The Starting 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game**1. COMING HOME AFTER A MARQUEE WIN**

NC State is bringing the momentum of a neutral-court win over a nationally-ranked opponent back home to PNC Arena for a stretch of home games. The Wolfpack's overtime win over LSU in the Barclays Center is followed by three consecutive home games. Friday's game against Winthrop is the start of a stretch that will see the Pack also host Michigan and Patriot League favorite Bucknell before final exams. Four of the Wolfpack's next five games are at PNC Arena.

2. CAT'S CLASSIC

Cat Barber was named to the all-tournament team at the Legends Classic after leading the team to a 3-1 record in the event. Barber ran the Wolfpack in Brooklyn to the tune of 15 assists against three turnovers while averaging 21.0 points and 6.5 rebounds per game. Barber made 24 of his 26 foul shots at the Barclay Center, including the final six free throws that put the LSU victory on ice. He also assisted on the Pack's last field goal of the game, a game-changing, fast-break lay-up by Maverick Rowan. In his postgame comments, Mark Gottfried called his point guard's play in Brooklyn "phenomenal."

3. DOUBLE TROUBLE

While going up against freshman phenom Ben Simmons of LSU, it was the Martin twins who came out on top. Caleb and Cody Martin combined for 30 points and 19 rebounds, as Caleb Martin made four 3-pointers and scored 16 points while his older brother posted his first career double-double (14 points, 10 rebounds). The twins also combined for seven assists and five steals while each played 37 minutes. Cody drew the primary responsibility of slowing down the 6-10 Simmons who totaled four points on 1-for-6 shooting before fouling out. With Simmons playing with four fouls in overtime, the Wolfpack isolated Cody Martin vs. Simmons, who committed his final foul when the Wolfpack twin attacked him on the offensive end.

4. 20 YEARS AGO TO THE DAY

Coincidentally, NC State and Winthrop met on the hardwood exactly 20 years before Friday's game. The Wolfpack cruised past Winthrop 97-48 on Nov. 27, 1995 at Reynolds Coliseum. The Pack, which led by 25 at halftime, got 23 points and 10 rebounds from 1996 NBA Draft pick Todd Fuller and 20 points from Jason Sutton. NC State shot 13-for-28 from 3-point range that night, as Fuller made four long-range shots.

5. A ROTATION BUILT FOR MARCH

Under normal circumstances, a tourney-bound basketball team would pare down its rotation during the postseason. NC State hasn't been afforded those normal circumstances. The Wolfpack is essentially playing a seven-player rotation. In the two games in Brooklyn this week, seven players played all 425 possible minutes (Shaun Kirk appeared for 0:06 of game time vs. Arizona State). NC State's primary seven-player rotation has played 1,014 of the season's 1,025 minutes (98.9 percent). Cat Barber is playing an ACC-leading 39.2 minutes per game, while Caleb Martin and Maverick Rowan are each playing more than 33 minutes per game.

- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Voted 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.

HENDERSON EXPECTED TO MISS 6-8 WEEKS

Terry Henderson, a redshirt junior from Raleigh who was projected as a starter for NC State this season, is expected to miss a minimum of 6-8 weeks after tearing ligaments in his right ankle in the season opener on Nov. 13. He suffered the setback just seven minutes into his Wolfpack career after sitting out the 2014-15 season as a transfer. He averaged 11.7 points per game as a sophomore at West Virginia in 2013-14.

HOME SWEET PNC

NC State, in its 16th season at PNC Arena, owns a **193-74 all-time record** at the multi-purpose building in west Raleigh. Mark Gottfried **owns a 54-18 mark at PNC Arena**, which is the eighth-largest home court in all of college basketball.

OVERTIME IN NO TIME AT ALL

NC State's overtime win over LSU came in no time at all. The 45-minute contest was played in a **real-time mark of 2 hours, 2 minutes**. It is believed to be the fastest-played overtime game in recent college basketball history.

THE ACC'S BEST FREE THROW SHOOTER

Cat Barber, an all-tourney team pick at the Legends Classic, is currently the best free throw shooter in the ACC. The 6-2 point guard **leads the ACC with 47 made foul shots** and he stands **third in the league in free throw percentage**. Barber was 24-for-26 at the line in the two games in Brooklyn.

