THE STARTING 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game

1. THE CENTURY 'MARK'

Mark Gottfried has now won 99 games in his first 154 contests at NC State. A win Saturday at Missouri would make him **the second-fastest Wolfpack coach to 100 wins in school history**. The legendary Everett Case reached 100 wins at NC State in just 120 games. Jim Valvano reached the mark in 156 games, meaning one win in either of the next two games would tie Gottfried with Valvano for the school's second-fastest to 100 Wolfpack victories.

2. BIG SHOT BY BIG CAT

Cat Barber, known to his mother back in Virginia as Big Cat, **made a big shot in NC State's 76-73 win over High Point** on Wednesday night. With the game tied at 73, with 13.3 seconds remaining, NC State came out of a timeout and went to Barber. He drove left, briefly collided with teammate Caleb Martin, regained composure and created space against his defender. His fallaway 3-pointer from the left wing fell through the net as time expired and gave NC State a win over the Big South Conference's preseason favorite. The game-winning trey was his third of the game and was the No. 2 play on Thursday's ESPN Sportscenter.

3. DELAYED RETURN GAME

Saturday's contest in Columbia is the second half of a home-and-home series between the Wolfpack and the Tigers. Missouri, ranked 25th at the time, came to PNC Arena two years ago and edged the Pack 68-64. The two teams planned on playing last December but a date could not be found that was agreeable to both schools, which then delayed the Pack's return game to this season.

4. PACK'S POST PRODUCTION

NC State has been led by perimeter players Cat Barber, Caleb Martin and Maverick Rowan, but increased production from State's post players could be the key to the Pack's success. Lennard Freeman, BeeJay Anya and Abdul-Malik Abu have each had their best moments over the last three games. In the Bucknell win, Freeman recorded a double-double (10 points,13 rebounds). Against South Florida, Abu had a double-double that featured a career-best 14 rebounds and dunked four times. He then totaled 13 points and nine rebounds against High Point. Anya had perhaps his finest outing as a Wolfpacker at USF, totaling a career-high 17 points on 7-for-8 shooting with seven rebounds and five blocks.

5. SUCCESS AGAINST HIS OLD LEAGUE

Mark Gottfried coached 341 games at SEC school Alabama, and he has found success against his old conference during his time at NC State. **The Wolfpack is 4-2 against SEC opponents** since 2011. Gottfried's NC State teams own a pair of wins over Tennessee and a pair of wins over LSU, including a win in last year's NCAA Tournament. His SEC losses while at NC State are the 2013 loss to Missouri and a neutral-court loss to Vanderbilt in 2011.

- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).

HENDERSON EXPECTED TO MISS 6-8 WEEKS

Terry Henderson, a redshirt junior from Raleigh who was projected as a starter for NC State this season, is still out after tearing ligaments in his right ankle in the season opener on Nov. 13. He suffered the setback just seven minutes into his Wolfpack career after sitting out the 2014-15 season as a transfer. He averaged 11.7 points per game as a sophomore at West Virginia in 2013-14.

CALEB, MAVERICK FROM LONG RANGE

Caleb Martin, much improved after shooting .305 from 3-point range last year, is currently **third in the ACC in 3-pointers made per game (2.80)**. In the offseason, Martin tweaked his shooting form to keep the ball more to the right and has removed a hitch from his motion. Freshman Maverick Rowan has been the Pack's other long-range threat, **standing seventh in the ACC with 2.30 made treys per game**. Martin has made four 3-pointers in a game four times this season and Rowan has done it three times.

CAT TAKING AIM

In addition to the outside shooting of Caleb Martin and Maverick Rowan, Cat Barber has recently realized he needs to be a threat from the outside. In the last two games, **Barber** is **4-for-10** from long range. He was **0-for-9** in the season's first eight games.

BEEJAY PUTTING THE BALL IN THE BASKET

If BeeJay Anya can make three buckets per game this season, he could put himself in the NC State record book. Mostly finishing near the rim, the 6-9 **Anya is shooting .742 on the season**, which would shatter NCSU's single-season field goal percentage record (Kevin Thompson, .624). Anya is making 2.3 field goals per game and shot .610 from the floor last season.

