## CROSSROADS LEAGUE SERIES FORMAT

The Crossroads League season consists of each school playing a doubleheader at each other school for a total of 36 games. All college softball games are scheduled for 7 innings and played by NCAA rules.

**Inclement Weather:** The game is considered complete when it is called if the trailing team has batted in the fifth inning. If it has not reached that point, it must be suspended and finished later. All games that cannot be completed by Monday, May 3 will be wiped out. If the visiting team scores to take the lead but the home team has not finished its half of the inning, the score reverts to the previous inning.

**Run Rule:** The game is over if one team leads by 8 or more runs after 5 innings.

**Extra Innings:** The eighth and ninth innings, if necessary, are played under usual rules. If a game reaches the 10th inning, the last batter of the previous inning is placed on second base under the international tiebreaker rule. This procedure is used in all innings beyond the 10th as well.
