## QUICK HITTERS

-This marks the 44th season of IUPUI basketball and the 17th the Jaguars have competed at the NCAA Division I level.

-Head Coach **Jason Gardner** is the eighth head coach in the history of the program and is in his second year at the helm. He enters tonight with an 11-22 career record.

-Tonight's game is the second of four games of the 2015 Legends Classic, three of which will be true road games for the Jaguars. The tourney will conclude w/ two games in Georgia next week.

-IUPUI's roster this year consists of six returning letterwinners, four eligible Division I transfers and four freshmen. All four DI transfers will be vying for starting nods over the course of the season.

-Senior guard **Marcellus Barksdale** was voted preseason Second Team All-Summit League and is the program's active career leader in virtually every statistical category.

## NEWS AND NOTES

### RECEIVING VOTES

Coming off the road win at Indiana State, IUPUI received votes in the most recent Mid-Major Top 25 for the first time in a long time. The Jaguars garnered six votes in this week's polls and was one of five Summit League teams considered.

### UPSET THWARTED

IUPUI had upset on the mind at Marquette on Monday night (Nov. 16) before ultimately falling in overtime, 75-71. The Jaguars had a potential game-winning three blocked at the end of regulation and were outscored 6-2 in the extra frame.

**Darell Combs** scored 16 of his game-high 21 points after halftime, including 12 straight at one point. The Jaguars trailed by as many as 10 in the first half, but battled back to knot the score at 36 at the break.

### AFTER THE HALF

Combs has been Mr. Second Half in the season's first two games, scoring 28 of his 37 points this season after halftime.

### CHARITABLE EFFORT

IUPUI was a perfect 10-of-10 at the foul line at Marquette on Monday (Nov. 16). The last time previously IUPUI had been perfect at the line was on Feb. 6, 2014 when the Jags made all 11 in a loss at North Dakota State.

IUPUI is shooting 77.5 percent (31-of-40) at the stripe in the season's first two games.

### FOR OPENERS

IUPUI's season-opening win at Indiana State was the first season-opening victory since 2012 when the Jaguars started with a home win over Utah Valley. It was the first season-opening road win since 2009 when the Jaguars opened with an 88-82 win at Drake that season.

### AGAINST THE ACC

IUPUI hasn't beaten an ACC team since defeating Georgia Tech on Dec. 29, 2001 when the Jags picked off the Jackets, 96-92 in Atlanta.

### AVENGED

The season-opening win at Indiana State avenged a loss from a season ago as ISU defeated the Jags in the 2014-15 opener at Indiana Farmers Coliseum. IUPUI led throughout, including leading by as many as 10 in the first half.

### DEBUTS

Five of IUPUI's nine players that saw the floor at Indiana State on Friday (Nov. 13) were making their IUPUI debuts. All five showed well, including the two true freshmen **Evan Hall** and **T.J. Henderson** coming off the bench.

### SEEING RED

Sophomore guard **D.J. McCall** and freshman forward **Noah Thomas** are expected to redshirt the 2015-16 season. Two duo be joined by Syracuse-transfer **Ron Patterson** in anchoring the practice squad this season.

### THREE SIGNEES

The IUPUI basketball program inked three signees on National Signing Day as **Elyjah Goss (Plainfield, Ill./Plainfield East)**, **Anthony Jones (Indianapolis, Ind./Speedway/FCI)** and **T.J. Washington (Tulsa, Okla./Jenks)** all made their commitments official.

Goss, a 6-foot-7 forward, is considered one of the top power forwards in the state of Illinois while Washington, a 6-foot left-handed point guard, is among the top guards in the state of Oklahoma.

Jones, a 6-foot-5 swingman, was among the city's top players at Speedway High School and is spending this season at Florida Christian Institute in Coral Gables, Fla..

### TRENDING UPWARD

Year one under Head Coach **Jason Gardner** saw huge gains for the IUPUI basketball program. The Jaguars increased their win total against Division I opponents from three to 10 last season and climbed from the basement of The Summit League to a sixth-place 6-10 finish a year ago.

The Jags' non-conference wins included victories at Milwaukee and Pepperine and home wins over Ball State and South Alabama.

