Welcome to the United States Military Academy



President Thomas Jefferson established the United States Military Academy (USMA) on March 16, 1802. USMA is located in West Point, NY which is less than 50 miles north of New York City on the narrowest part of the Hudson River. The significance of this location dates back to the Revolutionary War when General Washington ordered that a chain be constructed to stretch across the Hudson in order to prevent British ships from sailing down the Hudson to New York City. Although the chain was never tested, it is believed that its mere presence was sufficient to deter the British from attempting to sail down the Hudson at all. In addition to its Revolutionary War heritage, West Point also has the distinction of being the oldest continuously garrisoned post in the United States.

The mission of USMA is to “educate train and inspire the Corps of Cadets so that each graduate is a commissioned leader of character committed to the values of Duty, Honor, Country and prepared for a career of professional excellence and service to the Nation as an officer in the United States Army.” In order to accomplish this mission, USMA educates cadets in three pillars: academic, military, and physical. The Academy also has a strict honor code that all cadets are expected to internalize: “A cadet will not lie, cheat, steal, or tolerate those who do.”

USMA has a very rigorous four year program with numerous academic, military, and physical requirements to graduate. The Academy offers a wide range of academic majors in both the arts and sciences. Regardless of major, all cadets are required to complete courses in a broad range of courses across all departments at the Academy. All cadets graduate with a Bachelor of Science and are commissioned as Second Lieutenants in the Army.

The Army West Point Women’s Fencing Team is proud to host the NIWFA 2018 Conference Championship.

National Intercollegiate Women's Fencing Association



Three women collegiate fencers, Julia Jones and Dorothy Hafner of New York University and Elizabeth Ross of Cornell University, founded the **NIWFA** in 1929. The inspiration and model for the new athletic association for women was the men's **Intercollegiate Fencing Association (IFA)** founded a third of a century before. The purpose of the organization was to develop women's intercollegiate fencing and to sponsor an annual championship.

New York University won the first team championship. **Mrs. Mildred Stuyvesant Fish** of New York, donated the perpetual trophy for the team championship. Julia Jones, an N.Y.U. student won the first individual championship. Until her death in 1995, Ms. Jones was the guiding light of the association she helped to establish.

The **Christmas Invitational** is an individual event for collegiate women hosted by the **NIWFA** on the first Sunday in December. Each member college/university may enter a maximum of six foil, six epee and six saber fencers in the annual event. This developmental event for novice fencers sanctions the participation of **United States Fencing Association (USFA)** Class "C" fencers or below. (Fencers need not be members of the USFA.)

The competition in each weapon is conducted in a round robin format to a final of six fencers. Fencers eliminated in the first round compete in a consolation round. Each entrant is thereby provided with at least two rounds of fencing competition. The six finalists are awarded **Julia Jones Medals**. The **Evelyn Terhune Trophy** is presented to the winner of the foil event. The first place epeeist is awarded the **Betty Santelli Trophy** and the saber champion, the **NIWFA Trophy**.

The **NIWFA Team and Individual Championships** are held on the last Saturday in February or the first Saturday in March. Foil, epee and saber teams compete in separate round robin formatted championships. A match between each three-member team consists of three bouts. The total number of bouts won determines the team championship.

The **Mildred Stuyvesant Fish Trophy** is presented to the Champion Foil Team; the **Raymond Miller Trophy** to the Champion Epee Team and the **Giorgio Santelli Trophy** to the Champion Saber Team. The Combined Weapons Team Champion is awarded the **Olympians Trophy**. The second place team is presented with the **West Point Trophy**. Each member of the first four teams is awarded a **Julia Jones Medal**.

Sixteen fencers in each weapon qualify from the team events for participation in the Direct Elimination Individual Championships. The eight finalists in each weapon are awarded **Julia Jones Medals**. The Foil Champion is awarded the **Julia Jones Trophy**; the Epee Champion, the **Salle Santelli Women's Epee Team Trophy** and the Saber Champion, **the Saber Trophy**.

Any college or university granting a degree at the Bachelor's level is invited to become a member of the association. Members of fencing teams must be matriculated, undergraduate, full-time students in good standing. Student athletes must be amateur fencers. Following the guidelines of the **National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA)**, fencers are eligible to compete in the **NIWFA** for a total of four years.

The **NIWFA** remains true to the vision of its founders by continuing to provide competitive fencing opportunities for collegiate women and develop their skills in competition. Many **NIWFA** alumnae continue to be actively involved in fencing.

