- The Leathernecks snapped a three-game losing streak on Saturday, topping Denver 91-74. Trenton Massner and Alec Rosner each scored season-highs, with Massner dropping 29 and Rosner adding 28.

- Western Illinois went 1-2 vs. ORU last year, winning in Tulsa, but losing in Macomb and at the Summit League Tournament. KC swept WIU last season.

- After this week's trip, the Leathernecks begin a four-game homestand next week. WIU hosts St. Thomas (Jan. 21), North Dakota (Jan. 23), South Dakota (Jan. 26) and South Dakota State (Jan. 28) at Western Hall.

Leathernecks visit ORU, KC this week

MACOMB – The Western Illinois men's basketball team hits the road this week, playing a pair of Summit League contests away from Western Hall. The Leathernecks look to snap a two-game conference road losing streak, taking on league-leading Oral Roberts on Thursday and Kansas City on Saturday.

Last time out:

The Leathernecks ended a three-game losing streak on Saturday, topping Denver 91-74. Trenton Massner and Alec Rosner led the way, scoring individual team-highs for the season. Massner finished with 29 while Rosner contributed 28.

Denver cut a 13-point WIU lead to five with under six minutes to play, but a 10-0 Leatherneck run fueled by eight points from Rosner allowed Western to take control of the game.

The Leathernecks went 31-62 from the field (50 percent) and 12-24 (50 percent) from three.

About the Leathernecks:

Massner comes in leading the team in scoring, averaging 16.4 points per game. Rosner adds 15.8 points per game for the cause. Jesiah West contributes 10.9, while Vuk Stevanic adds 10.6 and Quinlan Bennett chips in 8.9. Off the bench, Elijah Farr is scoring 4.9 per game. West leads WIU on the glass with 6.1 rebounds a night.

As a team, WIU is scoring 76.6 per game while allowing 72.3. Western Illinois is shooting 45.8 percent from the floor, including 32.2 from three. Leatherneck foes are making 31.5 percent of their threes while making 45.8 percent overall.

About the Golden Eagles:

Oral Roberts comes into the game unbeaten in Summit League play at 4-0. The Golden Eagles lost to nationally-ranked New Mexico on Monday night. Oral Roberts is led by Max Abmas, who averages 20.8 points per game and is grabbing 5.2 rebounds a night. Transfer Connor Vanover adds 12.7 points per game and a team-high 6.5 rebounds. The seven-foot five Vanover has a conference-high 52 blocks this season. Issac McBride adds 11.4 points. ORU is the highest-scoring team in the Summit, av-

eraging 84.3 points per game this season. The Golden Eagles allow 72.4. Oral Roberts makes 46.9 percent of its shots while holding teams to 42 percent.

About the Roos:

Kansas City comes enters the week 6-11 overall, 2-2 in the Summit. The Roos host St. Thomas on Thursday. RayQuawndis Mitchell leads Kansas City, scoring 18.2 points per game. Shemarri Allen adds 16.2 while Anderson Kopp scores 13.0. Allen David Mukeba Jr. is among the league leaders with 7.9 rebounds per game.

Kansas City is scoring 66.2 per game while allowing an average of 67.1. The Roos are shooting 40.4 percent from the field while opponents are making 40.1. Kansas City makes 29.7 percent of its threes while allowing opponents to make 33.4.

What's next:

After this week's trip, Western Illinois begins a four-game homestand. The Leathernecks begin the Western Hall streak against St. Thomas on Jan. 21. WIU then hosts a make-up game against North Dakota on Jan. 23 followed by home games against South Dakota (Jan. 26) and South Dakota State (Jan. 28)

Fast facts:

Massner ranks fifth in the Summit League in points per game while Rosner is seventh. Jesiah West is eighth in the league in rebounds per game while Massner ranks 12th. Rosner is third in the league in field goal percentage (46.6) and second in three-point percentage (42.5). Massner is fourth in field goal percentage (43.9) and three-point percentage (35.5). Massner's 5.7 assists per game lead the Summit League as does his 1.9 steals per game. West's 1.9 blocks per game rank second.

