## LOWDOWN ON THE SHOWDOWN

SERIES HISTORY: The Maple Leafs and Foresters are meeting for the 51st consecutive season tonight with Goshen holding a 37-35-1 lead in the all-time series. The tie happened in the first meeting between the two schools in 1971. Huntington has won eight of the last nine matches in the series, but GC won eight of the 10 matches from 2010-14.

IRON WOMEN: Sadie Brenneman, who leads the team with 157 digs and 21 aces, and Gwyn Bellamy, who posted her first career double-double Wednesday night with 10 kills and 10 digs in a loss to Grace, are the only two Maple Leafs who have played in all 61 of the team's sets this season. Naomi Willis has played in 60, Christina Towne in 59, and Maddy Beaver and Emily Lynch in 58 apiece.

TURNING THE CORNER: The end of Friday night's conference slate marks the midpoint of the 2021 Crossroads League volleyball season, when every team will have played each opponent once and will play each of them again at the opposite site. At the end of the regular season on Saturday, Oct. 30, the top eight schools will advance to the CL tournament.

**UP NEXT:** Goshen is back in action tomorrow at NAIA no. 8 Marian as the Maple Leafs start the second half of their non-conference schedule: the game kicks off at the slightly unusual hour of 5 p.m. EDT because MU has a home football game later in the day. That starts a stretch of nine road matches in the next 10 for Goshen; the only home game in that span is a date with Indiana Wesleyan University at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 6.