### ATTENDANCE INCREASE

IUPUI boasted the nation's 30th largest increase in home attendance last season, gaining more than 900 patrons per game in year one at Indiana Farmers Coliseum. The Jaguars averaged 1,527 fans per home game last season, led by the season-opening 3,159 at the game

against Indiana State.

### BALANCED ATTACK

For the first time in school history a year ago, IUPUI was without a double-digit scorer as then-junior **Marcellus Barksdale** scored a team-high 9.5 points per game. All total, IUPUI had nine different players average between 4.4 and 9.5 points per game, with five of those individuals returning to the 2015-16 roster.

Gardner tried virtually every combination available last season with 10 different players averaging more than 12 minutes per game. Barksdale was the lone IUPUI player to play more than 24 minutes per contest.

### BETWEEN THE LINES

The Jaguars bring back six letterwinners from last year's team, most notably seniors **Marcellus Barksdale** and **Mason Archie, II**.

Barksdale was an honorable mention All-Summit Leaguer last season after posting a team-high 9.5 points per game and 52 steals. He was second on the squad in rebounding (4.7 rpg) and (2.4 apg) was easily the team leader in minutes played (32.0 mpg). Archie, who started 19 games, averaged 7.6 points per game while sinking a team-high 33 treys.

The other four returners are all sophomores - **Aaron Brennan** (6.4 ppg, 3.1 rpg), **D.J. McCall** (4.8 ppg, 2.9 rpg), **Leo Svete** (4.4 ppg, 30 3's) and **John Hubler** (0.3 ppg).

### CELLUS WATCH

Senior **Marcellus Barksdale**, the program's lone four-year senior this season, has quietly stacked up some impressive numbers in his IUPUI career. Barksdale, in his fifth year with the program, has accumulated 690 points, 440 boards and 229 assists.

It's not unreasonable to think Barksdale could finish as the 23rd member of IUPUI's 1,000 Point Club, while also landing in the top 10 on the program's all-time list in rebounds and assists.

### GRADS

Both Barksdale and Archie have earned degrees from IUPUI and are working towards graduate studies this season.

Last year, IUPUI had four grads on the active roster with both Najee and Williams having had earned degrees prior to the season.

### FRESHMAN STARTERS

Both Brennan and McCall were primarily starters a year

ago, despite both being true freshmen.

Brennan shot an efficient 52.2 percent from the floor while averaging 20.9 minutes per game. He also proved to be one of the team's better defenders, collecting 21 steals as an undersized forward.

McCall, a versatile 6-foot-5 guard, started 15 of 31 games and averaged just more than 21 minutes a night. He was third on the squad with 89 boards and 38 assists in his rookie season.

True freshman **Noah Thomas** will be IUPUI's tallest player this season at 6-foot-9 while the shortest players on the team will be 6-foot guards **T.J. Henderson** and **Jordan Pickett**.

### HOOSIER TIES

Gardner, a former Indiana Mr. Basketball, has made a point to rebuild the program with Indiana high schoolers. Of the 15-man roster, 12 hail from the Hoosier state with the lone exceptions being **Darell Combs** from Chicago and Kentucky natives **Marcellus Barksdale** and **Evan Hall**.

### WINNING THE GLASS

Despite being undersized most nights, IUPUI finished the year with a +1.0 board per game rebounding margin. While **DavRon Williams** (6.3 rpg) did much of the work, eight different players collected at least two caroms per game.

### JAGS ON THE TUBE

Every IUPUI home game will be televised this season on Hometown Sports & News (HTSN / RTVG.2), marking the program's fourth straight year in the partnership. Greg Rakestraw and IUPUI Hall of Famer Bob Lovell will be on the call and most games will be simulcast on ESPN3.

### LEGENDS CLASSIC

IUPUI will play four games as part of this year's Legends Classic, sponsored by the Gazelle Group. The Jaguars will open at Marquette (Nov. 16) and then head to N.C. State (Nov. 18) before playing two regional round games in Kennesaw, Ga., on Nov. 23-24.

### DI'S ELIGIBLE

This year's roster includes four DI transfers who practiced with the team a season ago. Three of the four came to IUPUI from Loyola (Ill.) while all four are expected to play major roles this season.

