LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

SCHRÖDINGER'S BASKETBALL GAME: Today's game is not a Crossroads League game even though both schools are members of the Crossroads League and have been for more than 15 years. Spring Arbor is located in Michigan, where COVID-19 and its restrictions have wreaked havoc upon the Cougars' schedule. On Jan. 13, the league athletic directors voted to approve a plan that would count SAU's remaining games as non-conference affairs.

REBOUNDING MACHINES: Keyaira Murff picked up her 600th career rebound Wednesday night in a loss at Taylor, making her the seventh person in school history to reach that milestone after TaNiece Chapman did it earlier this season. Chapman has 625 boards and Murff has 600, which rank fifth and seventh in school history (separated by sixth-place Donna Porter who has 606). Graysen Cockerham has also retrieved 463 caroms and is on pace to reach the 600 mark sometime next season. The school record is 1,016 rebounds by Cassie Greives.

UP NEXT: The road gets more difficult for the Maple Leafs next week, partially because they have to go back on the road for four of their final five games and partially because the teams they have to play next week are good. Goshen travels to 19th-ranked Indiana Wesleyan in Marion on Wednesday for a game that tips off at 7 p.m. EST before visiting 5th-ranked Marian in Indianapolis on Saturday. The team's next home game is Wednesday, Feb. 17, when they host Huntington at 7 p.m. on Senior Night. This is also their final home game of the season.
