for three consecutive weeks playing at Kentucky State (Sept. 12), at Morehouse (Sept. 19) and at conference foe Virginia Union (Sept. 26).

The Golden Bulls will then come home to take on Bowie State on Oct. 3 for the Eddie McGirt Classic followed by the return of Coach Blount to his alma mater and old stomping grounds at Winston-Salem State on Oct. 10. Kickoff between the Rams and Golden Bulls is scheduled for 1:30 p.m. at Bowman Gray Stadium.

Following the clash with the Rams, JCSU returns home for two consecutive games, taking on Fayetteville State on Oct. 17 and hosting Shaw for Homecoming on Oct. 24.

The season will conclude with road trips to St. Augustine's on Oct. 31 and Livingstone on Nov. 7 for the 7th Annual Commemorative Classic at Alumni Memorial Stadium in Salisbury.

Commemorative Classic

A 120-year-old historic rivalry began the authentic Black College Football Phenomenon. On December 27, 1892 Biddle Institute (Johnson C. Smith University) traveled to Livingstone College's Old Delta Grove campus in Salisbury, North Carolina. Though there was snow on the ground and it was only two days after Christmas, the teams forged their way to a historic moment in sports while writers recorded the results. A writer in the 1930 yearbook of Livingstone College provided a glimpse of that December experience.

According to historian T. M. Martin, the men of Biddle spent two years studying the sport of football. In 1892, they challenged the men of Livingstone, whose team was formally organized in the fall of that year. It is doubtful that when Biddle University and Livingstone College teed it up on December 27, 1892, in what was described as little more than a cow pasture, either team had the slightest inkling of the legacy they were about to give birth. Games of monumental historical significance, coaches of legendary proportions and players of extraordinary brilliance ultimately emerged from what was to become known as the Historically Black Colleges and Universities.

The teams played two 45-minute halves on Livingstone's front lawn. W. J. Trent scored Livingstone's only touch-down on a fumble recovery. By then, snow covered the field's markings and Biddle argued that the fumble was recovered out of bounds. The official ruled in Biddle's favor, allowing them to keep the 5-0 lead that they established early on, giving JCSU the historic 1st victory! And the rivalry continues...

Irwin Belk Complex

Named for benefactor and Charlotte businessman Irwin Belk, a member of the family behind Belk department stores, the Irwin Belk Complex opened in 2003.

The \$8.9 million dollar, 4,500 seat facility features an Olympic-sized Mondo track, as well as a dance studio, weight rooms, multimedia classrooms and administrative offices. The complex was completed as a collaboration between JCSU and the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Parks and Recreation Department.

It also serves as the location of the annual JCSU Commencement Ceremony.

The entrance to the stadium features a long pathway made of bricks honoring the alumni and supporters who helped fund the complex.

The Irwin Belk Complex hosted several major track events, including NCAA Division II Championships, CIAA championships and several other programs involving the community.



Johnson C. Smith University

In 1867 the Reverend S.C. Alexander and the Reverend W.L. Miller saw the need to establish an institution in this section of the South and began to devise such plans as would secure the desired results. On April 7, 1867, at a meeting of the Catawba Presbytery in the old Charlotte Presbyterian Church, formerly located at the corner of D and Fourth Streets, Charlotte, N.C, the movement for the school was formally inaugurated, and these two ministers were elected as teachers.

Information concerning the establishing of the school was brought to the attention of Mrs. Mary D. Biddle, a devout churchwoman of Philadelphia, Penn., who, through appeals on behalf of the work in one of the church papers, pledged \$1400. In appreciation of the first and generous contribution, friends of the project requested Mrs. Biddle to name the newly established school after her late husband, Major Henry Biddle. After the request was granted, the school was named Biddle Memorial Institute and later was chartered by the State Legislature under that name.

The first eight acres of land used as the site for the school were donated by Colonel W.R. Myers, a wealthy citizen of Charlotte, N. C. From 1867 to 1876 the school was known as the Biddle Memorial Institute. In 1876 the charter was changed by the Legislature of North Carolina, and the name of the school became Biddle University. The institution operated under this name until 1923.

