## LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

**SENIOR NIGHT:** Tonight is the final home match for Goshen College senior Taylor Eash, the lone member of the class of 2021 on the Maple Leaf roster. Taylor has missed just three matches in her career and will don GC purple and white for the 109th time tonight.

**HELLO:** Huntington is the only remaining team in the Crossroads League that the Maple Leafs have not faced yet this season: this match was postponed on Saturday, Oct. 3, and moved from Huntington to Goshen. While Goshen's second matches against Spring Arbor and Mount Vernon Nazarene were canceled, those teams did meet as scheduled in the first half.

**HELPING HAND:** While the Foresters have yet to win a match this season, they rank 28th in the nation with 532 total assists and 32nd with 790 digs. The team has won 10 sets and taken at least one set in eight of 13 matches.

**UP NEXT:** Goshen travels to Grace for its antepenultimate road match of the season at 3 p.m. tomorrow before returning home to host Huntington again in a match at 5 p.m. next Wednesday. The regular season concludes next weekend after visits to Indiana Wesleyan and Taylor.

**SCHEDULE UPDATE:** The Crossroads League tournament has been pushed back three days and will now begin on Tuesday, Nov. 10, instead of Saturday, Nov. 7. The tournament will still wrap up on Saturday, Nov. 14. Because teams will finish the season with differing numbers of matches played, the tournament will be seeded by winning percentage.
