MARQUETTE OPENS 2023-24 CAMPAIGN MONDAY

Golden Eagles host UT Martin in season opener

The Marquette women's basketball team open the 2023-24 season by facing UT Martin for the first time on Monday, Nov. 6. Tipoff from the Al McGuire center is at 12 p.m. CT.

The Golden Eagles are coming off a 21-11 (13-7 BIG EAST) record in 2022-23 with wins over then No. 3 Texas and then No. 4 UConn, the two highest-ranked wins in program history. Another run to the semifinals of the BIG EAST tournament was followed by an NCAA tournament appearance for Marquette, the second in the last four years.

Senior Jordan King was named unanimous preseason All-BIG EAST after averaging 15.9 points, 4.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game. She led the Golden Eagles in minutes played, three-point percentage, points, assists, and steals per game. At 17.2 points per game in league play, King is the BIG EAST's top returning scorer from 2022-23.

Liza Karlen, who earned Honorable Mention All-BIG EAST honors, is coming off a junior season where she averaged 11.4 points, 7.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game, all career bests.

Rose Nkumu has improved her numbers each year she's been on campus at Marquette. The senior will pair with Jordan King in the backcourt where they were first (King, 91) and second (Nkumu, 63) on the team in assists last season.

The Golden Eagles added several key pieces this offseason highlighted by Lehigh transfer Frannie Hottinger, who was the 2023 Patriot League Player of the Year. The

Inner Grove Heights, Minnesota, native scored 20.4 points per game, 19th in the nation, and recorded 16 double doubles which ranked 16th in the nation.

Lee Volker (Duke), Abbey Cracknell (Gulf Coast State College) and Bridget Utberg (Central Michigan) join Hottinger as the four new faces coming to Marquette by transfer.

Freshman Skylar Forbes will look to make an impact right away. The Markham, Ontario, native averaged 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds her senior year at Scarborough Prep and was a member of the U18 Canadian National team.

Mackenzie Hare begins her sophomore campaign after earning a spot on the BIG EAST All-Freshman team after leading the team in three-pointers made.

Marquette begins its 49th season of competition and is 4-0 in season openers under Megan Duffy. The Golden Eagles beat Fairleigh Dickinson to open last season, 75-47.

Head Coach Megan Duffy

Fifth Year | Dayton, Ohio | Notre Dame, '06



The 2022-23 campaign marked the fourth at Marquette University for Megan Duffy, who was named the sixth head coach in program history in April 2019.

Through four seasons at the helm of Marquette women's basketball, Duffy has the best winning percentage of any coach in Marquette women's basketball history, going 87-37 (.702) overall and 53-23 (.697) in BIG EAST play. During Duffy's tenure, the Golden Eagles have made three postseason appearances, and have earned a pair of runner-up finishes in both the regular season and conference tournament.

Marquette had an outstanding season in 2022-23, a campaign which was topped off by a trip to the NCAA tournament. The season was highlighted by the two highest-ranked wins in program history, as the Golden Eagles took down then No. 3 Texas and then No. 4 UConn during the regular season. The team went 21-11 overall with a 13-7 mark in BIG EAST play, and made it to the BIG EAST Tournament semifinal round for the seventh-straight season.

Duffy led the development of Jordan King and Chloe Marotta, the first Marquette duo to each land a spot on the All-BIG EAST First Team in the same season program history. King was a unanimous selection to the team after leading MU in both scoring (15.9) and assists (4.0), ranking in the league's top-10 in both categories. Marotta made an enormous statistical leap in her fifth and final season at Marquette, improving from 6.9 points per game in 2021-22 to 14.8 in 2022-23. She also ranked fifth in the BIG EAST with 9.0 rebounds per game.

Additionally, Duffy helped Emily La Chapell and Mackenzie Hare each earn recognition as members of the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team, the first duo to do so at Marquette since Natisha Hiedeman and Allazia Blockton in 2015-16.

As a team, the Golden Eagles boasted one of the nation's top defenses and most efficient offenses. Marquette led the BIG EAST in scoring defense, allowing opponents just 58.2 points per game, and dominated the glass with a +3.9 rebounding margin and 38.4 boards per contest. The team averaged 16.5 assists with just 13.5 turnovers per game to post an outstanding 1.22 assist/turnover ratio on the year.

The 2021-22 season was highlighted by a run to the WNIT Sweet 16 and the seventh-best win total in program history (23). The Golden Eagles posted a 23-11 overall record, including a 15-3 mark at the Al McGuire Center, a program record for home wins in a season. After earning a bye in the first round of the BIG EAST tournament as the 5-seed, Marquette used a historic offensive performance in a 105-85 win over DePaul in the quarterfinal round to advance to its sixth-straight tournament semifinal appearance.