19 **NIWFA** alumnae have participated on one or more Olympic Teams
17 **NIWFA** alumnae have participated on one or more Pan American Teams
15 **NIWFA** alumnae have won one or more AFLA and USFA National Championship.

How strong is **NIWFA** competition? Fencing is not a sport which can be measured in absolute terms of how far, how fast or how much. Most **NIWFA** fencers learn to fence while they are in college, although some started in secondary school or in a club. There is considerable range in skill level among **NIWFA** fencers. (The competitive field, however, is approximately that of **USFA** Class "C" fencers or below.)

Dear NIWFA Fencers, Coaches and Alumnae,

In 1969 when Denise O'Connor asked (actually told) me to hire, organize and assign scorers and timers for the NIWFA Championships being held at Brooklyn College, I was a bit nonplussed. I was a Junior transfer to the BC Physical Education Department, a novice fencer on her Junior Varsity team and had never organized anything of that nature. It was the start of my association with the NIWFA, my administrative career and living the Denise O'Connor tenet of "giving back to fencing."

There is no better role model for that than Denise who has been associated with the NIWFA for over 60 years, wearing one hat or another, to say nothing of her diverse roles within USA Fencing. Her passion for the sport, which she shared through her teaching and coaching, was infectious and had a profound effect on too many of her students to list.

She lived a fundamental principle of the NIWFA, to give women opportunities for leadership roles and mentor and support them. A principle that she continued into retirement and the NIWFA has done successfully for 90 years. The NIWFA was the first organization at whose Championships I fenced, served on a Bout Committee, Chaired a Bout Committee, officiated a gold medal bout, and served as an officer. The fact that they were under Denise's tutelage and while Julia Jones was still actively involved was an honor and a gift. They are two fencing icons.

I am proud of my association with the NIWFA and the fact that my final experience in fencing will be at the 90th Annual Championships. The circle is complete.

Wishing you all the best for the next 90 years of the NIWFA.

Dear Julia,

I have my fulfilled promise to ensure the continuation of your beloved NIWFA. It is time for the younger generation to follow in your footsteps.

I am privileged to have personally worked with a pioneer in women's sports. You were a college freshman interested in athletics but not the right height for basketball. A friend suggested fencing and a legend was born. You started a fencing team and the first organization for women's fencing. You became the first NIWFA Champion as well a member of the first NIWFA Championship team. Three years later you organized the Christmas Invitational for Metropolitan New York college women who traveled home for the holidays. They, in turn, returned to their schools to start fencing programs. Under your leadership and passion for the game, membership increased from the original three teams until twenty six teams participated in two day championships. When the NCAA discovered women's collegiate fencing, you continued to perpetuate the NIWFA. Today we celebrate the 90th consecutive annual championship, the longest of any collegiate athletic championship for women.

I began my association with the NIWFA as a freshman, continued as a coach, an official, an administrator and a personal friend. I inherited your passion for fencing and the NIWFA. I am amongst the women who have experienced athletic competition, both as an individual and a team member, when the doors were closed to women in sport. You have touched so many who are Olympians, coaches, teachers and parents whose daughters fence and carry on with your passion because of your dedication to the development of women fencers.

Senior Judine Watkis put on another stellar performance having won silver at the 2016 NIWFA Christmas Invitational. Paul Yuen has been the head fencing coach for the City College of New York Women's Varsity Fencing Team since 2006 after having served as a volunteer assistant coach two years prior. Coach Yuen took over the fencing program from Roi Green. The team not only does well in competition but they are also extremely bright and studious. The College of New Jersey



The current fencing program at The College of New Jersey has been in existence since 2014. 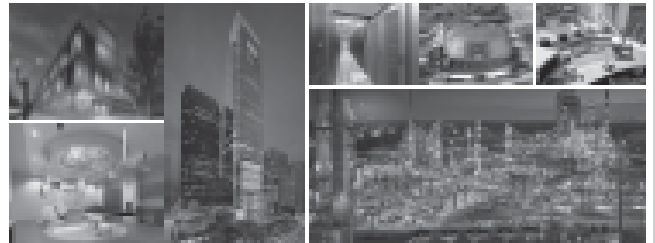

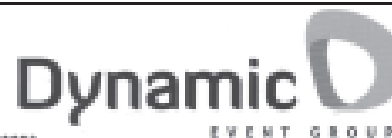
