- Be the 833rd win in program history (832-438)
- Be the 615th win (614-198) of head coach Wes Moore's career

**SERIES HISTORY**

- Thursday's game marks the 17th meeting between NC State and Virginia Tech. The Wolfpack holds a commanding 15-1 advantage in the series.
- Virginia Tech won the last meeting between the teams, defeating NC State 57-56 in the first round of the 2015 ACC Tournament on a buzzer-beater.
- NC State is 7-0 in all games played at Virginia Tech.
- Five in total and two of the last three meetings between the teams have been decided by one point.
- In NC State's last trip to Blacksburg, the Wolfpack won 72-71 in overtime on a Len'Nique Brown-Hoskin buzzer-beater.

**NOTING THE WOLFPACK**

- The Wolfpack owns the No. 60 RPI as of January 19.
- RPI records: vs. RPI 1-50 (2-4), vs. RPI 51-100 (1-2), vs. RPI 101-200 (7-0), vs. RPI 201+ (3-0).
- Junior guards Miah Spencer and Dominique Wilson each recently scored 10+ points for the 50th time in their careers. They are now approaching 1,000 career points, with Spencer at 975 and Wilson at 970.
- Spencer ranks first in the ACC and 25th in the NCAA with 98 total assists.
- Wilson ranks 6th in the ACC with 15.5 points per game and has scored 20+ points five times this season.
- The Wolfpack ranks 5th in the NCAA with 295 FTs made, 13th in the NCAA with 148 3FGs made, and 14th in the NCAA with 798 total rebounds.

**SCOUTING THE HOKIES**

- Virginia Tech enters Thursday's game the owner of a 14-3 record which includes a 2-2 mark in ACC play. The Hokies are receiving seven votes in the January 19 USA Today Coaches Poll.
- RPI records: vs. RPI 1-50 (1-2), vs. RPI 51-100 (1-0), vs. RPI 101-200 (3-1), vs. RPI 201+ (9-0).
- Virginia Tech's top win this season came at No. 8 Tennessee on December 6, 57-43.
- In the Hokies' two ACC wins (Boston College and Clemson), they have won by an average margin of 27.5 points.
- The Hokies boast the No. 1 field goal percent defense in the nation and are holding opponents to 47.0 points per game.

**IF THE SEASON ENDED TODAY...**

NC State would sit sixth in the ACC standings and earn a bye to the second round of the ACC Tournament on Thursday, March 3. In this game, the Wolfpack would play the winner of Georgia Tech and Wake Forest.

**THE EVOLUTION OF MATHURIN**

Year by year, junior forward Jennifer Mathurin has improved significantly. In addition to the impressive improvements below, she has hit three 3FGs five times this season.

# WOLFPACK WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

## The Last Time - NC State vs. Virginia Tech

March 4, 2015

**GREENSBORO, N.C.** - The NC State women's basketball team (16-14) dropped a heartbreaking decision to the Virginia Tech Hokies in the first round of the 2015 ACC Tournament Wednesday afternoon, falling by a final score of 57-56. A Miah Spencer three-point play gave State a 56-55 lead with 15 seconds remaining, but a corner jumper from Hannah Young with 0.5 seconds on the clock resulted in the Virginia Tech victory.

A very back-and-forth contest, Wednesday's game featured 11 ties and 11 lead changes. State led the game for 23:47 and trailed for just 5:46. NC State shot 17-42 (.405) from the field and 4-11 (.364) from long range, while Virginia Tech (11-19) operated at a 19-43 (.442) clip and went 7-21 (.333) from three-point distance.

Sophomore captain Spencer tied for a game high with 19 points on 5-9 shooting and an 8-10 success rate from the free throw line. Teammate Jennifer Mathurin scored nine points on 3-6 shooting and grabbed eight rebounds.

## PACK FACTS

### 50 TIMES

Junior guards Miah Spencer and Dominique Wilson recently surpassed impressive career scoring milestones. Spencer scored 10+ points in a single game for the 50th time on January 10 at Pittsburgh while Wilson matched this feat one game later at No. 22 Duke.

### REBOUND DOMINANCE

Jennifer Mathurin pulled down a career-high 17 rebounds in the 30T win at Pittsburgh on January 10. In doing so, she became the first Wolfpack player to record 15+ rebounds since Kody Burke grabbed 16 in an ACC Tournament win over Syracuse on March 6, 2014. In the game at Pittsburgh, Mathurin's defensive rebounding total (9) alone was higher than the combined rebounding totals of 17 of 19 players.

### PASSES ALL AROUND

Junior guard Miah Spencer has dished out 93 assists this season (5.2 per game). In nine games, she has recorded six or more. Should she keep up this pace, Spencer would end the season with the highest number of assists per game since Krisy Ziuzki dished out 5.3 per game in 1992-93.

