

LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

MILLENNIAL UPDATE: A pair of Maple Leafs scored their 1,000th career point in the last month. Tahj Curry hit the milestone on Saturday, Jan. 23 at Saint Francis before Austin Branagan did it last Wednesday at Taylor. Curry now has 1,088 points, of which 286 came in his first two seasons at Ohio Dominican, while Branagan has 1,017 points, all at GC. The latter figure ranks 28th in program history, between Jim Gingerich '66 at 1,042 and Moe Miller '71 at 1,004. There are 29 Maple Leafs who have scored 1,000 points at Goshen, which includes 20 players in the 1,100-point club and eight who have reached 1,500. Errick McCollum '10 (2,789) and Eric Walsh '06 (2,277) lead the program's record book.

SCOUTING IWU: Indiana Wesleyan guard Kyle Mangas leads the NAIA in scoring and is second in assists, 10th in rebounds and 11th in steals. His 3,218 career points are the second-most of any player who has played college basketball in Indiana, trailing only Steve Platt (Huntington '74), who had 3,400. (Larry Bird scored 2,850 points in three seasons at Indiana State.) At his current rate of 29.6 points per game, Mangas would catch Platt by the end of the month. The Wildcats also have 13 other players and 42 NAIA top-50 rankings.

UP NEXT: After playing seven of its last eight games on the road, Goshen closes with four of its final five games in Ruth Gunden Gymnasium to end the regular season. Unfortunately for the Maple Leafs, three of those four come against nationally-ranked opponents. The Maple Leafs host 18th-ranked Marian University on Saturday at 1 p.m.
