### BREEDY BALLIN'

For the second game in a row, Brianna Breedy scored in double figures, including another efficient game from the floor (55% FG). She scored 11 points against Michigan after a 13-point outing against Robert Morris. Breedy is currently second on the team in field goal and three point percentages, and is Oakland's third leading scorer.

### TWO-WAY K

Kahlaijah Dean currently is fourth in the Horizon League in scoring (18.6) and fifth in steals (2.6) per game. Dean is one of two Horizon League athletes to be top five in both points and steals per game, the only other being reigning Player of The Year Macee Williams.

### WORRIED WOLVERINES

The first road test of the season came Monday, Nov. 22 for Oakland, as they took on the Michigan Wolverines in Ann Arbor. The No. 13 ranked Wolverines were undefeated coming in. They held a lead for most of the game, at one point reaching 18 points. Oakland went on a massive 11-0 run to open the fourth quarter to push the Wolverines to the brink, down one with five minutes remaining. The Wolverines pulled away, but not without a fight from the Golden Grizzlies. Kahlaijah Dean scored 15 points and Brianna Breedy added 11. Lamariyee Williams had nine points and a team-high three assists.

### FIRST HORIZON W

Oakland earned their first Horizon League win this season after defeating Robert Morris 65-60 on Saturday, Nov. 20. Kahlaijah Dean scored a game-high 22 points with four 3-pointers. The biggest three came with 4:18 remaining to take a one-point lead, after trailing the entire second half. After a timeout, Dean hit a big three to put the score at 59-58. Lamariyee Williams hit 4-4 free throws down the stretch to keep the lead.

### KICKING OFF HORIZON PLAY

Oakland fell in their Horizon League opener to Youngstown State, 79-68. The Golden Grizzlies went on a 19-4 run in the fourth quarter to try and recover from a 20-point deficit, but the lead was too much to overcome. Kahlaijah Dean led Oakland with 18 points and Lamariyee Williams recorded a career-high five steals.

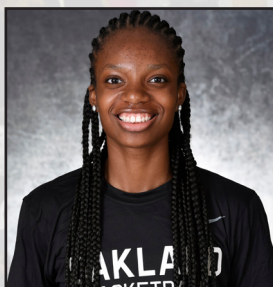

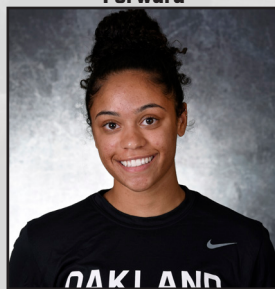

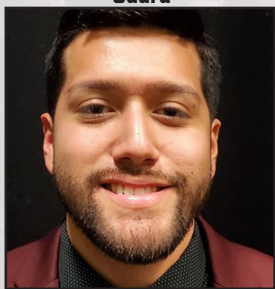

**GAME 7- OAKLAND 56 at MICHIGAN STATE 94**

Kahlajah Dean reached double figures for the sixth time in seven games with 15 points on 6-of-13 shooting and 3-for-3 from the free throw line while Brianna Breedy added seven points as Oakland fell, 94-56, at No. 25 Michigan State on Tuesday afternoon.

Dean also had a team-best four steals defensively and grabbed a team-high five rebounds along with Kayla Luchenbach. Breanne Beatty and Autumn Kissman each chipped in with six points each while Jalisha Terry added five points with a team-high four assists. C'erra Maholmes scored a season-high four points with East Lansing native, Lamariyee Williams adding two points.

Oakland (3-4) battled in the first quarter, which proved to be a defensive struggle, only trailing by only four points at 16-12. The Golden Grizzlies remained in striking distance scoring 19 points in the second quarter to trail by nine points at the half, 42-31.

The third quarter proved to be the difference as Michigan State (7-0) pulled away outscoring Oakland 31-16 aided by a 13-0 run to take a commanding 73-47 lead at the end of the frame. The Spartans then tacked on another 17-0 during the fourth quarter to remain undefeated on the season.





