LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

#FORTHECUP: Today's game is part of the U.S. Highway 20 Cup rivalry series; since Bethel and Goshen play twice in women's volleyball, the winning team will receive half a point in the standings. Goshen leads 3¼ to 2¾ after the fall season. The U.S. Highway 20 Cup awards points to the winning team in the Goshen-Bethel rivalry in the 15 sports shared by the two schools; Bethel won the inaugural edition of the Cup in 2019-20 with a 7½ to 3½ margin (4 sports went unplayed). Due to soccer cancellations this fall, the 2020-21 series will only have 14 points instead of 15, so the first school to 7¼ points wins the second edition of the cup.

NATIONAL LEADERS: Goshen ranks 17th in the NAIA for most rebounds this season, having retrieved 620 missed shots. TaNiece Chapman has accounted for more than a quarter of that total after grabbing 157 of them, which ranks sixth in the nation among individuals.

SERIES HISTORY: This is the 80th meeting between the Maple Leafs and the Pilots. Bethel leads the all-time series 50-29; the first game was Dec. 3, 1982.

UP NEXT: Goshen travels to Saint Francis at 7 p.m. Wednesday night to make up a game that was postponed in November. The Maple Leafs and Cougars will then meet again at 1 p.m. next Saturday here in Gunden Gymnasium in their regularly-scheduled second meeting, which is Goshen's antepenultimate home game of the regular season and might be the penultimate home game depending on what happens with Spring Arbor's schedule in Michigan.