A ROTATION BUILT FOR POSTSEASON - ALREADY

It's not uncommon for a team to tighten its rotation at the end of the season, as conference and national tournaments approach. NC State, however, has been forced to go with a condensed lineup, playing essentially a seven-player rotation. State's seven main players have played 2,002 of the team's possible 2,025 minutes (98.86%).

CAT 1,000

Cat Barber, playing in his 82nd game as a Wolfpacker, has 942 career points. He is 58 points away from becoming the 49th player to score 1,000 points in an NC State uniform. Barber is averaging 11.6 points per game for his career.

BALLIN' AGAINST BUCKNELL

The Wolfpack reached rare heights on the offensive end of the floor in the 99-86 victory over Bucknell. The Wolfpack's 99-point output was the team's most under Gottfried and the highest point total in a game since the Pack beat ECU 100-66 in 2004. State also shot a season-high .544 from the floor.

ROLLIN' ON 20s

Maverick Rowan scored a career-high 27 points against Bucknell, with Cat Barber getting 24 and Caleb Martin adding 21. It was the **first time three Wolfpackers scored 20 points in the same game since Nov. 28, 1990** when Chris Corchiani (36 points), Rodney Monroe (25) and Bryant Feggins (23) did so in a 135-88 win over Charleston Southern.

BEE-JAY AN-YA!

BeeJay Anya, the current ACC leader with 3.10 blocks per game, stands second on NC State's all-time career blocks list. He enters Wednesday with 168 career blocked shots, 38 short of the school record held by Thurl Bailey (1979-83). He swatted 91 shots last season, which was the second-highest total in NC State history. He is also the ACC's active leader in blocked shots, three ahead of Clemson's Landry Nnoko.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya is one of the largest players in college basketball. He's actually trimmed down considerably, having **lost nearly 80 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Ddiaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

LENNARD'S THE MAN OF STEEL

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, is rounding into form after missing several months of the offseason healing a fracture in his lower right leg. He had successful surgery in May, and now has a 14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg to heal a fracture. Freeman grabbed 5.6 boards per game last season and had a double-double in State's NCAA Tournament win over Villanova

LENNARD OFF THE BENCH

BeeJay Anya has started the last two games, both NC State wins, for the Wolfpack. Lennard Freeman now comes off the bench, and he has seemed more effective in that role. In his three games off the bench, the 6-9 Freeman is averaging 6.3 points and 8.7 rebounds.

LENNARD MAKES THE PACK GO

When Lennard Freeman plays and produces, the Wolfpack usually wins. Over the past two seasons, **NC State has a 14-2 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes. In games where the junior grabs eight or more rebounds, NC State is 20-3. The Pack is 11-0 in Freeman's career when he grabs 10 or more rebounds.

TOP GUN

A late addition to the roster this summer was Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Rowan, whose father played college basketball at St. John's and was a fan of the Top Gun movie, is averaging 14.1 points per game. Rowan, who won a high school state title in both Pennsylvania and Florida, has scored in double figures in eight of the first 10 games of his college career.

GOTTFRIED'S DRIVE FOR FIVE

Head coach Mark Gottfried has a chance to accomplish something only one other coach in ACC basketball history has matched. Gottfried has led his program to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first four seasons, which has only been accomplished by Skip Prosser (first 4 years) and Roy Williams (first 6 years). NC State is one of just 16 teams in the nation to have played in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments.

SOPHOMORES DELIVERING

With the team's two top scorers from last season gone, and the injury to Terry Henderson, NC State is relying even more on its young players to produce. Here's a breakdown of the increase in production from sophomores Caleb and Cody Martin and Abdul-Malik Abu:

The testing consists of five tests: Standing Vertical Jump; Approach Vertical Jump; 3/4 Court Sprint; Reaction Shuttle; 4-Way Agility Drill.

PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout. Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

COME TO STATE, STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.

THANK YOU #WPN

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

NATIONALLY-RANKED AT THE FINISH

After wins over LSU and Villanova landed the Wolfpack in the Sweet 16, NC State was listed in the season's final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Pack was ranked No. 24 in the final poll. It was the first time finishing the season ranked since the team's Sweet 16 run in 2012, which landed the Pack at No. 20 in the final ranking.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physcially to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'. Martin was lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness. That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 15.2 points per game and is fourth in the ACC in minutes played (36.2).

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.