### SECOND TIME IS THE CHARM

In their second game of the season, Oakland defeated Niagara 77-64 in a wire-to-wire victory. The Golden Grizzlies jumped out to an early lead and refused to look back. Leading the way offensively were Breanne Beatty and Olivia Sims, each with 12 points. Kahlajah Dean made her defensive presence felt, grabbing five steals in a solid team defensive effort. Niagara was held to 38.5% from the floor and 20% from behind the arc as the Golden Grizzlies bounced back from their 84-72 loss vs. Toledo.

### POINT PRECIPITATION

The Golden Grizzlies currently rank third in the Horizon in points per game with 70.5 ppg. Last season, Oakland had the second-best offense in the league. Kahlajah Dean leads the team with 19 points per game this season.

### IN THE SEASON OPENER

Oakland took on MAC opponent Toledo in their season opener, losing 84-72 to the Rockets. After taking an early seven-point lead at the end of the first quarter, the Toledo offense warmed back up and evened the score. The Rockets had a 27-point third quarter they rode to a victory. Kahlajah Dean scored a game-high 27 points and hit five threes to go along with six assists. Kayla Luchenbach scored 13 points, Breanne Beatty led the team in rebounds (seven) and Breanna Perry blocked two shots. Freshmen Olivia Sims and Helen Staley made their debuts alongside sophomore transfer Aaliyah McQueen, who also made her Oakland debut.

### DEAN EARNS PRESEASON HORIZON LEAGUE FIRST TEAM HONORS

After earning Horizon League First Team honors for the 2020-21 season, Kahlajah Dean was voted a preseason All-Horizon first team athlete in October. Last season marked the third consecutive year Dean has garnered All-League honors after being named Sixth Player of the Year and All-League Third Team last season and named to the All-Freshman Team during the 2018-19 season. Dean is the first student-athlete to earn first team honors since Hannah Little in 2017.

### OAKLAND RUNS ON DEAN

Kahlajah Dean led the Golden Grizzlies in points, assists, rebounds and steals. She scored in double figures in 21 of 24 games, including eight 20-point performances. Her highest scoring performance came against Milwaukee on Feb. 13, where she dropped a career-high 34 points.

### FANTASTIC FOUR SEED

The Golden Grizzlies finished as the no. 4 seed in the Horizon League last season, their best conference finish since 2017 (T-3). Their 12-8 record marked the best Horizon League record since 2017 as well. The 12 wins tied Jeff Tungate's career-best as head coach.

### RUNNING AND GUNNING

Oakland scored 69.5 points per game in 2020-21, second best in the Horizon League. Led by Kahlajah Dean's 17.2 points per game, the Golden Grizzlies scored as a team. In 2020-21, six Golden Grizzlies scored five or more points per game.

### BOMBS BY BLACKWELL

In her second season, Alona Blackwell finished sixth in the league in 3-pointers made per game. Her 1.8 threes per game led the team and led to big scoring outbursts. Her five 3-pointers against Wright State on Dec. 19, 2020 was a career-high, and helped the Golden Grizzlies defeat the Raiders on the road, 75-69.

### DIME TIME

Oakland ranked second in the Horizon in total assists (360), assists per game (15) and assist to turnover ratio (1.01). The ball movement was spearheaded by Kahlajah Dean (106 total assists), Brianna Breedy (61) and Breanne Beatty (56). All three return this season.

### PRESEASON PREDICTION

Oakland was picked fifth in the Horizon League preseason poll, after finishing as the No. 4 overall seed last season. Kahlajah Dean was the only Golden Grizzly to be named to a preseason team, making the first team.

### PADAWANS AND JEDIS

Six freshmen are on the 2021-22 roster this season, the most Jeff Tungate has had on the roster since 2014-15. In addition to six freshmen, Oakland has four seniors and a graduate student on the roster, putting their roster at 11 seniors/freshmen.