NEAR TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Cat Barber nearly recorded a triple-double in the Pack's win over South Alabama. Barber posted 17 points and a career-high 12 rebounds to go along with eight assists in the win. Barber, who is shooting just 7-for-27 from the floor, made 11 of his 12 foul shots in the game. There has only been one triple-double in NC State history (Julius Hodge, December 2002 vs. North Carolina A&T (11 points, 12 rebounds, 10 assists).

CALEB'S ADJUSTMENT MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Caleb Martin came to NC State known as a deadly long-range shooter. However, he shot just .305 from 3-point range last season and less than 36 percent on all of his attempts. In the offseason, Martin tweaked his shooting form to be "quieter" and more straight-ahead. Specifically, he now keeps the ball more to the right and has removed a hitch from his motion. The changes have paid off as he **is leading the ACC in 3-pointers made per game (3.60)** while shooting .439 from 3-point land.

MORE ON BIG CAT

While Anthony Barber is famously known as Cat, his mother, Pamela Barber, has always **called him Big Cat**. Barber, a second team preseason All-ACC pick, was the 'Big Cat' down the stretch for the Pack last season, **averaging 14.6 points and 4.0 assists per game over the last 14 games of the season**. Included in that run was a career-best performance of 34 points in the ACC second round against Pittsburgh.

BEE-JAY AN-YA!

BeeJay Anya, who led the ACC with **2.53 blocks per game last season**, is one rejection away from second place on NC State's all-time career blocks list. He swatted 91 shots last season, which was the second-highest total in NC State history. Anya has 149 blocked shots one shy of Kevin Thompson (1989-93) for second place in school history.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya is one of the largest players in college basketball. He's actually trimmed down considerably, having **lost nearly 80 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Diaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

MORE FROM MALIK

After three games, Abdul-Malik Abu is averaging 15.0 points and 7.0 rebounds while leading the team with seven dunks. Yet, Mark Gottfried has said the talented and athletic sophomore can do even more. Abu, a 6-8 forward from Boston, was selected by many national outlets as a potential breakout player after averaging 6.4 points per game and starting 22 times as a freshman.

CODY SHAKES ILLNESS FOR BEST GAMES

Cody Martin sat out last Sunday's practice in Brooklyn due to illness. he felt better Monday and was cleared to play against Arizona State, when he scored a season-high 10 points. He followed that with a new career highs of 14 points, 10 rebounds and four steals in the LSU victory. Cody Martin **averaged 12.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in the two games in NYC**.

EFFICIENT 'D'

NC State is **currently 39th in the nation** in defending 2-point field goals. Opponents inside the arc are shooting just .392 against NC State, a mark that is sixth in the ACC. The Pack limited South Alabama to .298 shooting on 2-pointers, while IUPUI shot just .314.

NARD'S LEG

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, missed several weeks of the summer after undergoing successful surgery on his leg. The 6-8 junior had **a 14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg** to heal a fracture. Freeman grabbed 5.6 boards per game last season and had a double-double in State's NCAA Tournament win over Villanova.

PUT LENNARD IN THE GAME

The NC State coaching staff couldn't quite but its finger on it, but there was something about how the Pack played last year when Lennard Freeman was in the game. **NC State had an 11-1 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes and he played 27.6 minutes per game in the five games NC State won in March.

TOP GUN

A late addition to the roster this summer was Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Rowan, whose father played college basketball at St. John's and **was a fan of the Top Gun movie**, is averaging **14.0 points per game**. Rowan, who won a high school state title in both Pennsylvania and Florida, has scored in double figures in all five games this season.

GOTTFRIED'S DRIVE FOR FIVE

Head coach Mark Gottfried enters the 2015-16 season with a chance to accomplish something only one other coach in ACC basketball history has matched. Gottfried has **led his program to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first four seasons, which has only been accomplished by Skip Prosser (first 4 years) and Roy Williams (first 6 years)**. NC State is one of just 16 teams in the nation to have played in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments.