The Golden Eagles made history during the 2020-21 season, winning 14 of their 18 BIG EAST games, including a school-record 11 true wins in road games. Thirteen of MU's 19 wins came away from home, including a decisive 85-71 victory over then-No. 24 DePaul at Wintrust Arena that helped the team lock up an NCAA tournament bid. After winning BIG EAST tournament games against Providence and Creighton, MU advanced to the BIG EAST tournament championship game for the fifth consecutive season. UConn and Maryland are the only other high major teams to make five straight conference tournament title games from 2017-21.

Duffy was named the sixth head coach in Marquette women's basketball history on April 10, 2019. She inherited a team that went 27-8 (15-3 BIG EAST) in 2018-19 that fell in the Round of 32 in the NCAA tournament to Texas A&M, 78-76. The team Duffy took over had lost four 1,000-plus point scorers in Allazia Blockton (2,204 points), Natisha Hiedeman (1,913), Amani Wilborn (1,409) and Danielle King (1,389).

Despite these losses, Duffy made an immediate impact on the program, directing a team selected to finish ninth in the preseason poll to a second-place effort in the BIG EAST and an appearance in the league tournament championship game. The roster featured a pair of all-league performers in Selena Lott and Camryn Taylor and the program was poised for participation in the NCAA tournament.

The Dayton, Ohio, native has translated her extensive playing career, which included All-America selections (finalist for national player of the year awards), USA Basketball participation (Gold medalist) and professional experience in the WNBA (Minnesota and New York) and overseas, into immediate success in the coaching ranks.

Duffy arrived at Marquette after leading Miami (Ohio) to a pair of Women's National Invitation Tournament appearances during her two-year tenure with the program. Miami finished the season with a 23-9 overall record and a 13-5 Mid-American Conference mark in 2018-19 and reached 20 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1980's.

Under Duffy's tutelage, Miami produced two all-conference performers, while the team's successes carried into the classroom as well. Miami had a program-high eight student-athletes tabbed Academic All-MAC and the RedHawks were named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Top 25 Honor Roll in 2018 after earning the sixth-best team grade-point average in the nation among all Division I schools.

Prior to her time in Oxford, Duffy owns stops at BIG EAST school St. John's (2009-12, assistant coach), George Washington (2012-14, associate head coach) and Michigan (2014-17, assistant coach). She helped lead each of the three programs to the postseason (seven total appearances), highlighted by a trip to the Sweet 16 with the Red Storm in 2012 and the WNIT title with the Wolverines in 2017.

Duffy was a four-year letterwinner at Notre Dame (2002-06), helping the Irish to four-straight NCAA appearances and two Sweet 16 berths. She is one of four players in school history to total at least 1,000 points, 500 assists and 200 steals. She was an Associated Press and Kodak All-America honorable mention in 2005 and 2006, while being a finalist for both the John Wooden Award and Nancy Lieberman Award in her final season.

Duffy graduated from Notre Dame in 2006 with a double degree in psychology and computer applications. She is married to Kevin Hoyng.



Coach Duffy led Marquette to a 24-8 (13-5 BIG EAST) season in her first year at Marquette in 2019-20. She was named BIG EAST Coach of the Year and had the Golden Eagles on the cusp of their fourth consecutive NCAA tournament appearance.

Justine Raterman

Associate Head Coach

Dayton (2010)

- Entering her fifth season as an assistant coach at Marquette.
- Serves as recruiting coordinator for the Golden Eagles and excels in post player development.
- In 2021-22, Raterman helped her post players take their games to another level. Lauren Van Kleunen earned First Team All-BIG EAST honors, leading the squad in scoring (13.7), while also averaging 6.4 rebounds per contest and shooting a team-best 57.8 percent from the floor. She also helped Liza Karlen to make enormous improvement during her sophomore season.
- Before coming to MU, Raterman served as an assistant for the Miami Redhawks in the 2018-2019 campaign.
- A former standout player at Dayton, Raterman graduated in 2012 after leading Dayton to three NCAA tournament berths and one WNIT appearance. She is the Flyers' second all-time leading scorer and all-time leading rebounder of the modern era with 1,832 points and 915 rebounds.



