LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

AS MIKE BREEN WOULD SAY, "BANG": Goshen ranks 27th in the NAIA with a 35.7 percent shooting mark from beyond the 3-point line. Taylor leads the nation with 82 3-pointers made, an average of 11.7 per game, and has a 33.6 percent mark for 43rd place in the nation.

CHAP STICK: Maple Leaf forward TaNiece Chapman ranked 30th in NAIA Division II last season with 3.4 offensive rebounds per game. This season, despite the merging of the two NAIA divisions, she is 36th in the nation with 9.0 rebounds per game and 50th on the offensive glass with 3.7 caroms per contest. She's also shooting .567 from the floor, good for 43rd.

MORE WEEKND THAN THE GRAMMYS: Taylor was one of four Crossroads League teams to open its conference slate last Saturday, falling behind 18-8 at the quarter and 34-22 at intermission in a 65-59 loss to Marian. Kayla Kirtley matched her season high with 17 points and pulled down 7 rebounds to lead the team in each category.

UP NEXT: Despite having had 11 off days prior to tonight's game, the Maple Leafs will now sit idle for another 7 days over the Thanksgiving holiday as they join the rest of us in stuffing our faces with turkey and other traditional food products. The team's next game is Wednesday, Dec. 2, when Goshen hosts Indiana Wesleyan at 7 p.m.

SCHEDULE CHANGE: The game against Rio Grande that was postponed last week will now be played on Friday, Dec. 18 at 5 p.m., replacing a canceled game with Lourdes.
