LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Goshen has two juniors leading the team with 13.1 points per game. TaNiece Chapman is also seventh in the nation with 136 rebounds, an average of 9.7 per game, while Graysen Cockerham is 20th in the NAIA with 50 total assists. Cockerham is also relatively proficient as a rebounder, ranking 30th in the nation with 106 boards, while she leads the team with 50 assists to rank 20th in the country at this level.

AS MIKE BREEN WOULD SAY, "BANG": Goshen ranks 30th in the NAIA's newly-combined one-division format with a .346 mark from 3-point range this season. The Maple Leafs have 84 triples in their account, good for 39th in the nation, while Marian ranks 15th with 108.

NATIONAL REMATCH: Goshen and Marian both reached the Fab Four at the NAIA Division II national tournament in 2016, but did not meet: Marian went on to win the whole enchilada.

UP NEXT: Goshen travels to Grace for a 7 p.m. tip-off on Wednesday night before returning home Saturday to host Bethel University in another installment of the U.S. Highway 20 Cup. Goshen leads the rivalry trophy series 3¼-2¾ after the conclusion of the fall season. Tip-off is slated for 1 p.m. with the women playing in Goshen and the men in Mishawaka.

SCHEDULE CHANGES: The playing of today's game means that GC is down to one unresolved postponement: the game originally scheduled for Saturday, Dec. 5, at Spring Arbor has not yet been rescheduled. Stay tuned to GoLeafs.net for more schedule updates.
