The Starting 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game**1. OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION**

The Wolfpack is averaging nearly 80 points per game this season, and it reached rare heights on the offensive end of the floor in last week's 99-86 victory over Bucknell. The Wolfpack's 99-point output was the team's most under Gottfried and the highest point total in a game since the Pack beat ECU 100-66 in 2004. State shot .544 from the floor, the team's highest mark since shooting .556 last season against West Virginia in Madison Square Garden. Individually, the win featured three Wolfpackers (Cat Barber, Maverick Rowan, Caleb Martin) scoring 20 points or more. It was the first time three NC State players scored 20 or more points in the same game since 1990.

2. CAT GETTING TO THE LINE AT A RECORD RATE

Using his quickness and ballhandling, Cat Barber has found his way to the free throw line at a record rate. He ranks **third in the nation with 89 foul shot attempts**, and is on pace to break the school record for free throw attempts in a season (355 by Mel Thompson in 1954). Additionally, he draws 8.5 fouls per game, which **ranks 15th in the nation and third among players playing in Power 5 conferences**. NC State is 5-1 when Barber, who averages 11.1 free throw attempts per game, shoots 10 or more free throws.

3. RETURN GAME

Sunday's contest is the second half of a home-and-home series between the Wolfpack and the Bulls. As part of the Global Sports Invitational last season, NC State downed South Florida 68-65 in Raleigh last November. Cat Barber scored 10 points and BeeJay Anya totaled eight points, nine rebounds and six blocks to lead NC State, which led 65-56 with 2:11 left before the Bulls made a late push.

4. CALEB AND MAVERICK MAKING ALL THE TREYS

Caleb Martin and Maverick Rowan are among this season's most prolific 3-point shooters in the ACC. In fact, the young wing players have been the team's complete attack on the perimeter, **combining to make all 46 of the team's 3-point shots**. Martin stands second in the ACC with 3.38 made 3-pointers per game and Rowan is tied for seventh in the league with 2.38 per game. As a team, NC State takes 27.6 percent of its total shots from 3-point range (315th highest in the nation).

5. POST PLAYER SHUFFLE

Mark Gottfried has said multiple times this season NC State will need more production out of post players, Lennard Freeman, BeeJay Anya and Abdul-Malik Abu. In the Bucknell win, Gottfried inserted Anya into the starting lineup in place of Freeman. Coming off the bench resulted in Freeman's best performance of the season, his first double-double of the season where he tied his career high of 13 rebounds. Abu shook a mini-slump and produced 11 points and nine rebounds against Bucknell.

HENDERSON EXPECTED TO MISS 6-8 WEEKS

Terry Henderson, a redshirt junior from Raleigh who was projected as a starter for NC State this season, is **expected to miss a minimum of 6-8 weeks** after tearing ligaments in his right ankle in the season opener on Nov. 13. He suffered the setback just seven minutes into his Wolfpack career after sitting out the 2014-15 season as a transfer. He averaged 11.7 points per game as a sophomore at West Virginia in 2013-14.

SOMETHING HAS TO GIVE ON THE PERIMETER

NC State has seen several players find a hot hand this season, and the result has been **the Pack ranking 277th in the nation in 3-point field goal defense (.373)**. Sunday's game at USF, statistically, figures to help the Wolfpack improve in that area. The Bulls shoot just .232 from 3-point range on the year, which is **the worst percentage in the nation**. USF doesn't have a single player shooting better than .278 from long range this season.

A ROTATION BUILT FOR POSTSEASON - ALREADY

It's not uncommon for a team to tighten its rotation at the end of the season, as conference and national tournaments approach. NC State, however, has been forced to go with a condensed lineup, playing essentially a seven-player rotation. State's seven main players **have played 1,606 of the team's possible 1,625 minutes (98.83%)**.

CAT GETTING TO THE LINE

Cat Barber has already taken 89 foul shots this season, ranking third in the nation. Here are some of Barber's most prolific foul shooting games this season:

CALEB'S ADJUSTMENT MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Caleb Martin came to NC State known as a deadly long-range shooter. However, he shot just .305 from 3-point range and less than 36 percent on all of his attempts last season. In the offseason, Martin tweaked his shooting form to be "quieter" and more straight-ahead. Specifically, he now keeps the ball more to the right and has removed a hitch from his motion. The changes have paid off as he **is second in the ACC in 3-pointers made per game (3.38)** while shooting .415 from 3-point land.

Maverick Rowan scored a career-high 27 points last weekend, with Cat Barber getting 24 and Caleb Martin adding 21. It was the **first time three Wolfpackers scored 20 points in the same game since Nov. 28, 1990** when Chris Corchiani (36 points), Rodney Monroe (25) and Bryant Feggins (23) did so in a 135-88 win over Charleston Southern.

BEE-JAY AN-YA!

