Women's Basketball Hosts No. 23 Illinois Saturday

Marquette Leads All-Time Series, 5-2

The Marquette University women's basketball team hosts nationally ranked Illinois on Saturday, Nov. 11, at the Al McGuire Center. Tipoff is at 2 p.m. CT.

The Golden Eagles started their 2023-24 campaign on Monday with an 84-51 win over UT Martin.

Six players scored in double figures, led by Mackenzie Hare, who had 17 points in her first career start. Skylar Forbes, in her collegiate debut, had 14 points in 16 minutes played.

Five new faces registered their first minutes in the Blue and Gold, including Frannie Hottinger, who earned the start. Lee Volker scored a collegiate career-high 13 points on 5-of-10 shooting.

Rose Nkumu registered her first career double-double with 12 points and 10 assists, a new career-high. The senior also had three steals, four blocks and four charges drawn.

Liza Karlen had 10 points and 10 rebounds for her 14th double-double of her career. Jordan King was second on the team with 14 points on 4-of-6 shooting, her 70th time scoring in double figures.

Marquette has an early ranked opportunity with the No. 23 Fighting Illini (1-0, 0-0 BIG TEN), who opened their season Tuesday night with an 81-61 win over Morehead State. Genesis Bryant led the way with a career-high 32 points on 12-of-16 shooting.

Saturday's meeting will be the eighth versus Illinois, with Marquette leading the all-time series, 5-2. The last matchup came on Dec. 21, 2010, when Marquette beat Illinois at home, 73-56.

The game will be broadcast on FloSports with Bob Brainerd on the call. Live stats will be available on GoMarquette.com.

SCOUTING THE FIGHTING ILLINI

- Illinois opened its 2023-24 season with an 84-61 win over Morehead State on Tuesday.
- Two players scored in double figures, led by senior guard Genesis Bryant, who had a career-high 32 points on 12-of-16 shooting.
- Kendall Bostic recorded a double-double with 15 points and a team-high 13 rebounds.
- The Illini shot 51% from the field, forced 19 turnovers, and registered 38 points in the paint.

ALL-TIME SERIES AGAINST ILLINOIS

- Saturday’s meeting will be the eighth all-time versus Illinois.
- Marquette leads the all-time series, 5-2.
- Last matchup came on Dec. 21, 2010, when Marquette beat Illinois at home, 73-56.
- Marquette is 35-54 all-time against Big Ten opponents.

STARTING FIVE

- Marquette is 30-11 against non-conference opponents under Megan Duffy.
- Through four seasons at the helm of Marquette women’s basketball, Coach Duffy has the best winning percentage of any coach in Marquette women’s basketball history, going 88-37 (.704) overall and 53-23 (.697) in BIG EAST play.
- The Golden Eagles return three starters and six letterwinners from last season, who accounted for just under 60 percent of the scoring.
- As a team, the Golden Eagles were picked third in the preseason poll by the conference coaches. Marquette has finished the regular season better than their preseason pick three out of the last four seasons.
- At 17.2 points per game in league play, Jordan King is the BIG EAST’s top returning scorer from 2022-23.

KING NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST TEAM

- Senior Jordan King was named unanimous preseason All-BIG EAST after averaging 15.9 points, 4.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game. She led the Golden Eagles in minutes played, three-point percentage, points, assists, and steals per game. At 17.2 points per game in league play, King is the BIG EAST’s top returning scorer from 2022-23.
- The Rockton, Illinois, native has started in all 124 games during her collegiate career, averaging 32.5 minutes per contest. King ranked top ten in the BIG EAST in five statistical categories last season: scoring (8th, 15.9), assists (5th, 4.0), steals (5th, 2.0), assist/TO ratio (9th, 1.3), and minutes played (8th, 34.3).
- King is the first unanimous selection for Marquette to the preseason All-BIG EAST team since Selena Lott in 2020.