### RACE TO 50

NC State head coach Wes Moore is 56-28 in the midst of his third season at NC State. With the December 6 win over Charlotte, he ranks fourth among active ACC coaches for the fewest games required (75) to earn 50 wins at their current school. Only Jeff Walz (Louisville - 63 games), Joanne McCallie (Duke - 64), and Muffet McGraw (Notre Dame - 74) have achieved this feat quicker than Moore.

### LAYING IT ALL ON THE LINE

NC State players have taken 41 charges through the first 18 games of the 2015-16 season. Jennifer Mathurin leads the team with 20, while Ashley Williams (10), Spencer (6), Carlee Schuhmacher (3), and Wilson (2) have taken the others.

### EMPTY THE BENCH

All 15 available players took the court in NC State's 86-55 win over Western Carolina on December 16 and 12 scored at least two points. The Wolfpack scored a season-high 34 points in a single quarter and a season-high 57 points in a single half during the victory.

### WHAT A GREAT WEEK

Mathurin had a terrific opening week for the Wolfpack Women. The junior forward averaged 16.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in

wins over Villanova and High Point, teams which each achieved at least 20 wins during the 2014-15 season.

### STRONG EFFORT FROM DISTANCE

NC State shot .450 (9-20) from three-point range in the win over Villanova. Ashley Williams, in her first career start, led the team with a 4-6 success rate from beyond the arc.

### ALL MADE CONTRIBUTIONS

Though only eight Wolfpack players took the court in the win over Villanova, each and every one recorded at least one point and one rebound throughout the game.

### WOLFPACK QUICK FACTS (PRESEASON)

During the 2015 Postseason WNIT, NC State head coach Wes Moore (601-192) became one of the fastest head coaches in NCAA Division I history to earn 600 wins in 800 or fewer games (791). The 2015-16 season will be Moore's 27th as a head coach, during which he will be seeking his 26th winning season, his 23rd postseason appearance, and his 22nd season of 20+ wins.

NC State will debut a large class of six freshmen during the 2015-16 season. The incoming Wolfpack class was ranked No. 16 in the nation by ESPNW and features five McDonald's High School All-American nominees.

Due to the ongoing \$35 million Reynolds Coliseum renovation and Walk of Fame and History project, the Wolfpack will play two home games at PNC Arena and the remaining 14 at Broughton High School's Holliday Gymnasium. This will be the first time in program history when NC State has played a season away from Reynolds Coliseum.

The Wolfpack roster features 16 student-athletes this season, making it the largest team since the 2003-04 squad featured the same number of players.

NC State's 2015-16 schedule features 17 teams which qualified for the 2015 NCAA Tournament or Postseason WNIT.

The 11th annual Hoops 4 Hope game will be played at Broughton High School on Sunday, Feb. 14 against Syracuse. Tipoff between the Wolfpack and Orange is set for 2 p.m.

### PLAY 4KAY WEEK

In addition to NC State's annual Hoops 4 Hope game, the Wolfpack will be featured as a part of ESPN's Play 4Kay Week on Feb. 21 at UNC-Chapel Hill. This game between the

One of the top head coaches in NCAA women's basketball, Wes Moore will begin his third season as the head coach of NC State with the start of the 2015-16 season.

In his first season at the helm of the NC State women's basketball program (2013-14), Moore led the Wolfpack to the following accomplishments:

A 25-8 record

A top 25 RPI

11 straight weeks in the AP and USA Today polls

A first AP top-10 ranking since 2001

Four wins over AP top-20 teams

Ten wins over top-100 RPI teams

A 13-2 nonconference record

A 14-2 record at home

His second season (2014-15) at the helm of the Wolfpack was also impressive, as his team struggled through the significant adversity of having five student-athletes miss a combined 81 games throughout the season as a result of multiple injuries and an NCAA ruling on freshman Bosnian center Sara Boric to still finish with an 18-15 record which ended in the Sweet 16 of the 2015 WNIT.

In a WNIT first-round win at East Tennessee State on March 19 of his second season at NC State, Moore earned the 600th win of his career. In so doing, he became one of the fastest coaches in NCAA history to earn 600 wins in 800 or fewer games (791).

NC State Director of Athletics Deborah A. Yow announced on April 5, 2013 that Wes Moore had been hired as NC State's new head women's basketball coach.

Moore spent 15 seasons (1988-2013) as the head coach at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga (UTC) where he led the Lady Mocs to 12 Southern Conference (SoCon) regular season titles, nine SoCon tournament championships, and nine NCAA Tournament berths, while becoming the winningest coach in UTC and SoCon history. He came to Raleigh as the reigning SoCon Coach of the Year, an award he has earned on six separate occasions.