ASKING A LOT OF THE SOPHOMORES

With the team's two top scorers from last season gone, and now the injury to Terry Henderson, NC State is relying even more on its sophomores. Here's a breakdown of the increase in production from Caleb Martin and Abdul-Malik Abu:

The testing consists of five tests: **Standing Vertical Jump; Approach Vertical Jump; 3/4 Court Sprint; Reaction Shuttle; 4-Way Agility Drill.**

PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is **ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout.** Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

COME TO STATE, STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, **only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.**

THANK YOU #WPN

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, **the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase**, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

NATIONALLY-RANKED AT THE FINISH

After wins over LSU and Villanova landed the Wolfpack in the Sweet 16, NC State was listed in the season's final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Pack was ranked No. 24 in the final poll. It was the first time finishing the season ranked since the team's Sweet 16 run in 2012, which landed the Pack at No. 20 in the final ranking.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physically to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'. Martin was lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness. That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 18.3 points per game. He set career highs for points (21), field goals (8), 3-pointers made (5), steals and minutes (38) against William & Mary and then followed that with a team-high 19 points against South Alabama.

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.

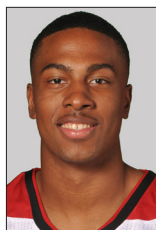
WHAT DO WE NEED TO REPLACE?

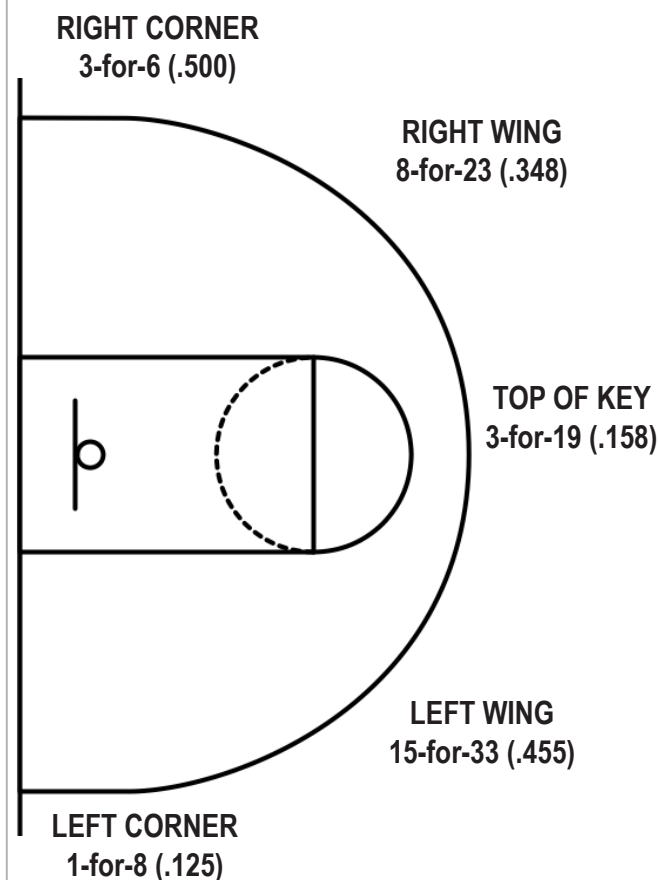

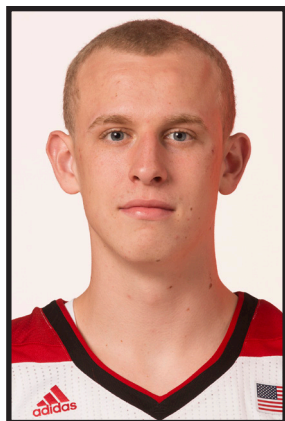

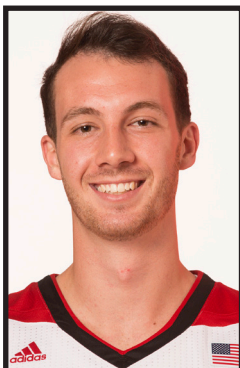
