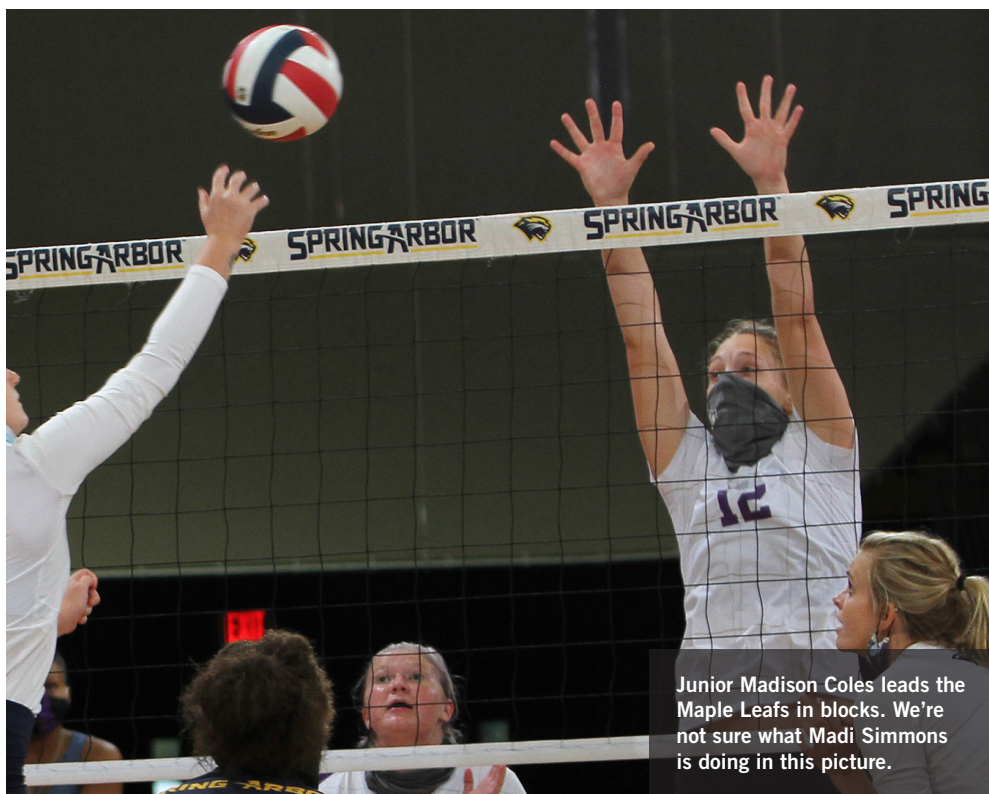

## LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

**ONE MORE TIME:** Tonight is the actual final home match for Goshen College senior Taylor Eash, the lone member of the class of 2021 on the Maple Leaf roster. Taylor has missed just three matches in her career and will don GC purple and white for the 110th time tonight. Senior Night festivities were held between sets 2 and 3 on Friday night and can be found on our YouTube channel if you look in the right places.

**DID WE NOT JUST DO THIS?:** Huntington defeated the Maple Leafs in four sets on Friday night in a match that included Goshen snapping a 40-set losing streak which dated back to last season. Madison Coles finished with a season-high 10 winners and Taylor Eash posted 2 blocks, including a solo, for Goshen. Abby Robinson led all players with 12 kills and Brea Metz had 10 for the Foresters. Jennings Tacosik led all players with 34 assists and 6 aces while Ariene Butler had a match-high 23 digs.

**UP NEXT:** Goshen finishes the regular season with matches tomorrow (at Indiana Wesleyan University) and Friday (at Taylor University). Both of those contests will begin at 7 p.m.

**SCHEDULE UPDATE:** The Crossroads League tournament has been pushed back three days and will now begin on Tuesday, Nov. 10, instead of Saturday, Nov. 7. The tournament will still wrap up on Saturday, Nov. 14. Because teams will finish the season with differing numbers of matches played, the tournament will be seeded by winning percentage.
