### Luka's on a Roll

Luka Barisic has been a scoring machine for Western Illinois over the last four games, with four straight performances of 20 or more points. Over his last six games he's averaging 20.8 points while shooting over 44.0 percent from three, and been a force on the glass with an average 8.7 rebounds per contest - a including three double-doubles. The Osijek, Croatia native ranks 13th in the Summit League in scoring and tenth in rebounding.

### **Elite Offense**

Western Illinois continues to be one of the best scoring teams in the country, currently 20th in the nation in scoring at 79.8 points per game. Western Illinois has four players scoring above double figures and is one of three teams in the nation with four players scoring 13 plus points per game, led by Trenton Massner (16.4), Will Carius (15.3), Luka Barisic (14.9) and Colton Sandage (13.9).

### Sandage's Efficiency

Colton Sandage continues to be an efficient scorer for Western Illinois in Summit League play. Sandage has shot 51.0 percent over his last five games and 43.3 percent from downtown, and had a huge game last week vs North Dakota State with 27 points on 8-18 shooting and 6-12 from three.

# **Earning his Time**

KJ Lee has played a huge role off the Leatherneck bench in the team's last three games, averaging 24.3 minutes per contest - including a season-best 32 against North Dakota State on Thursday (Feb. 10). A true freshman from O'Fallon, Mo., Lee was tasked with guarding former Second Team All-Summit Leaguer Sam Griesel in the double-overtime loss, and coach Jeter said after the game that Lee had proven himself as a player who is ready to be a contributor on this team.

# Winning Basketball

After defeating North Dakota on Saturday, Western Illinois won its 15th game of the season and guaranteed that the team will finish the regular season with a .500 or better winning percentage. This is the first time since the 2012-13 season that a Leatherneck men's basketball team can claim that honor, despite it being just year two under head coach Rob Jeter.

# **Doing it All**

Trenton Massner has done a little bit of everything for Western Illinois this season, as he leads the Leathernecks in all categories besides rebounds. Massner leads the team with 16.8 points per game, 4.1 assists per game, 1.7 steals per game, and 0.6 blocks per game. Massner trails Tamell Pearson in rebounds per game, who leads the Leathernecks with 6.5 boards per game. Massner's numbers have him sitting at second in the summit league in scoring, second in assists, first in steals, and eighth in rebounding.

### What is a Leatherneck?

Western Illinois holds the distinction of being the only non-military institution to officially have its nickname derived from a branch of the military service. The school began the use of the Marine Corps' official nickname, "The Fighting Leathernecks", in 1927 when athletic director and head baseball, basketball and football coach Ray "Rock" Hanson was granted permission by the U.S. Navy, based on his status as a Marine hero, to use the nickname.

# **The Hall**

Nicknamed The Hall, Western Hall has been a successful home for both Western Illinois basketball teams. Western Hall is one of 11 college basketball venues in the country to have the name "Hall" in it, and the Leathernecks have played there since the 1977-78 season. The Leathernecks hold a winning record when playing at home this season.

# **HEAD COACH ROB JETER**



Wherever Rob Jeter goes, success is sure to follow, and on March 30, 2020, his next stop became Western Illinois University.

Jeter was tabbed as the Leathernecks' 21st head men's basketball coach, carrying with him 25 years of coaching experience and seven NCAA Tournament appearances. His previous stops included the University of Minnesota, University of Nevada-Las Vegas, and a head coaching stint at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

At the helm of his own program, Jeter was a three-time coach of the year. Eleven seasons at Milwaukee captured five seasons with 20 or more wins, Coach of the Year honors from the Horizon League (2011) and the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association (2006,2011), and two NCAA Tournament berths. His first Panther squad registered a first-round victory over the University of Oklahoma in the 2006 NCAA Tournament.

Jeter's most recent trip to the NCAAs occurred in 2019 as an assistant at Minnesota. The Gophers ended their season in the second round but earned their first tournament win in six years to go alongside another 20-win season (22-14).

In his two-year stint, Jeter was responsible for all aspects of the program, from recruiting to skill development, and he worked extensively with the Gophers' backcourt and defense. He helped coach Amir Coffey and Marcus Carr to All-Big Ten honors in 2019 and 2020, respectively.

Coffey is currently with the NBA's Los Angeles Clippers on a two-way contract with the Agua Caliente Clippers of the NBA G League.

Prior to Minnesota, Jeter was on staff at UNLV from 2016-18. The Runnin' Rebels doubled their wins in year two to produce a 20-win season, and Jeter had a hand in recruiting the 12th-best class in the country that included McDonald's High School All-American Brandon McCoy and National Junior College Player of the Year Shakur Juiston.

Jeter left Milwaukee (2005-2016) as its all-time winningest coach (Division I era) with an overall record of 185-170. The Panthers claimed the Horizon League's regular-season titles in 2006 and 2011 and tournament titles in 2006 and 2014.

Before running his own ship, Jeter was an assistant coach under Bo Ryan at Wisconsin (2001-05), UWM (1999-01), and Wisconsin-Platteville (1994-98). He was also an assistant at Marquette (1998-99) under Mike Deane.

At Wisconsin, Jeter helped the Badgers to remarkable success with two regular season Big Ten championships and a Big Ten Tournament title. Wisconsin made four-straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including berths in the Sweet 16 in 2003 and the Elite Eight in 2005.

Jeter played college basketball for Ryan at UW-Platteville and captained his team to the NCAA Division III title in 1991. He earned his bachelor's degree in 1991 and went on to earn a master's from UWP in 2001.

Jeter was inducted into the UW-Platteville Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006 and was also inducted into the inaugural hall of fame class for the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. He became a three-time HOFer in 2013 when Platteville's 1991 national championship team received the school's highest honor.

# PLRYING CRREER

Jeter's collegiate career started at UW-Platteville, where he played for Bo Ryan from 1987-91 and captained the team to the 1991 NCAA Division III title while being named to the All-Final Four team. A two-time All-WSUC selection and two-time All-Midwest Region choice, Jeter held UW-Platteville records for career field goal percentage (.601) and consecutive starts (89) and was named to the WSUC honor roll three times. He spent one season playing professional basketball overseas, playing for the Olivias Futebol Clube in 1992-93 and leading the Portuguese league in scoring.
