LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

LEAGUE HONORS: Goshen forward TaNiece Chapman was named Crossroads League player of the week on Monday after averaging 17.7 points and 9.0 rebounds a game last week while leading the Maple Leafs to wins over Grace and Bethel. Her best game, 21 points and 12 rebounds, actually came in a loss Monday against Marian. She leads the team with 13.9 points and 9.6 rebounds a game this season — with a big showing of 18 rebounds today, she would be **averaging** a double-double. She ranks eighth in the NAIA in rebounds.

HELLO AGAIN: Goshen and Saint Francis are playing back-to-back conference games against one another since the teams met Wednesday night in Fort Wayne in a makeup game. USF won that contest 56-49 behind 19 points from Cassidy Crawford and 16 from Reganne Pate.

JUST MAKE THE SHOTS: Saint Francis allows the third-fewest rebounds per game in the NAIA at 29.2, aided by a .448 field-goal percentage on offense.

UP NEXT: Goshen travels to Taylor at 5 p.m. Wednesday: the early start is necessitated by the playing of a doubleheader, which was mostly avoided this year due to COVID-19 but happened anyway because of final exam schedules in November. The team then returns home to host Spring Arbor next Saturday; that game is a non-conference contest as Spring Arbor has withdrawn from CL basketball this year due to Michigan COVID-19 protocols. Tip-off is still scheduled for 1 p.m. in Goshen's penultimate home game of the regular season.
