The Matchup

JCSU makes the longest trip of the season, taking on Bowie State in a non-conference matchup. Last season, Bowie State downed JCSU 34-21 in sloppy conditions, thanks to the remnants of Hurricane Joaquin. JCSU enters the game after a 38-28 loss at Wingate while Bowie State fell 50-48 to Seton Hill.

Today's game will be the 736th game in school history.

Defensively Speaking

JCSU's defense preformed particularly well against Wingate's spread offense in week 1, forcing three interceptions and one sack. All-told JCSU forced four tackles for loss to go along with four pass breakups and six QB hurries. Carlo Thomas led the way with 13 tackles while Basir Wright had 11. Lineman Jamaal Tutt contributed 9 tackles with 1.5 being for loss. Fellow lineman Brice Smith provided the JCSU sack and finished with 2.0 tackles for loss.

Ball Hawk

Junior safety Carlo Thomas added two more interceptions to his mind-blowing career total. In his two seasons with the Golden Bulls, he now has 14 career interceptions, three of which have gone for scores.

Lane Throws For 227, Goes over 1000

Sophomore QB Jordan Lane came close to eclipsing his career-high against Wingate. He threw for 227 yards, just 24 yards shy of his career high (251) set last season at Winston-Salem State. With the 227 against Wingate, he now has 1,145 career passing yards on 88 completions.

Freshman 'Returns' Positive Results

Freshmen Desmond Dozier and Braxton Gambrell had impressive outings in their first collegiate game. Dozier caught two passes for 16 yards and had a 86 yard KO return for a score. Gambrell also did well on returns, providing three for 104 yards and a long of 43.

Dogs, Dogs, Dogs

JCSU's first three opponents this season are all canines, including the first two being Bulldogs. JCSU faces the Wofford Terriers on Sept. 17.

JCSU is 26-71-2 all time against schools with a dog as a mascot.

Kermit Blount enters his second season at the helm of the JCSU football program. In his first season, he improved the JCSU win total from the 2014 season by putting together a solid defensive team. He guided JCSU to a 37-20 upset win over then Southern Division leading Fayetteville State. That win over the Broncos was the first of three straight wins for JCSU. All told, the Golden Bulls won three of their last four games of the 2015 campaign.

Prior to coming to JCSU, he spent four seasons as the head coach at MEAC member Delaware State. While with the Hornets, Blount guided the DSU program to a 6-5 mark in 2012, including a 5-3 MEAC record. That season marked the most successful year since 2007 when Delaware State won the MEAC, finishing with a 10-2 record. In Blount's third season with the Hornets in 2013, they also finished with a 5-3 MEAC record.

Before his appointment at Delaware State, Blount served as head coach at Winston-Salem State, his alma mater. While at WSSU, Blount notched a career record of 91-87-3, leading the Rams to an 8-2 record in his final season at the helm in 2009. He guided the Rams to two Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association Championships and a total of three CIAA Championship game appearances. He also led the Rams to two Pioneer Bowl appearances, winning in 1999.

Blount was honored as the CIAA Coach of the Year and as the Washington D.C. Pigskin Coach of the Year, as well as the 100% Wrong Club Coach of the Year in both 1999 and 2000.

Throughout his coaching career, Blount has been associated with programs that have experienced phenomenal success. In all, he has been in a leadership role with teams that have won a total of six conference titles at both the NCAA Division I and Division II levels. He has also served as President of the CIAA Football Coaches Association.

Prior to becoming head coach at WSSU, Blount served as an assistant coach for five seasons at South Carolina State from 1989-1993, coaching the quarterbacks, wide receivers and acting as the Bulldogs' Offensive Coordinator. Blount also coached the quarterbacks at Howard University (1984-1989) and at East Carolina University (1983-1984). While at Howard, the Bison finished 9-1 and won the 1987 MEAC championship.

Blount holds a B.S. in health and physical education from Winston-Salem State University and later earned a Master's degree from East Carolina University.

A native of Richmond, Va., Blount is married to the former Ava Harris and has two children (April & Bryan) and two grandchildren

JCSU Comes Up Short Against Bowie State, 34-21

Charlotte, N.C. (Oct. 3, 2015)-- Plagued by six turnovers, including three fumbles and three interceptions, the JCSU football team fell to Bowie State 34-21 on a dreary and drenched Saturday afternoon at the Irwin Belk Complex in Charlotte, N.C.

Bowie State gained the early 7-0 lead after Jordan Garrison hauled in a 15 yard pass from Matthew Goggans. The scoring play capped a 10-play 61 yard drive for the Bulldogs. The BSU lead would swell to 14-0 after Goggans threw another touchdown pass, this one a 23 yarder to Nyme Manns with 11:57 remaining in the second quarter.

