Welcome back, Adam

Adam Anhold checked in for the first time this season in Western's Summit-opening weekend versus North Dakota State. The Highland transfer joined the Leathernecks ahead of the 2020-21 season and was sidelined early after sustaining a knee injury during the preseason.

He recorded a rebound and a steal in game one of the two-game set versus NDSU before pouring in nine points, three boards, and a block in the finale.

On the Board

The Leathernecks -- previously ranked as high as 10th in the NCAA -- are currently 49th in the nation in offensive rebounds per game (12.89). Western leads the Summit in the category, guided by Will Carius (3.00) and Tamell Pearson (2.67).

A little History

Western knocked off the Jackrabbits, 79-76, in the quarterfinal round of the 2019 Summit League Tournament to become the first No. 8 seed in league history to upset the top seed.

SDSU leads the all-time series, 27-5.

Starting Five

Tamell Pearson, Will Carius, and Rod Johnson Jr. have started all nine games. The Leatherneck coaching staff has explored two different lineups this season, and Anthony Jones and Justin Brookens join the trio as the most popular (five out of nine contests).

Offensive Production

Western Illinois is one of three programs in the Summit with at least three players averaging double-figures. Tamell Pearson guides the Leathernecks' offense with 12.8 PPG, Will Carius adds 11.3 and Justin Brookens 10.0.

History Made

Welcome to the WIU record book, Justin Brookens. It didn't take long for the junior transfer to cement his spot in Leatherneck history -- just five games to be exact -- as a 37-point performance at Eastern Illinois tied for second-most in Western's single-game Division I history.

Coincidentally, the program's all-time leading scorer Joe Dykstra previously recorded the mark against EIU in 1983.

Basketball Background

Basketball is in Rod Johnson Jr.'s DNA. His parents, Roderick Sr. and Stacy, played collegiately -- Stacy was a two-year letter-winner in 51 games at Wisconsin-Milwaukee where Roderick Sr. also suited up before transferring to Southeast Missouri. He averaged 12.8 points and 6.7 rebounds in 103 collegiate games and also played professionally overseas in Poland.

Rod Jr.'s brother Jalen is enjoying his freshman season at Duke and his brother Kobe recently committed to play for USC.

The Connections

Rob Jeter & Chad Boudreau - coached together at the University of Milwaukee from 2005-16, where Boudreau served as an assistant on Jeter's staff ... the Panthers won the Horizon League Championships in 2006, 2011, and 2014, and qualified for six postseason tournaments during the 11-year stretch

Highland Community College - Boudreau spent three seasons as the head coach at Highland and Kyle Heikkinen was his assistant ... together, they led the Cougars to three consecutive Arrowhead Conference titles with undefeated conference records in 2019 and 2020 ... Cameron Burrell, Adam Anhold, and J.J. Flores are Highland alums who played under Boudreau

Morgan Park - Nick Irvin headed to WIU after coaching one of the most successful boys' basketball programs in Illinois history ... Morgan Park was also home to Leathernecks' Tamell Pearson, Cameron Burrell, and Marcus Watson Jr. ... Irvin won at least 20 games in all 12 seasons at the helm of the program, with two separate, back-to-back IHSA Class 3A state title runs in 2013-2014 and 2017-18 ... Burrell and Pearson were members of the 2017 and 2018 Morgan Park state championship teams

Father / Son - In Rob Jeter's 20-plus year career, he has never competitively coached his son, Robert Jeter IV, until now; the two begin their Leatherneck journey together, and the 2020-21 season also marks the beginning of Jeter IV's collegiate journey.

One Last Ride

Seniors Anthony Jones and Jake Weyhrich are the lone returners from Western's 2019-20 roster. Last year, in his first season with the team, Jones led the Leatherneck bench with 5.0 points per game in 24 appearances, while Wehyrich played limited minutes in six.

The Third and The Fourth

There are 16 father/son duos in NCAA Division I basket-ball. The Jeters joined the list ahead of the 2020-21 season -- their first at WIU.

WHAT IS A LEATHERNECK

Western Illinois holds the distinction of being the only non-military institution to officially have its nickname derived from a branch of the military service. The school began use of the Marine Corps' official nickname, "The Fighting Leathernecks", in 1927 when then-athletic director and head baseball, basketball and football coach Ray "Rock" Hanson was granted permission by the U.S. Navy, based on his status as a Marine hero, to use the nickname.

HEAD COACH ROB JETER



Wherever Rob Jeter goes, success is sure to follow, and on March 30, 2020, his next stop became Western Illinois University.

Jeter was tabbed as the Leathernecks' 21st head men's basketball coach, carrying with him 25 years of coaching experience and seven NCAA Tournament appearances. His previous stops included the University of Minnesota, University of Nevada-Las Vegas, and a head coaching stint at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

At the helm of his own program, Jeter was a three-time coach of the year. Eleven seasons at Milwaukee captured five seasons with 20 or more wins, Coach of the Year honors from the Horizon League (2011) and the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association (2006,2011), and two NCAA Tournament berths. His first Panther squad registered a first-round victory over the University of Oklahoma in the 2006 NCAA Tournament.

Jeter's most recent trip to the NCAAs occurred in 2019 as an assistant at Minnesota. The Gophers ended their season in the second round but earned their first tournament win in six years to go alongside another 20-win season (22-14).

In his two-year stint, Jeter was responsible for all aspects of the program, from recruiting to skill development, and he worked extensively

with the Gophers' backcourt and defense. He helped coach Amir Coffey and Marcus Carr to All-Big Ten honors in 2019 and 2020, respectively. Coffey is currently with the NBA's Los Angeles Clippers on a two-way contract with the Agua Caliente Clippers of the NBA G League.

Prior to Minnesota, Jeter was on staff at UNLV from 2016-18. The Runnin' Rebels doubled their wins in year two to produce a 20-win season, and Jeter had a hand in recruiting the 12th-best class in the country that included McDonald's High School All-American Brandon McCoy and National Junior College Player of the Year Shakur Juiston.

Jeter left Milwaukee (2005-2016) as its all-time winningest coach (Division I era) with an overall record of 185-170. The Panthers claimed the Horizon League's regular-season titles in 2006 and 2011 and tournament titles in 2006 and 2014.

Before running his own ship, Jeter was an assistant coach under Bo Ryan at Wisconsin (2001-05), UWM (1999-01), and Wisconsin-Platteville (1994-98). He was also an assistant at Marquette (1998-99) under Mike Deane.

At Wisconsin, Jeter helped the Badgers to remarkable success with two regular season Big Ten championships and a Big Ten Tournament title. Wisconsin made four-straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including berths in the Sweet 16 in 2003 and the Elite Eight in 2005.

Jeter played college basketball for Ryan at UW-Platteville and captained his team to the NCAA Division III title in 1991. He earned his bachelor's degree in 1991 and went on to earn a master's from UWP in 2001.

Jeter was inducted into the UW-Platteville Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006 and was also inducted into the inaugural hall of fame class for the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. He became a three-time HOFer in 2013 when Platteville's 1991 national championship team received the school's highest honor.