### FRESHMAN FOCUS

Oakland's six freshmen athletes each come from unique places. Below is a quick summary of each freshman:

### CORE FOUR

The top four in minutes played from the 2020-21 season remain on the roster this season. Kahlajah Dean, Alona Blackwell, Breanne Beatty and Brianna Breedy were the only players to average more than 25 minutes per game, and they all returned. Together, the core four accounted for 54.7% of Oakland's offense last season.

### NO MERCY

Oakland's current win streak against Metro Series rival Detroit Mercy sits at eight. The eight-game win streak is the longest in program history. The last time Detroit defeated Oakland was Feb. 11, 2017.

### FILLING UP BUCKETS

The Golden Grizzlies' fast-paced offense led them to the second-best scoring offense in the conference last year, averaging 69.5 points per game. Oakland reached a season-high 84 points twice, with both big games coming in February (2/6 and 2/19). In total, Oakland scored more than 80 points six times in 2020-21.

### PROTECTING THE ROCK

Oakland ranked second in the Horizon League last season in both turnover margin and assist/turnover ratio. The Golden Grizzlies' 2.62 turnover margin was also 59th in the country out of 336 teams. Their 1.01 assist/turnover ratio was 76th in the nation as well.

### SECOND CHANCES

The Golden Grizzlies were second in the Horizon League in offensive rebounds, pulling down 12.1 offensive rebounds per game. Seven athletes brought in more than 20 offensive rebounds last season, and Kahlajah Dean ranked 12th in the conference in offensive rebounds per game.

### THREE BALL BONANZA

Oakland ranked sixth in the Horizon League last season in both 3-point field goal percentage and total threes, shooting 30% and making 6.2 threes per game.

### 2020-21 season highlights:

### SECOND HALF SURGE

Over the last 12 games of the 24-game season, Oakland went 8-4 en route to the No. 4 seed. In a season which featured back-to-backs in Horizon League play to limit COVID-19 spreading, Oakland swept half of their final six series, establishing consistency as the season went on.

### BREEDY BALL

Brianna Breedy started all 21 games she appeared in last season. The senior point guard was the most efficient free throw shooter on the team (80.8%) and ranked second on the team in assists per game (2.9). Breedy's 1.84 assist to turnover ratio led the team in 2020-21.

### DEAN DOWNS 'DONS

Nearly averaged a triple-double at 17.5 points, 9.5 rebounds and 9.0 assists per game and 2.5 blocks, helping Oakland to a weekend sweep over Purdue Fort Wayne, extending the win streak at the time to four.

### LUCKY NO. 13

Kahlajah Dean etched her name into the history books on Feb. 13. She scored 20 points in the fourth quarter en route to pouring in a new career-high 34 points (over half of Oakland's 64 points) on 10-of-24 (41.7%) shooting from the field, 4-for-9 (44.4%) from 3-point range and 10-of-11 (90.9%) from the free throw line. She

also grabbed a game-high nine rebounds with three assists at Milwaukee (2/13). With that performance, she became the 29th player in program history to reach 1000 career points.

#### BLACKWELL'S BIG NIGHT

Alona Blackwell set a career-high, hitting five of seven 3-pointers, which helped Oakland snap a 16-game skid vs Wright State. That was the first win over the Raiders since Feb. 11, 1989, and the team improved to 3-0 in Horizon League play for the first time in program history (12/19).

#### BEATTY CATCHING FIRE

Breanne Beatty, the team's best 3-point shooter in 2020-21, set a career-high in points (15) against the Youngstown State Penguins on Jan. 9, shooting 3-5 on threes and 5-8 overall.

#### NOT JUST A PASSER

Brianna Breedy poured in a career-high 16 points, including three 3-pointers in an 81-55 win over the UIC Flames. Breedy, who averaged 4.2 points per game in 2020-21, also hit a career-high five free throws against the Flames. Those three 3-pointers are another career best.