JCSU would respond immediately on the ensuing kickoff when **Carlo Thomas (East Orange, N.J.)** found a crease and raced 77 yards on the kickoff before being forced out at the Bulldog 10-yard line. Three plays later **Tromecio Summers (Charlotte, N.C.)** punched it in from one-yard out for the score. **Erik Amaya (Kannapolis, N.C.)** was true on the point after attempt to trim the BSU lead to 14-7 with 10:23 to play in the first half.

The JCSU defense would come up big on the next Bowie State drive, when **JeJuan McCalston (Covington, Ga.)** picked off the Goggans pass at the BSU 47 to thwart the drive. JCSU however could not capitalize on the turnover and had to punt. BSU jumped ahead 20-7 on their next drive, going 52 yards in five plays capped by a nine yard reception by Kerrick Pollock. The subsequent point after attempt was no good.

After a JCSU punt, the Golden Bulls defense forced a Goggans fumble on the first BSU play. JCSU's **James Hardman-Santiago (Flint, Mich.)** pounced on the loose ball, giving JCSU the ball with 1:50 remaining before the half. JCSU wasted no time as quarterback **Jordan Lane (Charlotte, N.C.)** tossed his first collegiate touchdown pass, a 24-yarder to a diving **Roderick Carter (Miami, Fla.)** in the back corner of the end zone. Amaya's kick was good, drawing JCSU to within 20-14.

The Golden Bulls defense would come through big again. On the first play of the BSU drive, Goggans was flushed out of the pocket by **Daron Wright (Atlanta, Ga.)**. Wright then jarred the ball loose and teammate **Javard Gaines (Hackensack, N.J.)** scooped it up and raced 40-yards for the touchdown. The point after gave JCSU the 21-20 lead with 39 seconds left before halftime. The Bulldogs then ran the clock out in the first half, with JCSU carrying the one-point advantage into the break.

Neither team was able to scratch across any points through most of the third quarter, but the Bulldogs finally found pay dirt, reclaiming the lead at 27-21 when Heleance Gates scooped up a JCSU fumble and raced 42 yards for the score.

In the fourth quarter, JCSU held Bowie State in check and had a chance for a game-winning drive late in the game, but Lane's pass was picked off by BSU's Anthony McDaniel at the JCSU 14-yard line. Two plays later, BSU was in the end zone, this time on a 10-yard run from Stephen Willis. The successful point after attempt made it 34-21 with 1:44 to play.

Bowie State would seal the game after Quinton Jordan stepped in front of a Jordan Lane pass, ending the Golden Bulls hopes of a late comeback.

Individually, JCSU's **Desean Binyard (Winston-Salem, N.C.)** finished with 44 yards on seven carries. Teammates Jamal Francois and Tromecio Summers each finished with 37 and 35 yards rushing, respectively.

Receiver Roderick Carter finished with five receptions for 64 yards, including a touchdown grab. Quarterback Jordan Lane went 8-for-21 for 65 yards and one touchdown toss. Lane threw three interceptions on the afternoon.

BSU quarterback Matthew Goggans was limited to 177 yards, the first time this season he has been held under the 300-yard mark. He finished 17-for-26 while tossing three touchdowns, being intercepted once.

The loss drops JCSU to 1-4 overall, 0-2 in CIIAA play while Bowie State improves to 4-1, 2-0 in league action.

THE COMMEMORATIVE CLASSIC

A 124-year-old historic rivalry began the authentic Black College Football Phenomenon. On December 27, 1892 Biddle Institute (Johnson C. Smith University) traveled to Livingstone College's Old Delta Grove campus in Salisbury, North Carolina. Though there was snow on the ground and it was only two days after Christmas, the teams forged their way to a historic moment in sports while writers recorded the results. A writer in the 1930 yearbook of Livingstone College provided a glimpse of that December experience.

According to historian T. M. Martin, the men of Biddle spent two years studying the sport of football. In 1892, they challenged the men of Livingstone, whose team was formally organized in the fall of that year. It is doubtful that when Biddle University and Livingstone College teed it up on December 27, 1892, in what was described as little more than a cow pasture, either team had the slightest inkling of the legacy they were about to give birth. Games of monumental historical significance, coaches of legendary proportions and players of extraordinary brilliance ultimately emerged from what was to become known as Historically Black Colleges and Universities.

The teams played two 45-minute halves on Livingstone's front lawn. W. J. Trent scored Livingstone's only touchdown on a fumble recovery. By then, snow covered the field's markings and Biddle argued that the fumble was recovered out of bounds. The official ruled in Biddle's favor, allowing them to keep the 4-0 lead that they established early on, giving JCSU the historic 1st victory! And the rivalry continues...