Khadijah Rushdan

Assistant Coach

Rutgers (2012)

- Entering her first season as an assistant coach at Marquette.
- Comes to Marquette after spending the past five seasons as an assistant coach at North Florida.
- Primary duties include player development, scouting and recruiting at Marquette.
- While at North Florida, Rushdan helped develop forward Jazz Bond into the program's first-ever WNBA draft pick.
- Spent one season as an assistant coach at LaSalle and three seasons as an assistant coach at St. Elizabeth High School in Wilmington, Delaware. She was also a member of the coaching staff at the 2022 US Olympic Women's Basketball U16 Trials.
- After a strong collegiate career at Rutgers, she was selected as the 15th overall pick in the 2012 WNBA Draft by the Los Angeles Sparks. She spent one season there before playing professionally in Israel in 2012-13.
- As a guard at Rutgers from 2007-12, Rushdan helped her team to NCAA tournament appearances all five seasons, including an Elite Eight in 2007-08 and a Sweet 16 appearance in 2008-09.



Kayla Kleifgen

Assistant Coach

Eckerd (2015)

- Entering her first season as an assistant coach at Marquette.
- Comes to Marquette after spending the past seven seasons at Northern Kentucky.
- Primary duties include recruiting, player development of guards, and scouting.
- Spent six seasons as the recruiting coordinator at Northern Kentucky and was promoted to associate head coach for the 2022-23 season.
- While at Northern Kentucky, Kleifgen helped lead the Norse to their first-ever 20-win season at the Division I level in 2019-20. In 2021-22, she assisted the team en route to a 21-8 record, the program's best Division I record.
- Prior to NKU, Kleifgen spent one year at Kentucky as the team's staff support associate.
- As a player, Kleifgen was a four-year player at Eckerd College. She tied Eckerd's career mark by appearing in 110 games over her career and left Eckerd as only the third player in program history to finish with over 700 points and 400 assists.



Jonathan Tsipis

Advisor for Scouting and Analytics

North Carolina (1996)

- Entering his second season with the Marquette women's basketball program as an advisor for scouting and analytics in 2023-24 after joining the team in September of 2022.
- At Marquette, his roles will include advanced scouting, analytics of team and opponents, working closely with the coaching staff on game plans, and video breakdown.
- Has over 25 years of coaching experience, including nine years as a head coach at the Division I level at Wisconsin and George Washington.
- At Wisconsin, he coached players to eight all-Big Ten honors during his five seasons at the helm and coached the Badgers to their best finish in nearly a decade in 2018-19.
- While at George Washington, Tsipis helped turn the Colonials into a national power. Taking over a program that went 11-18 the year prior to his arrival, GW went 92-38 through four seasons with Tsipis at the helm. In his final two seasons there, the team had a 55-11 record with A-10 titles and NCAA Tournament appearances each year.
- From 2012-14, Tsipis and Duffy worked side-by-side at George Washington as head coach and associate head coach, respectively, a relationship which began during Duffy's playing days at Notre Dame, where Tsipis an assistant for Muffett McGraw from 2003-2012.

SCOUTING THE SKYHAWKS

- The Skyhawks finished fifth in the Ohio Valley Conference with a 9-9 league record (13-17 overall) last season that ended with a first-round loss to Morehead State in the conference tournament.
- The Skyhawks return seven players and three starters from last year's team that went .500 in OVC play. UT Martin led the OVC in free throw percentage (.787) while also ranking first in league play in both blocked shots (3.2 per game) and steals (10.6 per game).
- Junior guard Shae Littleford was named preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference for the second year in a row. She averaged 13.0 points, 3.2 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 1.7 steals while playing 32.8 minutes over 23 games (20 starts) in 2022-23.

ALL-TIME SERIES AGAINST UT MARTIN

- This will be the first meeting between Marquette and UT Martin.
- Marquette is 5-1 against the Ohio Valley Conference historically.
- The last matchup with an OVC school came on December 13, 2020, when Marquette beat Belmont in Nashville, 64-61. Belmont is now in the Missouri Valley Conference.

STARTING FIVE

- Marquette is 29-11 against non-conference opponents under Megan Duffy.
- Through four seasons at the helm of Marquette women's basketball, Coach Duffy has the best winning percentage of any coach in Marquette women's basketball history, going 87-37 (.702) overall and 53-23 (.697) in BIG EAST play.
- The Golden Eagles return three starters and six letterwinners from last season that accounted for just under 60 percent of the scoring.
- As a team, the Golden Eagles were picked third in the preseason poll by the conference coaches. Marquette has finished the regular season better than their preseason pick three out of the last four seasons.
- At 17.2 points per game in league play, Jordan King is the BIG EAST's top returning scorer from 2022-23.