Junior guard **Darell Combs** (Eastern Michigan) averaged 7.5 points per game as a sophomore at EMU, making six starts for the Eagles.

Gardner plucked a pair of 6-foot-8 Loyola-transfers in **Matt O'Leary** and **Nick Osborne**. O'Leary played 61 games (five starts) over two seasons, averaging 4.0 points and 2.6 boards per game. Osborne made 59 appearances (26 starts) and averaged 4.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game.

A third Loyola-transfer later joined the IUPUI program in sophomore guard **Jordan Pickett**. Pickett was one

of the top prep guards in the state of Indiana while at Pike High School, but played just five games in an injury shortened season for the Ramblers.

### NEWBIES

IUPUI has just four freshmen on this year's roster and only three true freshmen. Both **Evan Hall** (Hindman, Ky.) and **T.J. Henderson** (Indianapolis) signed National Letters of Intent with the Jaguars, while **Grant Sinn** (Spencerville, Ind.) and **Noah Thomas** (Whitestown, Ind.) were added as non-scholarship additions.

Hall, a 6-foot-7 forward, was a member of the Kentucky All-Star team after averaging 14.5 points and 8.2 rebounds per game at Knott County Central High School. Hall teamed with Kentucky Mr. Basketball Cameron Justice (Vanderbilt) to help Knott County to a 30-3 record and a KHSAA Boys Sweet Sixteen appearance.

Henderson, a silky 6-foot guard, averaged 29.3 points and five assists per game as a junior at Tindley before opting to attend Scenic his senior year. He helped Scenic gain a state No. 1 ranking and was an All-City selection.

Sinn, a 6-foot-2 guard, came to IUPUI from North Park University in Chicago. Sinn opened the preseason at North Park, but opted to transfer prior to the start of the season. He was among the state's top shooting guards and averaged nearly 20 points per game his senior season.

Thomas comes to IUPUI from Bridgton (Maine) Academy where he was ranked among the top 15 prospects in the state of Maine. Prior to Bridgton, Thomas starred at Traders Point Academy where he averaged 14 points and 13 boards per game as a senior.

### BUSS IN INDY

IUPUI added a huge transfer in the spring, inking former Indianapolis Broad Ripple-product **Ron "Buss" Patterson** to financial paperwork. Patterson played the past two seasons at Syracuse and will have two years of eligibility remaining, beginning in 2016-17.

Patterson originally signed with Indiana after a stand-out career at Broad Ripple High School, but had a parting of ways with the Hoosiers in the summer of 2012. He later played at Brewster Academy, earning New England Prep School Athletic Conference (NEPSAC) Player of the Year honors.

The 6-foot-2 guard played in 39 games for the Orange, averaging 2.6 points and 1.4 assists per game.

Patterson was ranked as the nation's 25th best shooting guard by ESPN.com during his high school recruitment.

### THE DEPARTED

IUPUI's two-man senior class of **Khufu Najee** and

**DavRon Williams** are both considered key losses after solid final years. Najee was a national finalist for the Senior CLASS Award and was chosen as a Division I-AAA Athletics Directors Association (DI-ADA) Scholar Athlete-Team. Despite missing time due to injuries, Najee averaged 7.4 points per game in the IUPUI backcourt.

Williams, in his lone season with the Jaguars, averaged 8.0 points and a team-high 6.3 boards per game while swatting 22 shots. The 6-foot-7 forward shot a team-best 57.7 percent from the floor, primarily off the bench.

### SCORING DOWN

As scoring was down across all levels of college basketball last season, that fact was especially true for the Jaguars. IUPUI averaged school record low 60.7 points per game, shooting just 42.6 percent (lowest percentage since 2007) from the floor.

IUPUI's three-point percentage of 29.6 percent was the program's lowest since the line was adopted in 1986.

### WORKING OVERTIME

Of IUPUI's 31 games a season ago, six went to overtime, including five home contests. IUPUI went 2-4 in overtime games with wins over Ball State and South Alabama. The six overtime games was a school record in the Division I era.

