LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

GRAND LARCENY: Goshen College ranks 11th in the NAIA in total steals with 77, led by Michael Bowers, who is eighth among individuals with 19. Bowers also checks in at number 18 on the total-points list (159), 32nd in 3-pointers (19) and 46th in assists (28), pacing the team to 26th, 24th and 29th respectively in those categories.

HUMAN WINDEX: The Maple Leafs are becoming notorious for cleaning the glass, ranking 41st in the NAIA with 278 rebounds to their name this season. Phillip Hughes leads the team with 57 rebounds in 10 games played.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Spring Arbor has played just one of its first six games this season in the McDonald Athletic Center, thanks in part to Michigan's COVID-19 restrictions. Their only home game was more than a month ago on Nov. 4 and the team hasn't played in Michigan since Nov. 17.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Brandon Durnell leads SAU in points and rebounds, averaging 24.3 and 11.2 respectively. He has three double-doubles this season.

UP NEXT: Goshen returns to the floor on Wednesday night to host Huntington at 7 p.m. before traveling to Grace next Saturday in the final conference game before the Christmas break. At least that was the schedule when we made this program; stay tuned to GoLeafs.net for the latest developments as the world of scheduling in a pandemic continues to turn.
