## LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

**HELLO, MY NAME IS:** None of Goshen's major statistical category leaders (see lower left corner of opposite page) played for the team in 2020. Naomi Willis and Gwyn Bellamy were each on the roster but redshirting, while Maddy Beaver, Sadie Brenneman and Emily Lynch are all in their first semester at GC.

**RUNNING THE GAUNTLET AT THE BEGINNING:** The Crossroads League schedule makers did not do Goshen any favors in their preparations for this fall, as GC's first two home matches are each against ranked squads in #13 Marian and #25 Bethel. The other ranked team in the league is Indiana Wesleyan, which is #16 and which will visit Goshen in the first week of October.

**VARIETY IN SCHEDULING:** After a 2020 season that was shortened to 15 matches, all in conference, due to COVID-19, the 2021 Goshen schedule consists of 36 matches and is already a quarter complete. Seventeen of GC's 18 non-conference matches are in some sort of tournament; the exception is a standalone match with St. Xavier in October.

**UP NEXT:** Goshen travels to the Rittenmeyer Center at Calumet College of St. Joseph in Whiting, Indiana, this weekend, to play in a tri-match with the host Crimson Wave and visiting Bluefield State College of West Virginia. Goshen's matches are set for 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. EDT, subject to the length of the previous matches. The team will return home next Wednesday to meet Bethel University at 7 p.m. in a U.S. Highway 20 Cup series match.