KING ON CHERYL MILLER AWARD WATCH LIST

- Jordan King was named one of 20 student-athletes nationwide selected to the 2024 Cheryl Miller Award Preseason Watch List, given annually to the best small forward in the nation.
- The winner will join the other awards in the Naismith Starting Five. Those awards include the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard award, the Ann Meyers Drysdale • Shooting guard award, the Katrina McClain Power Forward award, and the Lisa Leslie Center award.

KARLEN TABBED PRESEASON HONORABLE MENTION ALL-BIG EAST

- Liza Karlen is coming off a junior season where she averaged 11.4 points, 7.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game, all career bests. The St. Paul, Minnesota native, started in all but one of her 25 games played and her 7.4 rebounds a contest led the team and was ninth in the BIG EAST.
- Karlen, who missed seven games midseason due to injury, finished with five double-doubles and eight double-digit rebounding performances.

HARE COMES OUT HOT

- Mackenzie Hare earned her first career start Monday for Marquette and finished with a game-high 17 points.
- The sophomore had eight of Marquette’s first 10 points.
- It was her ninth career game in double figures and her four assists tied a career-high.

EFFICIENT FIRST GAME FOR FORBES

- Skylar Forbes, in her collegiate debut, scored 14 points on 6-of-11 shooting in just 16 minutes played.
- The freshman subbed in at the 6:21 mark of the first quarter and made a driving layup for her first career points just a minute later.
- Forbes finished second on the team in scoring (14) as the second sub off the bench.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR ROSE

- Rose Nkumu recorded her first career double-double with 12 points and a career-high 10 assists.
- The senior took over the second quarter, scoring seven of her 12 points for the game while also adding two assists before halftime.
- It was her third time scoring in double figures for her career, and her ninth career game with 5+ assists.
- Nkumu also had four blocks (career-high), three steals and drew four charges.
- Nkumu is 33rd nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (5.0) and 12th in blocks (4.0).

INSTANT IMPACT FOR LEE

- Lee Volker had a collegiate career-high 13 points on 5-10 shooting.
- Her five made field goals tied her collegiate career-high.

BLOCK PARTY

- Marquette is seventh in the nation in blocks per game after having nine blocks on Monday.
- Rose Nkumu had a career-high four blocks while five other Golden Eagles had one apiece.
- Marquette's nine blocked shots were the most in a game since last season's matchup against St. Francis when they had eight (11/27/22).

GOLDEN EAGLE DEBUTS

- Five new faces registered their first minutes in the Blue and Gold Monday against UT Martin, including Frannie Hottinger, who earned the start. The Lehigh transfer pulled down seven rebounds (second on team) and scored three points.
- Skylar Forbes made her collegiate debut and scored just over a minute after checking in.
- Lee Volker was first off the bench and scored a collegiate career-high 13 points.
- Abbey Cracknell played 12 minutes off the bench and scored her first NCAA point after going 1-of-2 from the line.
- Bridget Utberg played 10 minutes and dished out three assists and had two steals.

LAST BIG TEN MATCHUP

- The last matchup with a Big Ten team came in the second round of the 2022 WNIT when Marquette beat Purdue at the Al McGuire Center on March 21, 2022.
- Marquette won 77-62 and shot 44.4% from the field and 46.2% from three.
- It was the first meeting between Marquette and Purdue.
- Jordan King had 17 points on and 3-4 from beyond the arc.

FORT MEYERS TIP-OFF

- Marquette will be heading to Fort Meyers, Florida, for the 2023 Fort Meyers Tipoff, November 24-25.
- The rest of the eight-team field consists of Arkansas, Boston College, Indiana, Oklahoma, Princeton, Tennessee and Wisconsin. Marquette will be in the Shell Division with Arkansas, Boston College and Wisconsin.
- The Golden Eagles will face off with Boston College in the opening round on Nov. 24 at 3:30 p.m. CT. The winner will take on the victor of Arkansas and Wisconsin on Nov. 25, while the other two teams will play in the third-place game.

UP NEXT

- The Golden Eagles hit the road for the first time this season, visiting IUPUI on Wednesday night. Tipoff is at 6 p.m. CT.

