THE STARTING 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game**1. 100 WINS AT STATE**

Mark Gottfried has now coached NC State to 98 wins in his first 153 games. Wins in the next two games (vs. High Point and at Missouri) would make him **the second-fastest Wolfpack coach to 100 wins in school history**. The legendary Everett Case reached 100 wins at NC State in just 120 games. Jim Valvano reached the mark in 156 games, meaning two wins over the next three games would tie Gottfried with Valvano for the school's second-fastest to 100 Wolfpack victories.

2. AT THE LINE SHOOTING 2...CAT BARBER

Using his quickness and ballhandling, Cat Barber has found his way to the free throw line at a record rate. **He ranks second in the nation in free throws made (84)** and is also third in free throw attempts (97). Barber is on pace to break the school record for free throw attempts in a season (355 by Mel Thompson in 1954). Additionally, he draws 8.5 fouls per game, which **ranks 15th in the nation and third among players playing in Power 5 conferences**. NC State owns a 5-1 record when Barber, who averages 10.5 free throw attempts per game, shoots 10 or more free throws.

3. SO...HOW'S HIGH POINT?

High Point, which won 23 games last season and has won a share of the Big South regular season title three years running, was picked to win its conference again this year. The Panthers are led by athletic 6-8 forward John Brown, the team's leading scorer (20.6 ppg) and rebounder (7.6 rpg). High Point is 14th in the nation in 3-point shooting percentage (.424) and HPU's only two losses (to Texas Tech and Georgia) have come by a combined seven points.

4. GETTING MORE FROM THE BIGS

Mark Gottfried has said multiple times this season NC State will need more production out of post players, and in the last few games the Pack's big men have answered. Lennard Freeman, BeeJay Anya and Abdul-Malik Abu have each had their best moments over the last two games. In the Bucknell win, Freeman recorded a double-double (10 points, 13 rebounds). Against South Florida, Abu had a double-double that featured a career-best 14 rebounds and dunked four times. Anya had perhaps his finest outing as a Wolfpacker, totaling a career-high 17 points on 7-for-8 shooting with seven rebounds and five blocks.

5. HI NEIGHBOR, WELCOME TO RALEIGH

Long before the Pack played at Reynolds Coliseum, North Carolina State College and High Point College played five times in men's basketball. As college athletics evolved and NC State moved from the Southern Conference to the ACC, High Point spent many years competing at the NAIA and NCAA Division II levels. The two schools, located just 89 miles apart, played in 1948 and didn't meet again until November of 2008. Wednesday's contest is the seventh meeting between the two schools and the Pack has won all six of the previous meetings.

- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Voted 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.
- His 2003-04 Alabama squad advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, the longest tourney run in school history.

HENDERSON EXPECTED TO MISS 6-8 WEEKS

Terry Henderson, a redshirt junior from Raleigh who was projected as a starter for NC State this season, is still out after tearing ligaments in his right ankle in the season opener on Nov. 13. He suffered the setback just seven minutes into his Wolfpack career after sitting out the 2014-15 season as a transfer. He averaged 11.7 points per game as a sophomore at West Virginia in 2013-14.

EVERYBODY'S GETTING INTO THE ACT

Through eight games this season, only two Pack players had made a 3-pointer. Caleb Martin and Maverick Rowan combined to make the season's first 46 and 47 of the first 48 shots from long range. In the USF game, Cat Barber knocked down his first trey of the season (he's 1-for-14) and Shaun Kirk made a '3' late in the game, the first of his career. As a team, NC State takes 28 percent of its total shots from 3-point range (304th highest in the nation).

A ROTATION BUILT FOR POSTSEASON - ALREADY

It's not uncommon for a team to tighten its rotation at the end of the season, as conference and national tournaments approach. NC State, however, has been forced to go with a condensed lineup, playing essentially a seven-player rotation. State's seven main players have played 1,802 of the team's possible 1,825 minutes (98.74%).

CAT GETTING TO THE LINE

Cat Barber is second in the nation in made foul shots (84) and third nationally in foul shots taken (97). Here are some of Barber's most prolific foul shooting games this season:

CALEB, MAVERICK FROM LONG RANGE

Caleb Martin, much improved after shooting .305 from 3-point range last year, is currently second in the ACC in 3-pointers made per game (3.11). In the offseason, Martin tweaked his shooting form to keep the ball more the the right and has removed a hitch from his motion. Freshman Maverick Rowan has been the Pack's other long-range threat, standing ninth in the ACC with 2.11 made treys per game. Martin has made four 3-pointers in a game four times this season and Rowan has done it twice.

