THE STARTING 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game

1. REACHING THE CENTURY 'MARK'

NC State's victory at Missouri was win No. 100 at NC State for Mark Gottfried. The coach reached the mark in 155 games, making him **the second-fastest Wolfpack coach to 100 wins in school history**. The legendary Everett Case reached 100 wins at NC State in just 120 games. Jim Valvano reached the mark in 156 games, meaning Gottfried reached 100 wins one game faster than Valvano.

2. BIG CAT IS BIG TIME

There aren't many players in college basketball performing at a higher level than Cat Barber right now. The 6-2 junior is currently leading the ACC in scoring (22.2 ppg) and is second in the league in assists (5.6 apg). The blazing-fast Barber has driven to the rim enough to rank second in the country in both free throws made (100) and attempted (116). He's also grabbing 5.5 rebounds per game while playing a league-high 38.1 minutes per game. Barber, a second team preseason All-ACC pick, scored 33 points in the win at Missouri on Saturday and also boasts a 37-point effort against Winthrop earlier this season. Barber scored 26 points and hit a game-winning 3-pointer at the buzzer against High Point last week. For his efforts, Barber was voted ACC Co-Player of the week, sharing the honor with Brice Johnson of UNC Chapel Hill.

3. SUCCESS AGAINST NON-CONFERENCE IN-STATE OPPONENTS

Since Mark Gottfried's arrival in 2011, NC State has dominated against non-conference opponents from the state of North Carolina. The Wolfpack is 11-1 against in-state non-ACC teams under Gottfried, including two wins over UNC Greensboro. The Pack beat UNCG 89-68 on New Year's Eve in 2012 and then won 68-63 at Greensboro Coliseum in 2013. The lone loss was a 2013 overtime game against NC Central, a game in which the visiting team set a team arena record for free throws made (41).

4. NEED MORE FROM ABU, WE GOT MORE FROM ABU

After a mini-slump that saw him score just two points against Winthrop and Michigan, Mark Gottfried publicly said the team needed more from Abdul-Malik Abu. The 6-8 sophomore has risen to the challenge, flirting with double-doubles in each of the last four games. Abu, NC State's leading rebounder, had a double-double against USF (11 points, 14 rebounds) and Missouri (13 points, 11 rebounds) while also scoring double figures against Bucknell and High Point. Abu is averaging 12.0 points and 10.8 rebounds over the last four games.

5. NOBODY IN ACC HAS WON MORE AWAY FROM HOME

NC State already owns a pair of road wins, having cliamed victory at South Florida and Missouri. The Wolfpack is one of just two teams in the ACC to already have two road wins. Wake Forest is the other team, with wins at Bucknell and Rutgers. NC State owns seven road wins dating back to last season and has won three straight road games.

Won more games in his first 2 seasons with the Pack (48) than any coach in school history except Everett

- Case (55) in 1947 and 1948.
- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Voted 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.
- His 2003-04 Alabama squad advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, the longest tourney run in school history.

3 Seasons at Murray State (68-24 overall)

- Won an OVC title in each of his 3 seasons and was OVC Coach of the Year all 3 seasons.
- Led Murray State to 3 postseason appearances, including a pair of NCAA tourney berths.

YOU CAN'T HURT CODY

Cody Martin shook a sprained ankle suffered against High Point to play 21 quality minutes in NC State's win at Missouri. Earlier this season, Martin missed some practice time in before the Brooklyn trip due to illness. He recovered in time to average 12.0 points per game in the two games in the Barclays Center.

CAT IS THE TOP SCORER

In addition to last Saturday's 33-point effort, Cat Barber scored a career-high 37 points in NC State's win over Winthrop last month. Those two performances are the ACC's highest scoring games of the season. Barber currently leads the ACC with 22.2 points per game.

CAT 1,000

Cat Barber, playing in his 83rd game as a Wolfpacker, has 975 career points. He is 25 points away from becoming the 49th player to score 1,000 points in an NC State uniform. Barber is averaging 11.7 points per game for his career.

CALEB, MAVERICK FROM LONG RANGE

Caleb Martin, much improved after shooting .305 from 3-point range last year, is currently **fifth in the ACC in 3-pointers made per game (2.64)**. In the offseason, Martin tweaked his shooting form to keep the ball more to the right and has removed a hitch from his motion. Freshman Maverick Rowan has been the Pack's other long-range threat, **standing eighth in the ACC with 2.27 made treys per game**. Martin has made four 3-pointers in a game four times this season and Rowan has done it three times.

