LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

GOING OUT WITH A BANG: Senior Madison Coles racked up 11 kills and 4 blocks last night in a 5-set loss to Rochester University; at 16-14 in the fifth set, it was as close as the match could be without entering extra points. Classmate Naomi Willis registered 15 assists. Coles led the team with 3 blocks while Willis also had 12 assists and an ace earlier in the tri-match as Goshen snapped its losing streak with a straight-set win over Northwestern Ohio.

STILL A BANG, BUT NOT GOING OUT: Outside of Coles and sophomore Brielle Agnew, each of Goshen's leaders in major stat categories yesterday was a freshman. Sadie Brenneman finished with 20 kills in the two matches and Emily Lynch had 14 in the Rochester match, which also included Brenneman sweeping up 28 digs and Maddy Beaver putting up 7 blocks. Jaelyn Amhdar led the team in assists in both matches with 40 for the day.

SERIES HISTORY: This is the first meeting between Goshen and St. Xavier since 2017, when the Cougars topped the Maple Leafs in straight sets at the Huntington Invitational. SXU's last visit to Gunden Gymnasium came in 2012, which the Cougars also won in three sets; Goshen's last visit to the Shannon Center was the year before that in 2011.

UP NEXT: Goshen plays a pair of road matches next week to wrap up the 2021 season, visiting Grace at 7 p.m. Wednesday and Huntington at 3 p.m. Saturday. The 2022 season will begin in August; visit GoLeafs.net during the summer to learn about the schedule.