BALLIN' AGAINST BUCKNELL

The Wolfpack reached rare heights on the offensive end of the floor in last week's 99-86 victory over Bucknell. The Wolfpack's 99-point output was the team's most under Gottfried and the highest point total in a game since the Pack beat ECU 100-66 in 2004. State also shot a season-high .544 from the floor.

ROLLIN' ON 20s

Maverick Rowan scored a career-high 27 points last weekend, with Cat Barber getting 24 and Caleb Martin adding 21. It was the first time three Wolfpackers scored 20 points in the same game since Nov. 28, 1990 when Chris Corchiani (36 points), Rodney Monroe (25) and Bryant Feggins (23) did so in a 135-88 win over Charleston Southern.

BEE-JAY AN-YA!

BeeJay Anya, the current ACC leader with 3.00 blocks per game, has moved into second place on NC State's all-time career blocks list. He enters Wednesday with 164 career blocked shots, 42 short of the school record held by Thurl Bailey (1979-83). He swatted 91 shots last season, which was the second-highest total in NC State history. He is also the ACC's active leader in blocked shots, two ahead of Clemson's Landry Nnoko.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya is one of the largest players in college basketball. He's actually trimmed down considerably, having lost nearly 80 pounds since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Diaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

LENNARD'S THE MAN OF STEEL

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, is rounding into form after missing several months of the offseason healing a fracture in his lower right leg. He had successful surgery in May, and now has a **14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg** to heal a fracture. Freeman grabbed 5.6 boards per game last season and had a double-double in State's NCAA Tournament win over Villanova.

LENNARD OFF THE BENCH

BeeJay Anya has started the last two games, both NC State wins, for the Wolfpack. Lennard Freeman now comes off the bench, and he has seemed more effective in that role. **In his two games off the bench, the 6-9 Freeman is averaging 7.5 points and 10.5 rebounds.**

PUT LENNARD IN THE GAME

When Lennard Freeman plays and produces, the Wolfpack usually wins. Over the past two seasons, **NC State has a 14-2 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes. In games where the junior grabs eight or more rebounds, NC State is 20-3. The Pack is 11-0 in Freeman's career when he grabs 10 or more rebounds.

TOP GUN

A late addition to the roster this summer was Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Rowan, whose father played college basketball at St. John's and **was a fan of the Top Gun movie**, is averaging 13.6 points per game. Rowan, who won a high school state title in both Pennsylvania and Florida, has scored in double figures in seven of the first nine games of his college career.

GOTTFRIED'S DRIVE FOR FIVE

Head coach Mark Gottfried has a chance to accomplish something only one other coach in ACC basketball history has matched. Gottfried has **led his program to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first four seasons, which has only been accomplished by Skip Prosser (first 4 years) and Roy Williams (first 6 years).** NC State is one of just 16 teams in the nation to have played in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments.

SOPHOMORES DELIVERING

With the team's two top scorers from last season gone, and the injury to Terry Henderson, NC State is relying even more on its young players to produce. Here's a breakdown of the increase in production from sophomores Caleb and Cody Martin and Abdul-Malik Abu:

DECEMBER AT NC STATE

NC State owns a **24-8 record in the month of December** under Mark Gottfried. The Pack had at one point won 16 straight December games during 2011, 2012 and 2013. NC State is 42-17 during the 12th month dating back to 2007.

State's 87-79 shootout win over Winthrop featured 37 points from Cat Barber and 38 points from Winthrop's Jimmy Gavin:

Basic Athletic Measurement (BAM) Testing is the official athletic testing organization for the NBA Draft Combine, the Portsmouth Invitational, Adidas Nations and several other athletic events. The testing consists of five tests: **Standing Vertical Jump; Approach Vertical Jump; 3/4 Court Sprint; Reaction Shuttle; 4-Way Agility Drill.**

PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is **ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout.** Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

COME TO STATE, STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, **only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.**

THANK YOU #WPN

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, **the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase**, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the **Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.** Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

NATIONALLY-RANKED AT THE FINISH

After wins over LSU and Villanova landed the Wolfpack in the Sweet 16, NC State was listed in the season's final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Pack was ranked No. 24 in the final poll. It was the first time finishing the season ranked since the team's Sweet 16 run in 2012, which landed the Pack at No. 20 in the final ranking.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physically to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was **Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'.** Martin was **lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness.** That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 15.2 points per game and is fourth in the ACC in minutes played (36.2).

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.




