LEGACY OF SUCCESS

Since NYU's first game in 1906, the Violets have established themselves as one of the nation's preeminent powers. Following the 2013-14 season, NYU has won 1,266 games, while turning in numerous highlights:

POSTSEASON/NCAA HISTORY:

In 2012, NYU returned to the NCAA Division III Championship and hosted a first-round game, which they won 84-65 in front of a capacity crowd. Thirty-seven teams have earned postseason invitations – not including National Championships in 1919-20 (Amateur Athletic Union) and 1934-35 (Helms' Post-Season Poll). NYU reached the Final Four in 1945, 1960 and 1994, finishing as the NCAA Division III National Runner-Up in '94.

Violets in the Pros:

Much of the program's success can be attributed to the student-athletes who don the purple-and-white. Recently, NYU has sent players to professional careers overseas, including Carl Yaffe ('13, Slovakia), Keith Jensen ('10, Philippines) and Jason Boone ('07, Germany). Twenty former standouts suited up for NBA teams, including Tom "Satch" Sanders, a 2011 Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inductee who played for the Boston Celtics from 1960-73 and helped them win eight titles in his first nine seasons.

UNIVERSITY ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (UAA):

Since the inception of the UAA in 1987-88, 42 Violets have earned a total of 72 All-UAA accolades. Boone captured both UAA Player of the Year (2005-06) and Rookie of the Year (2003-04) honors.

The duo of Adam Crawford (1993-94) and Jesse Determann (1997-98) also earned Player of the Year accolades, while James Janeczek was tabbed Rookie of the Year (2002-03). This past season Evan Kupferberg (First), Ryan Tana (Second) and Costis Gontikas (Honorable Mention) all earned honors.

Joe Nesci has recently completed his 26th season as head coach of the New York University men's basketball team. Since his debut season in 1988-89, Nesci has led his squads to 25 winning seasons, 19 postseason appearances – including seven straight NCAA Division III Cham-

pionship trips from 1992 to 1998, the 2007 Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Division III Metro Tournament title, and a return to the NCAA Tournament in the 2011-2012 season. The 2011- 2012 Violets went 21-6 overall and reached the second round of the NCAA's. In the ultra-competitive University Athletic Association (UAA), Nesci's '11-12 team went 9-5 and finished in second place. The team ranked nationally in several offensive categories: third in assists (19.1) and seventh in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.35), as well as fourth in three-point field goal percentage (40.8%) and sixth in field goal percentage (50.1%). Nesci and his assistants went on to earn UAA Coaching Staff of the Year honors. Nesci is currently the program's all-time leader in career victories and winning percentage.

NEW YORK UNIVERSITY BASKETBALL CAMP RELEASE FORM

In consideration for permitting my child to participate in the New York University Basketball Camp (the "Camp") I hereby agree: (a) To release and discharge New York University (the "University") from any liability or responsibility for any personal or bodily injury (including death), and for any damage to or loss of property, however caused, that my child or I suffer as a result of or in connection with my child's participation in the Camp, other than for damage or loss resulting directly from the negligent acts or willful misconduct of the University; and (b) Not to raise any claim or institute any legal action proceeding, on my behalf or on behalf of my child, against the University for any cause of action that may result from or arise out of or in connection with my child's participation in the Camp, for any injury (including death) to my child, other than for damage or loss resulting directly from the negligent acts or willful misconduct of the University; and (c) To indemnify the University and hold it safe and harmless from and against any claim or cause of action asserted by my child, or on behalf of my child, against the University, for loss of, or damage or injury (including death) to, his or her person or property, resulting from, arising out of, or occurring in connection with my child's participation in the Camp, other than for damage or loss resulting directly from the negligent acts or willful misconduct of the University. All references to the University in this form shall include, and all provisions of this form shall insure to the benefit of, the University's trustees, officers, employees, agents, servants, and representatives. I have no knowledge of any physical impairment that would affect my child's ability to participate in the Camp. I authorize the University to request medical treatment as necessary to insure the well-being of my child while at Camp. I agree that my child will comply with all applicable rules, policies, and procedures of the University including but not limited to the Policy & Procedures Guide, which can be found at www.nyu.edu/athletics. This release shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York applicable to contracts entered into and intended to be performed solely within the state of New York. I shall submit to the jurisdiction of the federal and state courts located in the New York County, New York State, for the resolution of disputes arising hereunder or relating hereto, regardless of the place of execution hereof.