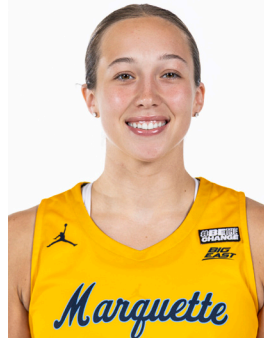

Fifth Year | Dayton, Ohio | Notre Dame, '06



The 2022-23 campaign marked the fourth at Marquette University for Megan Duffy, who was named the sixth head coach in program history in April 2019.

Through four seasons at the helm of Marquette women's basketball, Duffy has the best winning percentage of any coach in Marquette women's basketball history, going 87-37 (.702) overall and 53-23 (.697) in BIG EAST play. During Duffy's tenure, the Golden Eagles have made three postseason appearances, and have earned a pair of runner-up finishes in both the regular season and conference tournament.

Marquette had an outstanding season in 2022-23, a campaign which was topped off by a trip to the NCAA tournament. The season was highlighted by the two highest-ranked wins in program history, as the Golden Eagles took down then No. 3 Texas and then No. 4 UConn during the regular season. The team went 21-11 overall with a 13-7 mark in BIG EAST play, and made it to the BIG EAST Tournament semifinal round for the seventh-straight season.

Duffy led the development of Jordan King and Chloe Marotta, the first Marquette duo to each land a spot on the All-BIG EAST First Team in the same season program history. Additionally, Duffy helped Emily La Chapell and Mackenzie Hare each earn recognition as members of the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team, the first duo to do so at Marquette since Natisha Hiedeman and Allazia Blockton in 2015-16.

As a team, the Golden Eagles boasted one of the nation's top defenses and most efficient offenses. Marquette led the BIG EAST in scoring defense, allowing opponents just 58.2 points per game, and dominated the glass with a +3.9 rebounding margin and 38.4 boards per contest. The team averaged 16.5 assists with just 13.5 turnovers per game to post an outstanding 1.22 assist/turnover ratio on the year.

The 2021-22 season was highlighted by a run to the WNIT Sweet 16 and the seventh-best win total in program history (23). The Golden Eagles posted a 23-11 overall record, including a 15-3 mark at the Al McGuire Center, a program record for home wins in a season. After earning a bye in the first round of the BIG EAST tournament as the 5-seed, Marquette used a historic offensive performance in a 105-85 win over DePaul in the quarterfinal round to advance to its sixth-straight tournament semifinal appearance.

The Golden Eagles made history during the 2020-21 season, winning 14 of their 18 BIG EAST games, including a school-record 11 true wins in road games. Thirteen of MU's 19 wins came away from home, including a decisive 85-71 victory over then-No. 24 DePaul at Wintrust Arena that helped the team lock up an NCAA tournament bid. After winning BIG EAST tournament games against Providence and Creighton, MU advanced to the BIG EAST tournament championship game for the fifth consecutive season. UConn and Maryland are the only other high major teams to make five straight conference tournament title games from 2017-21.

Duffy was named the sixth head coach in Marquette women's basketball history on April 10, 2019. She inherited a team that went 27-8 (15-3 BIG EAST) in 2018-19 that fell in the Round of 32 in the NCAA tournament to Texas A&M, 78-76.

Despite these losses, Duffy made an immediate impact on the program, directing a team selected to finish ninth in the preseason poll to a second-place effort in the BIG EAST and an appearance in the league tournament championship game. The roster featured a pair of all-league performers in Selena Lott and Camryn Taylor and the program was poised for participation in the NCAA tournament.

The Dayton, Ohio, native has translated her extensive playing career, which included All-America selections (finalist for national player of the year awards), USA Basketball participation (Gold medalist) and professional experience in the WNBA (Minnesota and New York) and overseas, into immediate success in the coaching ranks.

Duffy arrived at Marquette after leading Miami (Ohio) to a pair of Women's National Invitation Tournament appearances during her two-year tenure with the program.