From 1921 to 1922, Mrs. Jane Berry Smith, of Pittsburgh, Penn, gave funds for the erection of the theological dormitory, a science hall, a teachers' cottage, and a memorial gate at Biddle University. In addition she provided a handsome endowment for the institution in memory of her late husband Johnson C. Smith. In recognition of these gener-



ous benefactions, the Board of Trustees voted to change the name of the institution to Johnson C. Smith University. The charter of the school, accordingly, was so amended March 1, 1923, by the Legislature of the State of North Carolina. From 1923 until her death in October 1929, Mrs. Smith gave funds for the erection of five more buildings, including a campus church.



The mission of Johnson C. Smith University is to provide an outgoing education for a diverse group of talented and highly motivated students from various ethnic, socioeconomic, and geographical backgrounds. Johnson C. Smith offers a liberal education in conjunction with concentrated study in specialized fields in preparation for advanced study and specific careers.

To ensure the integrity and stability of its status and the perpetuation of its rich legacy, Johnson C. 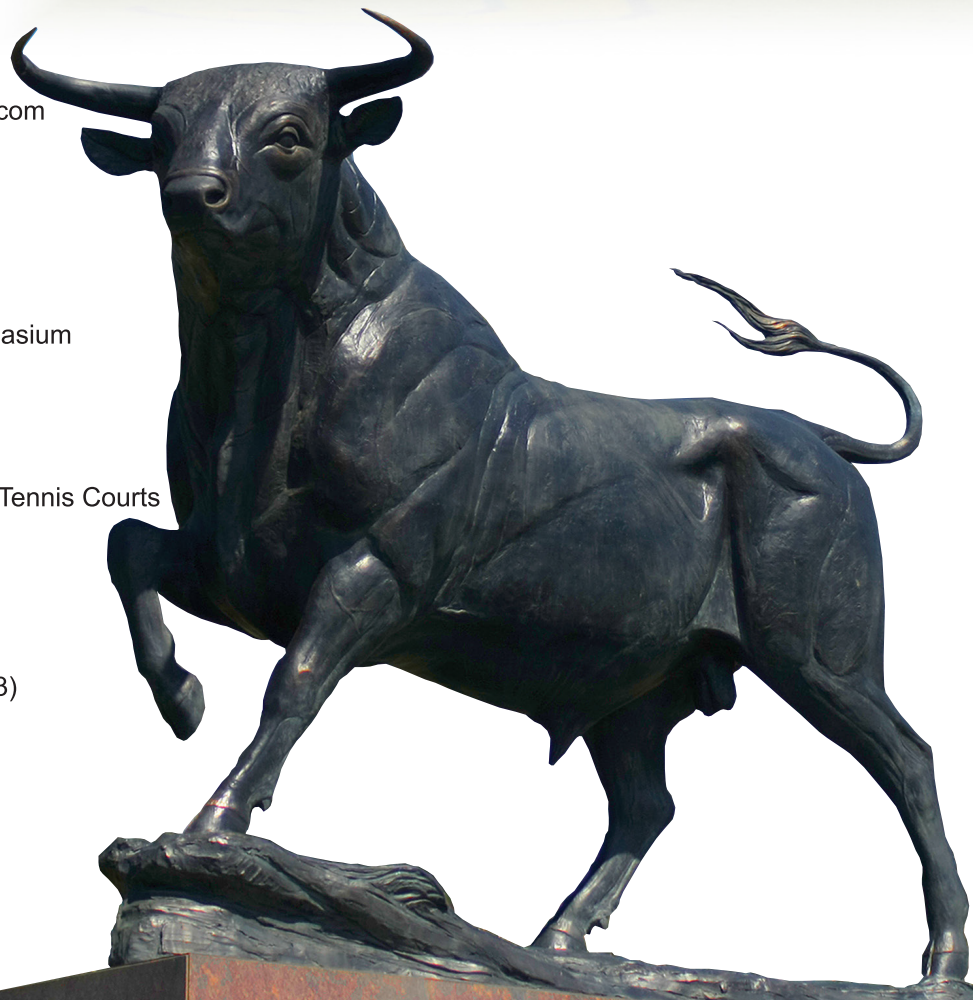