#### NEW YEAR, NEW RECORD FOR LUCHENBACH

On New Year's Day, Kayla Luchenbach recorded her second career double-double with 15 points and added a career-high 14 rebounds vs Green Bay. Her big day helped Oakland push the Phoenix to overtime, before losing 78-76 with a potential game-winning three rimming out.

#### BLOCKS BY BREANNA

Breanna Perry led the team in blocks per game (1.3) and total blocks (19). Her season-high in blocks came against Cleveland State on Jan. 30, when she sent four shots back against the Vikings.

#### PERRY CLEANING GLASS

Breanna Perry was second in rebounds per game for the Golden Grizzlies, pulling down 4.9 rpg. After missing the first nine games due to injury, Perry provided a boost for the Golden Grizzlies on the glass. Her season-high nine rebounds came against Milwaukee, in a game where she had nine points and hit the go-ahead free throw with two seconds left in overtime to secure the win on Feb. 13.

#### LUCKY SEVENS FOR SYDNEY

Sydney Gouard posted seven points with seven rebounds going a perfect 3-for-3 from the field vs UIC on Dec. 13. Gouard was one of five Golden Grizzlies to appear in every game during the 2020-21 season.

#### MAHOLMES VS MSU

Against the No. 25 MSU Spartans, C'Erra Maholmes put up four points, three rebounds and one block. Maholmes appeared in five contests, and returns this season as a graduate student.

#### END OF AN ERA

The Golden Grizzlies hosted their first quarterfinals game at the O'Rena last season, losing 86-64 to the IUPUI Jaguars. Kahlajah Dean and Autumn Kissman were the only players to score in double figures as Horizon League POY Macee Williams put up 28 points and nine rebounds.

# Jeff Tungate

## Head Coach - 9th Season

Jeff Tungate was named the head coach for the women's basketball team on July 16, 2013 and is currently in his ninth season at the helm having spent the previous six seasons as the associate head coach for the men's basketball program. In 2014, Tungate received the inaugural Oakland Athletics Coach of the Year award.

**2020-21:** Despite a year of uncertainty and COVID-19 protocols, the Oakland women's basketball team faced adversity head-on with a solid bounce-back 2020-21 season going 12-12 overall and 12-8 in Horizon League play which matched a program-best in league wins since the 2016-17 campaign. For the first time in program history, the No. 4 seed Golden Grizzlies also hosted a quarterfinal game against No. 5 seed and defending champion IUPUI in the 2021 HL Championships. Tungate also secured his 100th career win at home vs Robert Morris (2/6/21).

**2019-20:** Tungate led Oakland to a 2-2 mark to open the 2019-20 season before taking a medical leave of absence to care for a recurring back issue in which he missed seven games during the 2018-19 season due to the same condition. Oakland went on to finish 11-19 overall with a 6-12 mark in Horizon League play under the direction of Associate Head Coach Ke'Sha Blanton. The Golden Grizzlies made their seventh consecutive appearance in the Horizon League Tournament entering as the No. 8 seed before falling at No. 5 seed Milwaukee.

**2018-19:** Oakland went 6-24 overall with a 3-15 mark in Horizon League play. The Golden Grizzlies made their sixth consecutive appearance in the Horizon League Tournament entering as the No. 8 seed before falling to No. 1 seed Wright State. Tungate missed seven games due to a recurring back issue. In his absence, the team went 2-5 with wins over archrival Detroit Mercy to complete the series sweep over the Titans and UIC.

**2017-18:** Oakland finished the 2017-18 season with a 15-16 overall record and 7-11 conference mark. The Golden Grizzlies entered the Horizon League Tournament as the No. 7 seed and defeated No. 10 seed UIC (80-46) to earn the program's first HL tournament win before losing to No. 2 IUPUI (56-49).

