## LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

**GOING OUT WITH A BANG:** Senior Madison Coles led Goshen with 5 kills in last night's loss to Taylor University. Classmate Naomi Willis paced the team with 9 digs.

**SCHEDULE UPDATE:** Goshen's tri-match at Rochester University that was postponed on Saturday, Oct. 2, has been rescheduled for Friday, Oct. 22, with Northwestern Ohio replacing Cornerstone as the third team in the rendezvous. That rescheduling brings the Maple Leafs back to the NAIA maximum of 28 match dates this season.

**BRACKETOLOGY:** Mount Vernon Nazarene could clinch a top-four seed in the conference and the right to host a first-round match in next month's league tournament with a win today and a Bethel loss to Saint Francis; this would appear to clinch a tie for fourth, but MVNU has the tiebreaker over Bethel after completing a season sweep last night. Meanwhile, although the definition of "mathematical elimination" is nebulous this year since a COVID-19 outbreak on any team could move the schools below it up a line, but if Goshen plans to participate in the conference tournament, the Maple Leafs would do themselves well to win as many remaining conference matches as possible.

**UP NEXT:** Goshen plays three road weeknight matches next week, traveling to Saint Francis for its antepenultimate conference match at 7 p.m. Wednesday before taking part in the aforementioned tri-match at Rochester on Friday. The team's next home match is also its last one, which means it is Senior Day when St. Xavier University visits Saturday at 1 p.m.
