LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

BACA THE BLOCKER: Sophomore Amy Baca led Goshen with 5 blocks, a career high, on Wednesday night as the Maple Leafs won their third set of the conference season in a loss to Spring Arbor University in Michigan. The Tippecanoe Valley High School graduate ranks fourth on the team with 16 blocks this season. Maddy Beaver leads the team with 42.

SCHEDULE UPDATE: Goshen's tri-match at Rochester University that was postponed on Saturday, Oct. 2, has been rescheduled for Friday, Oct. 22, with Northwestern Ohio replacing Cornerstone as the third team in the rendezvous. That rescheduling brings the Maple Leafs back to the NAIA maximum of 28 match dates this season.

BRACKETOLOGY: Despite starting the season with an 11-2 conference record, Taylor has not yet clinched a top-four spot and quarterfinal host berth in next month's CL tournament; the Trojans could get most of the way there tonight with a win and a Bethel loss at Mount Vernon Nazarene. Goshen needs to make up three matches on eighth-place Grace to make the tournament; there are five matches left.

UP NEXT: Goshen plays its last conference home match of the season tomorrow afternoon at 3 p.m. when it hosts Mount Vernon Nazarene before playing its final three CL competitions on the road. The team's last remaining home match is Senior Day on Saturday, Oct. 23, when the Maple Leafs take on Saint Xavier University of Illinois at 1 p.m.