**2016-17:** During the 2016-17 campaign, Tungate guided Oakland to a third-place tie with a 12-6 Horizon League record which marked the first time the Golden Grizzlies won 12 league games since joining the conference in the 2013-14 season. It also was the first time Oakland won 12 conference games since going 14-4 in the Summit League in 2009-10. The team averaged 76.6 ppg which ranked 19th nationally and closed out the regular season winning nine of their final 12 games.

Oakland also set the program school record in the Division I era with 12 wins by a margin of 20 points or more breaking the previous mark of nine in 2006-07. The win at YSU (2/23) also marked the first time in the Division I era the Golden Grizzlies have won four consecutive league games by a margin of 20 points or more. The Golden Grizzlies also defeated No. 21/24 Green Bay, 74-71, (Feb. 2) which marked Oakland's first home win over a ranked opponent since defeating No. 21 South Dakota State on Jan. 5, 2009. The win also snapped Green Bay's 11-game win streak and marked the second consecutive year the Golden Grizzlies defeated the Phoenix while being nationally ranked.

During Tungate's third season in 2015-16, Oakland ranked first in the league in field goal percentage 42.7%, second in the league in scoring 75.4 ppg and third in 3-point percentage 32.7%. With the win at Vermont (Dec. 30), the Golden Grizzlies concluded the non-conference regular season with an 8-3 record which tied the 2004-05 and 2008-09 teams for the best non-conference winning percentage (72.7%) to begin a season in the Division I era.

He also guided Oakland to a 77-69 win over Green Bay (Mar. 5) on senior day becoming only the second team since YSU in 2013-14 to sweep the Phoenix in conference play. The Golden Grizzlies also defeated #22 Green Bay, 58-56, (Jan. 28) which was Oakland's first win over a ranked opponent since defeating No. 21 South Dakota State, 67-51, on Jan. 5, 2009. The Golden Grizzlies also scored a single-game school record 123 points the opener versus NAIA UM Dearborn (Nov. 13) making a record 51 field goals while shooting 61.4 percent from the field.

Tungate also coached Olivia Nash who garnered All-Horizon League second team honors and Taylor Jones was an All-Freshman Team selection. Nash finished her career as the 27th player in program history to surpass 1,000 points and ranks first all-time in program history for most double-doubles in the Division I era with 32. He also coached Elena Popkey who also finished her career tied with Ann Serra (1988-90) for the most career assists in program history with 483, ranked sixth all-time in program history in 3-pointers made with 184 and was named the inaugural recipient of the Horizon League's Bobby Fong Award which embodies the league's core values of integrity, respect and stewardship.

In his second season, Tungate once again finished sixth in the 12th-ranked conference in the NCAA. He also coached back-to-back All-Horizon League defensive team selections as Sinclair Russell was named as an honoree after leading the league in blocks.

In his first season at the helm, Tungate led the Golden Grizzlies to its first non-losing season in league play since 2010-11. OU finished the season with a 8-8 record in its inaugural season in the Horizon League. He also implemented a new offense that averaged the most points per game since 2007-08 and the most total points in five seasons. He coached the first-ever All-Horizon League performers in Bethany Watterworth (2nd team) and Kim Bee (All-Defensive). He earned his first career victory as a Division I head coach on Nov. 27, 2013, defeating Niagara 71-57.

Tungate began his career as Assistant Girl's Basketball Coach at Clarkston High School followed by one season as Assistant Women's Basketball Coach at Oakland Community College working for Oakland Hall of Honor member Ann Serra. He spent seven seasons with the men's basketball program, six as associate head coach.

The Golden Grizzlies experienced unmatched success, making three NCAA tournaments and winning five Summit League championships during his tenure. In 2010, Tungate was an honorable mention selection by CollegeInsider.com for the top 25 mid-major assistant coaches. Over the course of his seven years with the men's program, Tungate worked with six players that played professional basketball, including OU's first-ever NBA Draft Pick Keith Benson, taken 48th overall by the Atlanta Hawks in 2011.