BeeJay Anya, the current ACC leader with **2.75 blocks per game**, has moved into second place on NC State's all-time career blocks list. He enters Sunday with 159 career blocked shots, 47 short of the school record held by Thurl Bailey (1979-83). He swatted 91 shots last season, which was the second-highest total in NC State history. He is also **the ACC's active leader in blocked shots**, one ahead of Clemson's Landry Noko.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya is one of the largest players in college basketball. He's actually trimmed down considerably, having **lost nearly 80 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Diaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

CODY SHAKES ILLNESS FOR BEST GAMES

Cody Martin battled illness when NC State went to Brooklyn, missing a practice. He recovered in time to play against Arizona State, when he scored a season-high 10 points. He followed that with a new career highs of 14 points, 10 rebounds and four steals in the LSU victory. Cody Martin **averaged 12.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in the two games in NYC.**

NARD'S LEG

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, missed several weeks of the summer after undergoing successful surgery on his leg. The 6-8 junior had **a 14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg** to heal a fracture. Freeman grabbed 5.6 boards per game last season and had a double-double in State's NCAA Tournament win over Villanova.

PUT LENNARD IN THE GAME

When Lennard Freeman plays and produces, the Wolfpack usually wins. Last season, **NC State had an 11-1 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes. In games where the junior grabs eight or more rebounds, NC State is 19-3. The Pack is 11-0 when Freeman grabbed 10 or more rebounds.

TOP GUN

A late addition to the roster this summer was Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Rowan, whose father played college basketball at St. John's and **was a fan of the Top Gun movie**, is averaging 14.9 points per game after scoring a career-high 27 points against Bucknell. Rowan, who won a high school state title in both Pennsylvania and Florida, has scored in double figures in seven of the season's eight games.

GOTTFRIED'S DRIVE FOR FIVE

Head coach Mark Gottfried enters the 2015-16 season with a chance to accomplish something only one other coach in ACC basketball history has matched. Gottfried has **led his program to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first four seasons, which has only been accomplished by Skip Prosser (first 4 years) and Roy Williams (first 6 years).** NC State is one of just 16 teams in the nation to have played in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments.

ASKING A LOT OF THE SOPHOMORES

With the team's two top scorers from last season gone, and the injury to Terry Henderson, NC State is relying even more on its young players to produce. Here's a breakdown of the increase in production from Caleb Martin and Abdul-Malik Abu:

DECEMBER AT NC STATE

NC State owns a **23-8 record in the month of December** under Mark Gottfried. The Pack had at one point won 16 straight December games during 2011, 2012 and 2013. NC State is 41-17 during the 12th month dating back to 2007.

State's 87-79 shootout win over Winthrop featured 37 points from Cat Barber and 38 points from Winthrop's Jimmy Gavin:

PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is **ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout.** Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

COME TO STATE, STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, **only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.**

THANK YOU #WPN

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, **the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase**, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the **Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.** Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

NATIONALLY-RANKED AT THE FINISH

After wins over LSU and Villanova landed the Wolfpack in the Sweet 16, NC State was listed in the season's final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Pack was ranked No. 24 in the final poll. It was the first time finishing the season ranked since the team's Sweet 16 run in 2012, which landed the Pack at No. 20 in the final ranking.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physically to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'. Martin was lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness. That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 18.3 points per game. He set career highs for points (21), field goals (8), 3-pointers made (5), steals and minutes (38) against William & Mary and then followed that with a team-high 19 points against South Alabama.

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.

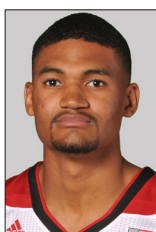

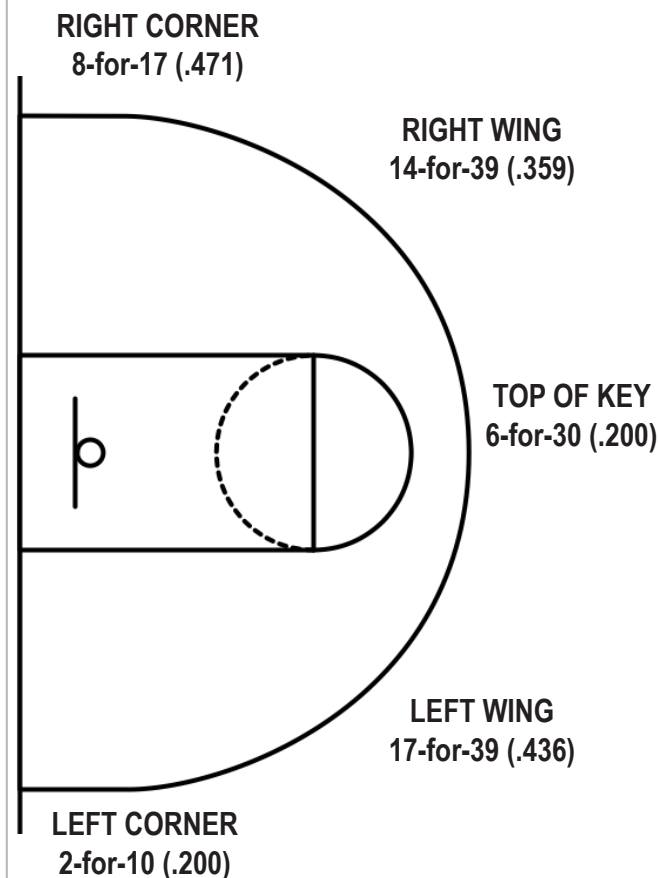
