LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

YOU AGAIN?: Goshen and Marian meet for the second time in six nights following a match last Friday in Indianapolis. The Knights won that match in three sets. This is the first time that GC has played the same opponent in back-to-back matches since August 20 and 23, 2017, against Rochester College (now University). That ersatz doubleheader involved a tournament meeting, while this one involved a rescheduled match that was originally slated for Labor Day weekend.

ROUNDING THE CORNER: Wednesday's schedule marks the halfway point of the Crossroads League slate, with matches 43 through 46 of the 90-match fixture list taking place. In theory, that would mean that every school has played each opponent once, but several postponements have prevented that from happening as planned. The midpoint of Goshen's conference schedule and home schedule for the fall is the end of tonight's match.

UP NEXT: Goshen hosts Bethel University on Saturday in a U.S. Highway 20 Cup match. Bethel leads 2¼ to 1¼ this season and the half-point from this volleyball meeting could make up half of that difference. First serve is set for 3 p.m. right back here at Gunden Gymnasium. After that, the team heads to seventh-ranked Indiana Wesleyan next Wednesday for a 7 p.m. first serve.

SCHEDULE UPDATE: The Goshen-Huntington match that was postponed on October 3 will be made up on Friday, Oct. 30 at Goshen. First serve is set for 7 p.m.
