#### LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

**CHAP STICK:** Maple Leaf forward TaNiece Chapman ranked 30th in NAIA Division II last season with 3.4 offensive rebounds per game. This season, despite the merging of the two NAIA divisions, she is 27th in the nation with 10 rebounds per game and 35th on the offensive glass with 4.0 caroms per contest. She's also shooting .619 from the floor and averaging 13.5 points per game, which means her **average** performance is a double-double.

**AS MIKE BREEN WOULD SAY, "BANG":** Goshen ranks 18th in the NAIA with a 39.1 percent shooting mark from beyond the 3-point line.

**FROM THE HISTORY BOOKS:** Goshen and Indiana Tech were each members of the Mid-Central College Conference (now the Crossroads League) from 1970-78, when the Warriors left to become independent. The conference did not sponsor women's athletics at that time. Goshen is 12-13 all-time against Tech in a series that began in the 1977 state tournament of the Indiana Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women. The teams met again in 1985, then annually from 1988-91 and 1995-2011, but have not played since Dec. 15, 2011. That hiatus of 3,256 days (not that we were counting) ends tonight.

**UP NEXT:** After not playing a home game for 267 days, Goshen gets reacquainted with Gunden Gymnasium by hosting two games in five days. The team is scheduled to play the University of Rio Grande on Tuesday at 7 after tomorrow's game with Grace Christian was canceled.
