LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

JUST KEEP PLAYING UNTIL IT GETS DARK: Tuesday's opening set, a 33-31 epic with Indiana Tech that was tied 13 times, was the longest set in the history of Goshen College men's volleyball as the teams combined for 43 kills on 89 attacks. The previous record was 29-27.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM: The Maple Leafs were ranked 15th in the nation in the NAIA coaches poll that came out Wednesday morning, marking the third straight time that Goshen has been in the national top 15. Men's volleyball is the first GC sport on record to appear in the top 15 of three straight coaches polls, although not all sports have polls and in many cases the polls only started in the 1990s.

PODIUM FINISHES: Goshen ranks second in the NAIA in aces, blocks and digs as a team, while Alexander Rabadzhiev leads the country with 28 aces individually. He is also second in the nation in kills while Michael Wahl is second in assists. Andy Bennett, Brayton Yoder and Lucas Sauder are also in the national top 5 in something individually.

UP NEXT: Goshen must put this match on the back burner quickly as the team hosts Maranatha Baptist University of Wisconsin tomorrow at 3 p.m.; it is believed to be the first meeting between the Maple Leafs and Sabercats in any sport. Following a visit to Indiana Tech next Wednesday (not Tuesday), the team will return home next weekend to play Judson. After next weekend, the team has six regular-season matches left: three at home and three on the road.
