#### LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

**MOVEMBER DAY:** Today's game has been designated as Movember Day by the Maple Leafs, with players and staff sporting mustaches to support the Movember cause, which uses the aforementioned facial hair to raise awareness (and hopefully funds) for prostate cancer research. Prostate cancer is the second-most common cancer for men in the U.S.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Today's game marks the end of a three-game road trip that was not kind to the Maple Leafs as they lost all three games, although one of those losses (to Eastern Michigan) was an exhibition against an NCAA Division I opponent that will not count in Goshen's final statistics. Goshen is actually shooting at a slightly higher percentage on the road (.474) than it is at home (.469), but the team's 3-point shooting and turnover figures have both taken a hit when playing in other facilities.

**SERIES HISTORY:** Goshen sports a 5-1 record against Madonna in the last 15 years, although the Crusaders won the most recent game by a 65-64 margin on Dec. 17, 2014.

**UP NEXT:** Goshen travels to a state (Illinois) whose nickname comes from one president (Land of Lincoln) to play a school named for another president (Roosevelt) on Tuesday at 7 p.m. EST. Next weekend, the team returns home to play Spring Arbor in its conference opener at 3 p.m. Saturday. That matchup also has presidential history: Goshen and SAU canceled their scheduled 1963 meeting when Kennedy was assassinated the day before.