CAT TAKING AIM

In addition to the outside shooting of Caleb Martin and Maverick Rowan, Cat Barber has recently realized he needs to be a threat from the outside. In the last three games, **Barber is 6-for-14 from long range. He was 0-for-9 in the season's first eight games.**

BOARD WORK

The Wolfpack has out-rebounded seven straight opponents and have been +10 or better in rebounding margin in each of the last four games. NC State was +19 on the glass against Bucknell and +12 against Missouri.

BEEJAY PUTTING THE BALL IN THE BASKET

If BeeJay Anya can make three buckets per game this season, he could put himself in the NC State record book. Mostly finishing near the rim, the 6-9 **Anya is shooting .727 on the season**, which would shatter NCSU's single-season field goal percentage record (Kevin Thompson, .624). Anya is making 2.2 field goals per game and shot .610 from the floor last season.

A ROTATION BUILT FOR POSTSEASON - ALREADY

It's not uncommon for a team to tighten its rotation at the end of the season, as conference and national tournaments approach. NC State, however, has been forced to go with a condensed lineup, playing essentially a seven-player rotation. State's seven main players have played 2,202 of the team's possible 2,225 minutes (98.96%).

ROLLIN' ON 20s

Maverick Rowan scored a career-high 27 points against Bucknell, with Cat Barber getting 24 and Caleb Martin adding 21. It was the **first time three Wolfpackers scored 20 points in the same game since Nov. 28, 1990** when Chris Corchiani (36 points), Rodney Monroe (25) and Bryant Feggins (23) did so in a 135-88 win over Charleston Southern.

BEEJAY REJECTING OPPONENTS

BeeJay Anya, the current ACC leader with 2.91 blocks per game, stands second on NC State's all-time career blocks list. He enters Wednesday with 169 career blocked shots, 37 short of the school record held by Thurl Bailey (1979-83). He swatted 91 shots last season, which was the second-highest total in NC State history. He is also the ACC's active leader in blocked shots, three ahead of Clemson's Landry Nnoko.

LENNARD OFF THE BENCH

BeeJay Anya has started the last two games, both NC State wins, for the Wolfpack. Lennard Freeman now comes off the bench, and he has seemed more effective in that role. In his three games off the bench, the 6-9 Freeman is averaging 6.3 points and 8.7 rebounds.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya is one of the largest players in college basketball. He's actually trimmed down considerably, having **lost nearly 80 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Ddiaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

LENNARD'S THE MAN OF STEEL

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, is rounding into form after missing several months of the offseason healing a fracture in his lower right leg. He had successful surgery in May, and now has a 14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg to heal a fracture.

LENNARD MAKES THE PACK GO

When Lennard Freeman plays and produces, the Wolfpack usually wins. Over the past two seasons, **NC State has a 15-2 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes. In games where the junior grabs eight or more rebounds, NC State is 20-3. The Pack is 11-0 in Freeman's career when he grabs 10 or more rebounds.

TOP GUN

A late addition to the roster this summer was Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Rowan, whose father played college basketball at St. John's and was a fan of the Top Gun movie, is averaging 13.9 points per game. Rowan, who won a high school state title in both Pennsylvania and Florida, has scored in double figures in nine of the first 11 games of his college career.

GOTTFRIED'S DRIVE FOR FIVE

Head coach Mark Gottfried has a chance to accomplish something only one other coach in ACC basketball history has matched. Gottfried has led his program to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first four seasons, which has only been accomplished by Skip Prosser (first 4 years) and Roy Williams (first 6 years). NC State is one of just 16 teams in the nation to have played in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments.

SOPHOMORES DELIVERING

With the team's two top scorers from last season gone, and the injury to Terry Henderson, NC State is relying even more on its young players to produce. Here's a breakdown of the increase in production from sophomores Caleb and Cody Martin and Abdul-Malik Abu:

PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout. Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

COME TO STATE, STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.

THANK YOU #WPN

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

NATIONALLY-RANKED AT THE FINISH

After wins over LSU and Villanova landed the Wolfpack in the Sweet 16, NC State was listed in the season's final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Pack was ranked No. 24 in the final poll. It was the first time finishing the season ranked since the team's Sweet 16 run in 2012, which landed the Pack at No. 20 in the final ranking.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physcially to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'. Martin was lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness. That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 15.2 points per game and is fourth in the ACC in minutes played (36.2).

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.