KING NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST TEAM

- Senior Jordan King was named unanimous preseason All-BIG EAST after averaging 15.9 points, 4.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game. She led the Golden Eagles in minutes played, three-point percentage, points, assists, and steals per game. At 17.2 points per game in league play, King is the BIG EAST's top returning scorer from 2022-23.
- The Rockton, Illinois, native has started in all 124 games during her collegiate career, averaging 32.5 minutes per contest. King ranked top ten in the BIG EAST in five statistical categories last season: scoring (8th, 15.9), assists (5th, 4.0), steals (5th, 2.0), assist/TO ratio (9th, 1.3), and minutes played (8th, 34.3).
- King is the first unanimous selection for Marquette to the preseason All-BIG EAST team since Selena Lott in 2020.

KING ON CHERYL MILLER AWARD WATCH LIST

- Jordan King was named one of 20 student-athletes nationwide selected to the 2024 Cheryl Miller Award Preseason Watch List, given annually to the best small forward in the nation.
- The winner will join the other awards in the Naismith Starting Five. Those awards include the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard award, the Ann Meyers Drysdale • Shooting guard award, the Katrina McClain Power Forward award, and the Lisa Leslie Center award.

KARLEN TABBED PRESEASON HONORABLE MENTION ALL-BIG EAST

- Liza Karlen is coming off a junior season where she averaged 11.4 points, 7.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game, all career bests. The St. Paul, Minnesota native, started in all but one of her 25 games played and her 7.4 rebounds a contest led the team and was ninth in the BIG EAST.
- Karlen, who missed seven games midseason due to injury, finished with five double-doubles and eight double-digit rebounding performances.

- The Golden Eagles return three starters plus three other letterwinners from last season who accounted for just under 60 percent of the scoring.
- Rose Nkumu joins King and Karlen as returning starters. The senior has improved each year on campus and is ready for that next step after 4.8 points and 2.8 assists, while starting in all but two games.
- Four new faces come to Milwaukee via the transfer portal. Lee Volker (Duke), Abbey Cracknell (Gulf Coast State College), Bridget Utberg (Central Michigan) and Frannie Hottinger (Lehigh) will all immediately start or be a member of the rotation for Megan Duffy.
- Frannie Hottinger is the reigning Patriot League Player of the Year after averaging 20.3 points per game (19th in the nation) and recording 16 double-doubles (16th in the nation).
- Lee Volker comes to Marquette after spending two seasons at Duke, appearing in 39 contests for the Blue Devils with seven starts.
- Abbey Cracknell joins Marquette after two seasons at Gulf Coast State College in Panama City, Florida. From Avoca Beach, Australia, Cracknell picked up All-Panhandle honors after the 2022-23 season and averaged 11 points, 5.8 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.6 steals per game.
- Bridget Utberg earned MAC All-Freshman honors in her lone season at Central Michigan. Utberg made 25 starts, averaging 13.2 points per game and 2.5 assists a contest.
- Freshman Skylar Forbes averaged 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds her senior year at Scarborough Prep in Toronto. She was a member of the U18 Canadian national team in 2022.
- Mackenzie Hare begins her sophomore campaign after earning a spot on the BIG EAST All-Freshman team a year ago. Hare led the team in three-pointers made and averaged 7.2 points per game.
- Claire Kaifes will be a veteran presence off the bench. The senior earned her first career start last season against Milwaukee.
- Halle Vice will start out the year on the bench due to injury. The freshman from Bettendorf, Iowa, led Pleasant Valley HS to a state title her senior year while being named to the All-State Tournament team for the second year in a row.
- Charia Smith is out for the year with an ACL injury. The sophomore appeared in 17 games last season.

- Marquette will be heading to Fort Meyers, Florida, for the 2023 Fort Meyers Tipoff, November 24-25.
- The rest of the eight-team field consists of Arkansas, Boston College, Indiana, Oklahoma, Princeton, Tennessee and Wisconsin. Marquette will be in the Shell Division with Arkansas, Boston College and Wisconsin.
- The Golden Eagles will face off with Boston College in the opening round on Nov. 24 at 3:30 p.m. CT. The winner will take on the victor of Arkansas and Wisconsin on Nov. 25, while the other two teams will play in the third-place game.

SEASON OPENER HISTORY

- Marquette is beginning its 49th season of competition this season and is 30-18 all-time in season openers. Megan Duffy is 4-0 at MU.
- The Golden Eagles beat Fairleigh Dickinson to open last season, 75-47.