### STAFF PRODUCTION

Few coaching staffs can match the production of the IUPUI coaching quartet during their respective playing days. All total, IUPUI's four coaches combined to score 5,588 points in their four-year careers, led by Gardner's 1,984 points at Arizona. Gardner later had his No. 22 jersey retired at Arizona.

**Scott Gillespie** scored 1,871 points in his four years at Ripon (Wisc.) College while Associate Head Coach **Matt Crenshaw** tallied 938 points in four seasons with the Jaguars.

Lastly, **Jon-Michael Nickerson** scored 795 points in his four-year career at Kennesaw State. Nickerson took a circuitous path to the hardwood, originally playing professional baseball after being drafted by the Florida Marlins in the 16th round of the 2003 MLB Amateur Draft. Nickerson played rookie and Single-A ball before retiring just prior to the 2006 season.

**Jason Gardner** was named the eighth head coach in IUPUI men's basketball program's history on April 2, 2014. Gardner, the 1999 winner of the Indiana Mr. Basketball Award, spent a year on the University of Memphis bench and two seasons at Loyola prior to that.

In his first season on the Jaguars' bench, he guided IUPUI to 10 wins, more than tripling the program's Division I win total from a year prior. His hiring paid immediate dividends on the recruiting trail, as he immediately inked five Division I transfers, four

of whom were former in-state standouts. His success on the recruiting circuit continued leading into the 2015-16 campaign as he landed former Indiana All-Star Ron Patterson from Syracuse, along with former Kentucky All-Star Evan Hall and talented Indianapolis guard T.J. Henderson.

While at Memphis, Gardner helped the Tigers to a 24-10 record as Shaq Goodwin and Joe Jackson earned All-Conference accolades. In addition, Memphis forward Austin Nichols was a unanimous selection to the American Athletic Conference All-Rookie Team after averaging 9.1 points and 4.2 boards per game. Gardner was a college teammate of current Memphis Head Coach Josh Pastner at Arizona.

Prior to coming to Memphis, Gardner was an assistant under Porter Moser at Loyola, helping the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement from 2011-12 to 2012-13. He coached Ben Averkamp to All-Horizon League accolades for two straight seasons, while Loyola point guard Cully Payne was a Bob Cousy Award nominee. He also helped recruit one of the top signing classes in the Horizon League prior to the 2012-13 season. Gardner's coaching career began in 2010 when he served as an assistant at nearby Cathedral High School.

Gardner's racked up numerous accolades during his prestigious high school, college and professional playing careers. He was a 1999 McDonald's and Parade All-American while at North Central High School, finishing his prep career with a school record 1,669 points. He was a two-time Gatorade Circle of Champions Indiana Player of the Year and was named the 1998-99 Indianapolis County Player of the Year by The Indianapolis Star and Indianapolis News. His senior season, he helped NCHS to the IHSAA 4A state championship and Tournament of Champions title while averaging 22.6 points, 4.7 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game.

The 5-foot-10 point guard was recruited to the University of Arizona by legendary Head Coach Lute Olsen, where he was a four-year All-American for the Wildcats. He was the 2002-03 Naismith National Player of the Year and Lowe's Senior CLASS award recipient. He was the 2000 consensus National Freshman of the Year and closed his career as one of four players in Pac-12 history with 1,500 points, 500 assists and 200 steals for a career. He helped lead Arizona to two Pac-12 regular season titles (2000, 2003) and four consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. The Wildcats made three Sweet Sixteens (2001, 2002, 2003), two Elite Eights (2001, 2003) and were the NCAA national runner-up in 2001. All total, Arizona won 107 games during Gardner's four seasons and he still holds school records for games started (135) and minutes played (4,825), while ranking third in school history with 1,984 career points. He also finished second in threes made (318) and fourth in assists (622). He earned his degree from the university in 2011 in disciplinary studies.

Gardner later played professionally overseas for more than eight years, primarily in Germany. In 2009, he was named MVP of German Basketball Bundesliga after helping Oldenburg to the league crown, averaging 13.7 points, 4.0 assists and 3.0 boards per game. He was a two-time Basketball Bundesliga All-Star, including starting the 2007 game.

Gardner is married to the former Jacquelyn Maxberry and the couple has four children, Jasper, Jason Jr., Jacob and Jackson.
