The Starting 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game

1. #WOLFPACKNYC

In the last 13 months, the NC State men's basketball program has been no stranger to New York City. The two games in Brooklyn will be the team's third visit to the Big Apple in a little more than a year. The team took an educational sightseeing trip during the school's fall break in 2014 and then played West Virginia in Madison Square Garden last December. The educational trip included visits to Rucker Park, the Empire State Building, Amateur Night at the Apollo, Motown: The Musical, the New York Stock Exchange, the National September 11 Memorial and the American Museum of Natural History. While on the trip, the Wolfpack practiced twice at the New York Athletic Club.

2. LEGENDS CLASSIC

NC State is making its first-ever trip to the Barclays Center, which will be the host of the 2017 and 2018 ACC Men's Basketball Tournaments. The Pack enters Monday's game after a pair of home victories in the regional rounds of the Legends Classic. After playing the Sun Devils, a potential match-up with LSU on Tuesday would be a rematch of last season's NCAA Tournament game in Pittsburgh, when the Pack edged the Tigers 66-65 on a last-second shot by BeeJay Anya. The most famous NC State-Marquette game, of course, was State's 76-64 win over Marquette in the 1974 national title game.

3. ARIZONA STATE MUST HAVE A GOOD SCOUT

Under first-year coach Bobby Hurley, Arizona State figures to have a pretty good scouting report on NC State. ASU assistant coach Levi Watkins is a 2005 NC State graduate and spent two seasons on Mark Gottfried's staff from 2011-13. Watkins played in 97 games for NC State, helping the team to four straight NCAA tourney appearances and a Sweet 16 run in 2005. With Watkins on Gottfried's staff, the Wolfpack made another Sweet 16 trip in 2012.

4. 2 GAMES, 2 DAYS, 8 SCHOLARSHIP PLAYERS

It's no secret that the Wolfpack is thin when it comes to its number of active players, and that will make the two-game swing in Brooklyn a great challenge. Mark Gottfried right now has eight full scholarship players available to him and just 11 players in uniform overall. After losing three of its top four scorers from last season, the Wolfpack saw starting guard Terry Henderson suffer torn ligaments in his right ankle just seven minutes into the regular season.

5. RIDING WITH THE STARTERS

After three games, Mark Gottfried has largely rode with the most recent starting five of Cat Barber, Maverick Rowan and Caleb Martin on the perimeter and Lennard Freeman and Abdul-Malik Abu inside. That group has combined for 464 of the season's 600 minutes, meaning those five players have played 77.3 percent of NC State's possible minutes. Individually, Barber has only subbed out once when he was hit in the nose and twice late when NC State's wins were in hand. Additionally, Martin is playing 36.7 minutes after seeing just 16.6 minutes per game last year.





Mark Gottfried

- Defeated 4 current Hall of Fame coaches during the 2014-15 season, with wins over Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, Louisville's Rick Pitino, UNC's Roy Williams and Jim Boeheim of Syracuse.
- Is just 3rd coach in ACC history to take his first four teams to the NCAA Tournament. (Roy Williams, Skip Prosser)
- Won 92 games in 4 seasons at NC State, the most at NCSU over a four-year span since 1981-85.
- One of 4 all-time ACC coaches to lead his team to the ACC Tournament semifinal round in each of his first 3 seasons.
- Won more games in his first 2 seasons with the Pack (48) than any coach in school history except Everett Case (55) in 1947 and 1948.
- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Voted 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.
- His 2003-04 Alabama squad advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, the longest tourney run in school history.

3 Seasons at Murray State (68-24 overall)

- Won an OVC title in each of his 3 seasons and was OVC Coach of the Year all 3 seasons.

HENDERSON EXPECTED TO MISS 6-8 WEEKS

Terry Henderson, a redshirt junior from Raleigh who was projected as a starter for NC State this season, is expected to miss a minimum of 6-8 weeks after tearing ligaments in his right ankle in the season opener on Nov. 13. He suffered the setback just seven minutes into his Wolfpack career after sitting out the 2014-15 season as a transfer. He averaged 11.7 points per game as a sophomore at West Virginia in 2013-14.

KEEP IT IN NEUTRAL

Some of NC State's best moments in recent seasons have come on netural courts. The Pack has made two Sweet 16 runs in the last four years and won seven games in the ACC Tournament during that time. **State is 16-11 in neutral-court games** under Mark Gottfried.

THE COLOR PURPLE

Not only does Mark Gottfried allow his team to play on big stages, he also makes a point to introduce is players to experiences off the court as well. On Saturday night, the team went to the Jacobs Theater on 45th Street in Manhattan to see The Color Purple.

NEAR TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Cat Barber nearly recorded a triple-double in tihe Pack's win over South Alabama. Barber posted 17 points and a career-high 12 rebounds to go along with eight assists in the win. Barber, who is shooting just 7-for-27 from the floor, made 11 of his 12 foul shots in the game. There has only been one triple-double in NC State history. It was authored by Julius Hodge in December 2002 against North Carolina A&T (11 points, 12 rebounds, 10 assists).

NOVEMBER AT NC STATE

NC State is 21-7 in the month of November under Mark Gottfried. The Pack has won 10 of its last 1 games played during the calendar's 11th month. NC State is 38-10 during November dating back to 2007.

