## LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

SERIES HISTORY: Among the five schools that Goshen played in its first season of intercollegiate women's volleyball in 1970, Grace is the only one that has appeared on every subsequent regular-season schedule. Grace has won six of the last seven meetings between the two teams dating back to Sept. 20, 2017; the last time Goshen defended its home floor was Oct. 5, 2016, in a three-set win. The Lancers hold a 37-34 lead in head-to-head meetings.

LOGJAM: The Maple Leafs have three players tied for the team lead with 24 blocks through the team's first 57 sets of the season. Emily Lynch has 5 solos and 19 assists while Emma Dippon has 4 solos against 20 assists and Maddy Beaver owns 2 solos and 22 assists. Beaver and Lynch have each played in 54 of the 57 sets while Dippon has playes in 47.

TURNING THE CORNER: The end of Friday night's conference slate marks the midpoint of the 2021 Crossroads League volleyball season, when every team will have played each opponent once and will play each of them again at the opposite site. At the end of the regular season on Saturday, Oct. 30, the top eight schools will advance to the CL tournament.

**UP NEXT:** The Maple Leafs wrap up their three-match homestand Friday evening when they host Huntington at 7 p.m., reaching the midpoint of their Crossroads League schedule. Goshen proceeds to play nine of its next 10 matches in other venues: its only other home match in the next three weeks is Wednesday, Oct. 6 against Indiana Wesleyan.