Under Duffy's tutelage, Miami produced two all-conference performers, while the team's successes carried into the classroom as well. Miami had a program-high eight student-athletes tabbed Academic All-MAC and the RedHawks were named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Top 25 Honor Roll in 2018 after earning the sixth-best team grade-point average in the nation among all Division I schools.

Prior to her time in Oxford, Duffy owns stops at BIG EAST school St. John's (2009-12, assistant coach), George Washington (2012-14, associate head coach) and Michigan (2014-17, assistant coach). She helped lead each of the three programs to the postseason (seven total appearances).

Duffy was a four-year letterwinner at Notre Dame (2002-06), helping the Irish to four-straight NCAA appearances and two Sweet 16 berths. She is one of four players in school history to total at least 1,000 points, 500 assists and 200 steals. She was an Associated Press and Kodak All-America honorable mention in 2005 and 2006, while being a finalist for both the John Wooden Award and Nancy Lieberman Award in her final season.

Duffy graduated from Notre Dame in 2006 with a double degree in psychology and computer applications. She is married to Kevin Hoyng.



Coach Duffy led Marquette to a 24-8 (13-5 BIG EAST) season in her first year at Marquette in 2019-20. She was named BIG EAST Coach of the Year and had the Golden Eagles on the cusp of their fourth consecutive NCAA tournament appearance.

- Serves as recruiting coordinator for the Golden Eagles and excels in post player development.
- In 2021-22, Raterman helped her post players take their games to another level. Lauren Van Kleunen earned First Team All-BIG EAST honors, leading the squad in scoring (13.7), while also averaging 6.4 rebounds per contest and shooting a team-best 57.8 percent from the floor. She also helped Liza Karlen to make enormous improvement during her sophomore season.
- Before coming to MU, Raterman served as an assistant for the Miami Redhawks in the 2018-2019 campaign.
- A former standout player at Dayton, Raterman graduated in 2012 after leading Dayton to three NCAA tournament berths and one WNIT appearance. She is the Flyers' second all-time leading scorer and all-time leading rebounder of the modern era with 1,832 points and 915 rebounds.

- After a strong collegiate career at Rutgers, she was selected as the 15th overall pick in the 2012 WNBA Draft by the Los Angeles Sparks. She spent one season there before playing professionally in Israel in 2012-13.
- As a guard at Rutgers from 2007-12, Rushdan helped her team to NCAA tournament appearances all five seasons, including an Elite Eight in 2007-08 and a Sweet 16 appearance in 2008-09.

- Primary duties include recruiting, player development of guards, and scouting.
- Spent six seasons as the recruiting coordinator at Northern Kentucky and was promoted to associate head coach for the 2022-23 season.
- While at Northern Kentucky, Kleifgen helped lead the Norse to their first-ever 20-win season at the Division I level in 2019-20. In 2021-22, she assisted the team en route to a 21-8 record, the program's best Division I record.
- Prior to NKU, Kleifgen spent one year at Kentucky as the team's staff support associate.
- As a player, Kleifgen was a four-year player at Eckerd College. She tied Eckerd's career mark by appearing in 110 games over her career and left Eckerd as only the third player in program history to finish with over 700 points and 400 assists.

- Has over 25 years of coaching experience, including nine years as a head coach at the Division I level at Wisconsin and George Washington.
- At Wisconsin, he coached players to eight all-Big Ten honors during his five seasons at the helm and coached the Badgers to their best finish in nearly a decade in 2018-19.
- While at George Washington, Tsipis helped turn the Colonials into a national power. Taking over a program that went 11-18 the year prior to his arrival, GW went 92-38 through four seasons with Tsipis at the helm. In his final two seasons there, the team had a 55-11 record with A-10 titles and NCAA Tournament appearances each year.
- From 2012-14, Tsipis and Duffy worked side-by-side at George Washington as head coach and associate head coach, respectively, a relationship which began during Duffy's playing days at Notre Dame, where Tsipis an assistant for Muffett McGraw from 2003-2012.