CALEB'S ADJUSTMENT MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Caleb Martin came to NC State known as a deadly long-range shooter. However, he shot just .305 from 3-point range last season and less than 36 percent on all of his attempts. In the offseason, Martin tweaked his shooting form to be "quieter" and more straight-ahead. Specifially, he now keeps the ball more the the right and has removed a hitch from his motion. The changes have paid off as he made 11 of his first 18 shots from beyond the arc and he's currently shooting .458 from 3-point range.

MORE ON BIG CAT

While Anthony Barber is famously known as Cat, his mother, Pamela Barber, has always **called him Big Cat**. He will need to be a big cat this season for the Wolfpack. Barber, a second team preseason All-ACC pick, will be counted on to play major minutes while running the team and contributing his usual standout on-the-ball defense. Barber was the 'Big Cat' down the stretch for the Pack last season, **averaging 14.6 points and 4.0 assists per game over the last 14 games of the season**. Included in that run was a career-best performance of **34 points in the ACC second round against Pittsburgh**.

BEE-JAY AN-YA!

BeeJay Anya, who led the ACC with 2.53 blocks per game last season, has moved into fourth place on NC State's all-time career blocks list. He swatted 91 shots last season, which was the second-highest total in NC State history. His 147 blocked shots is just three shy of Kevin Thompson (1989-93) for second place in school history.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya is one of the largest players in college basketball. He's actually trimmed down considerably, having **lost nearly 80 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Ddiaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

MORE FROM MALIK

After three games, Abdul-Malik Abu is averaging 15.0 points and 7.0 rebounds while leading the team with seven dunks. Yet, Mark Gottfried has said the talented and athletic sophomore can do even more. Abu, a 6-8 forward from Boston, was selected by many national outlets as a potential breakout player after averaging 6.4 points per game and starting 22 times as a freshman.

TAKING CARE OF IT

NC State has been one of the better teams in the nation in taking care of the ball. Last season, **State ranked 25th in the nation** with a 16.0% turnover rate, the fifth best mark in the ACC.

NC State is wearing black "Iced Out" alternate uniforms on Tuesday night in Brooklyn.



EFFICIENT 'D'

NC State is **currently 39th in the nation** in defending 2-point field goals. Opponents inside the arc are shooting just .392 against NC State, a mark that is sixth in the ACC. The Pack limited South Alabama to .298 shooting on 2-pointers, while IUPUI shot just .314.

NARD'S LEG

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, missed several weeks of the summer after undergoing successful surgery on his leg. The 6-8 junior had a 14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg to heal a fracture. Freeman grabbed 5.6 boards per game last season and had a double-double in State's NCAA Tournament win over Villanova.

PUT LENNARD IN THE GAME

The NC State coaching staff couldn't quite but its finger on it, but there was something about how the Pack played last year when Lennard Freeman was in the game. **NC State had an 11-1 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes and he played 27.6 minutes per game in the five games NC State won in March. Furthermore, Freeman averaged 7.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in State's two NCAA Tournament victories.

TOP GUN

A late addition to the roster this summer was Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Rowan, whose father played college basketball at St. John's and was a fan of the Top Gun movie, is averaging 15.3 points per game. Rowan, who won a high school state title in both Pennsylvania and Florida, averaged 28.5 points last year as a high school junior.

GOTTFRIED'S DRIVE FOR FIVE

Head coach Mark Gottfried enters the 2015-16 season with a chance to accomplish something only one other coach in ACC basketball history has matched. Gottfried has led his program to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first four seasons, which has only been accomplished by Skip Prosser (first 4 years) and Roy Williams (first 6 years). NC State is one of just 16 teams in the nation to have played in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments.

ASKING A LOT OF THE SOPHOMORES

With the team's two top scorers from last season gone, and now the injury to Terry Henderson, NC State is relying even more on its sophomores. Here's a breakdown of the increase in production from Caleb Martin and Abdul-Malik Abu:

Not since the NC State glory days of David Thompson has NC State won like it has the last four seasons. The Wolfpack was 92-52 in the last four seasons under Gottfried, which is the program's highest win total for a four-year span since the Pack won 100 games from 1972-76.

STATE, GOTTFRIED IN SEASON OPENERS

The Wolfpack's loss to William & Mary dropped the Pack to 58-5 all-time in season openers since ACC play began in 1953. It was NC State's first season-opening loss since a 94-80 setback to Weber State back on Nov. 24, 1993. Mark Gottfried is now 14-5 all-time in season openers (4-1 at NC State, 7-4 at Alabama, 3-0 at Murray State).

PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout. Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

COME TO STATE, STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.

THANK YOU #WPN

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

NATIONALLY-RANKED AT THE FINISH

After wins over LSU and Villanova landed the Wolfpack in the Sweet 16, NC State was listed in the season's final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Pack was ranked No. 24 in the final poll. It was the first time finishing the season ranked since the team's Sweet 16 run in 2012, which landed the Pack at No. 20 in the final ranking.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physcially to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'. Martin was lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness. That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 18.3 points per game. He set career highs for points (21), field goals (8), 3-pointers made (5), steals and minutes (38) against William & Mary and then followed that with a team-high 19 points against South Alabama.

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.