What is a Leatherneck?

Western Illinois holds the distinction of being the only non-military institution to officially have its nickname derived from a branch of the military service. The school began the use of the Marine Corps' official nickname, "The Fighting Leathernecks", in 1927 when athletic director and head baseball, basketball and football coach Ray "Rock" Hanson was granted permission by the U.S. Navy, based on his status as a Marine hero, to use the nickname.

TRADITION OF TOUGH

HEAD COACH ROB JETER



Wherever Rob Jeter goes, success is sure to follow, and on March 30, 2020, his next stop became Western Illinois University.

Jeter was tabbed as the Leathernecks' 21st head men's basketball coach, carrying with him 25 years of coaching experience and seven NCAA Tournament appearances. His previous stops included the University of Minnesota, University of Nevada-Las Vegas, and a head coaching stint at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

At the helm of his own program, Jeter was a three-time coach of the year. Eleven seasons at Milwaukee captured five seasons with 20 or more wins, Coach of the Year honors from the Horizon League (2011) and the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association (2006, 2011), and two NCAA Tournament berths. His first Panther squad registered a first-round victory over the University of Oklahoma in the 2006 NCAA Tournament.

Jeter's most recent trip to the NAAs occurred in 2019 as an assistant at Minnesota. The Gophers ended their season in the second round but earned their first tournament win in six years to go alongside another 20-win season (22-14).

In his two-year stint, Jeter was responsible for all aspects of the program, from recruiting to skill development, and he worked extensively with the Gophers' backcourt and defense. He helped coach Amir Coffey and Marcus Carr to All-Big Ten honors in 2019 and 2020, respectively.

Coffey is currently with the NBA's Los Angeles Clippers on a two-way contract with the Agua Caliente Clippers of the NBA G League.

Prior to Minnesota, Jeter was on staff at UNLV from 2016-18. The Runnin' Rebels doubled their wins in year two to produce a 20-win season, and Jeter had a hand in recruiting the 12th-best class in the country that included McDonald's High School All-American Brandon McCoy and National Junior College Player of the Year Shakur Juiston.

Jeter left Milwaukee (2005-2016) as its all-time winningest coach (Division I era) with an overall record of 185-170. The Panthers claimed the Horizon League's regular-season titles in 2006 and 2011 and tournament titles in 2006 and 2014.

Before running his own ship, Jeter was an assistant coach under Bo Ryan at Wisconsin (2001-05), UWM (1999-01), and Wisconsin-Platteville (1994-98). He was also an assistant at Marquette (1998-99) under Mike Deane.

At Wisconsin, Jeter helped the Badgers to remarkable success with two regular season Big Ten championships and a Big Ten Tournament title. Wisconsin made four-straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including berths in the Sweet 16 in 2003 and the Elite Eight in 2005.

Jeter played college basketball for Ryan at UW-Platteville and captained his team to the NCAA Division III title in 1991. He earned his bachelor's degree in 1991 and went on to earn a master's from UWP in 2001.

Jeter was inducted into the UW-Platteville Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006 and was also inducted into the inaugural hall of fame class for the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. He became a three-time HOFer in 2013 when Platteville's 1991 national championship team received the school's highest honor.

PLAYING CAREER

Jeter's collegiate career started at UW-Platteville, where he played for Bo Ryan from 1987-91 and captained the team to the 1991 NCAA Division III title while being named to the All-Final Four team. A two-time All-WSUC selection and two-time All-Midwest Region choice, Jeter held UW-Platteville records for career field goal percentage (.601) and consecutive starts (89) and was named to the WSUC honor roll three times. He spent one season playing professional basketball overseas, playing for the Olivias Futebol Clube in 1992-93 and leading the Portuguese league in scoring.
