## LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

**SERIES HISTORY:** The Maple Leafs and Cougars have traded runs in the head-to-head series since 2007. After a 9-0 Goshen run from 2007-12, Saint Francis won three matches in a row from 2013-14. Goshen answered by winning four straight matches to get into the middle of the 2016 season, but now USF has won nine consecutive matches of its own.

**HELLO, MY NAME IS:** None of Goshen's major statistical category leaders (see lower left corner of opposite page) played for the team in 2020. Sadie Brenneman, Emma Dippon and Emily Lynch are all first-year students while Naomi Willis is a senior who missed last season with an injury.

**UNCOMMON COMMON FOES:** While Goshen and Saint Francis, by virtue of being in the same conference, share the same possible set of non-conference opponents, they have not played any of the same teams in their 11 non-conference matches apiece so far this season. The teams share four common foes in conference play so far, losing to Bethel, Indiana Wesleyan, Marian and Mount Vernon Nazarene. By the end of next week, all 10 Crossroads League teams will have played each other once.

**UP NEXT:** Goshen plays its next two matches at home, meeting Grace College on Wednesday at 7 p.m. and Huntington on Friday at 7 p.m., before going to Marian University in a road match next Saturday to start the second half of the conference season.
