THE STARTING 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game**1. PACK vs. DUKE IN RALEIGH**

NC State has great success against Duke at PNC Arena in recent years. The Wolfpack has **beaten the Blue Devils in Raleigh in three of the last four meetings**, including when Duke was ranked No. 2 last season (87-75) and when it was No. 1 in 2013 (84-76). In 2010, NC State won 88-74 over a Duke team that would go on to win the national title. In all, **Duke is 1-4 in PNC Arena dating back to 2010**. This includes a 1-3 mark against NC State and an NCAA Tournament loss to Mercer in 2014.

2. HOME-AND-HOME ONCE AGAIN

NC State and Duke **played each other twice each year in the regular season from the 1923-24 season until 2005-06**. In recent years, due mainly to conference realignment, there have been eight instances in which the two schools were scheduled to play once. Duke is a rotational home-and-home opponent for NC State this season, with the other being Florida State. Saturday's game is **the 242nd edition of the NC State-Duke rivalry**, with NC State owning 99 wins over Duke.

3. THE ACC'S TOP TWO SCORERS

Saturday's game will feature the ACC's top two scoring leaders in Cat Barber and Duke's Grayson Allen. Barber has been one of the most productive guards in college basketball this season. The 6-2 junior leads the conference in scoring (22.3 ppg), minutes per game (38.42) and free throws made (139) while also standing fourth in assists per game (4.84). Allen is second in the ACC with 20.1 points per game. Barber and Allen are the only two players in the conference to boast three outings with 30 or more points this season.

4. BETTER DEFENSIVELY THAN YOU MIGHT THINK

Traditionally, NC State is not known for gaudy defensive numbers, but the Wolfpack has quietly performed quite well defensively. The Wolfpack this season allows 69.9 points per game which is near the middle of the conference and fewer than what Duke allows. NC State allows opponents to shoot just .412 on the year, **ranking fifth in the ACC**. Opponents are shooting just .433 on 2-point attempts this season, **which is second in the ACC and 32nd in the country**. Last Saturday, NC State held UNC Chapel Hill to 67 points, tying the Tar Heels' lowest scoring output of the season. Pittsburgh managed just 61 points against the Wolfpack, its third-lowest scoring total this year.

5. PACK CAN CLEAN UP ON THE GLASS

NC State has established itself as an elite offensive rebounding team, **leading the ACC with 15.74 offensive rebounds per game**. The Wolfpack grabs 39.1 percent of its missed shots, which **ranks 11th in the nation**. Statistically, this area bodes well for NC State as Duke is 14th in the ACC in defensive rebounding percentage (grabbing 66.9% of available defensive rebounds). In the league, only Syracuse has a lower defensive rebounding percentage than Duke. NC State owns 10 games with 16 or more offensive rebounds and pulled in 21 against Virginia Tech and 20 against Florida State. **Those offensive rebounds have translated into 15.3 second-chance points per game** for the Pack.

- Won more games in his first 2 seasons with the Pack (48) than any coach in school history except Everett Case (55) in 1947 and 1948.
- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Voted 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.
- His 2003-04 Alabama squad advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, the longest tourney run in school history.

3 Seasons at Murray State (68-24 overall)

- Won an OVC title in each of his 3 seasons and was OVC Coach of the Year all 3 seasons.
- Led Murray State to 3 postseason appearances, including a pair of NCAA tourney berths.

BATTLE OF SHORT ROSTERS

Fans in the stands on Saturday might not even need a roster card. Duke, like NC State, plays with a short bench. **NC State primarily uses seven players, who combined play 99.1 percent of the team's minutes. Duke's six healthy primary players have played 88.3 percent of this season's minutes.**

WOLFPUKS GAINING EXPERIENCE

The experience gained this season by the young Wolfpack squad could pay dividends for the program's future. According to the popular basketball metrics website KenPom.com, the **Wolfpack stands as the 305th most-experienced team** (or 46th least-experienced) in the country. The team, when minutes played are weighted by each player's eligibility class, averages just 1.27 years of experience. The national average is 1.70 and the average experience of the 15-team ACC is 1.48.

CAT'S CAREER

Cat Barber surpassed the 1,000-point mark in December, reaching the plateau in his 83rd game as a Wolfpacker. Barber now has **1,154 career points**, ranking 41st in NC State history. He needs 13 points to tie Lorenzo Brown for 40th place. Barber is **eighth among active players (and tops among non-seniors)** in the ACC in career scoring.

CAT AT THE FOUL LINE

Cat Barber **leads the ACC and ranks fourth in the nation** with 139 made free throws. Barber has eight games with 8+ made foul shots and ranks fourth in the conference with an .858 free throw percentage.

THEY'RE NOT NO. 1 OR 2 THIS TIME

The visiting team enters PNC Arena ranked 20th in the AP poll and 12th in the coaches poll. Last season, Duke came to PNC Arena unbeaten and ranked No. 2. In 2013, NC State knocked off a top-ranked Duke team. In the five times NC State has hosted Duke dating back to 2008, **Duke has never been ranked worse than No. 7.**

There are exactly two players in college basketball who average at least 22.0 ppg, 4.8 rpg and 4.8 apg: Cat Barber and Andrew Andrews of Washington.

ABUUUUUUUUUU

In the middle of his sophomore season, Abdul-Malik Abu is blossoming into a force. Abu, a 6-8 forward out of Boston, has eight double-doubles in his last 10 games. He scored a career-high 21 points against Florida State and then tied a career best in rebounds (14) at UNC. In ACC play, Abu is grabbing 9.8 boards per game, **ranking fifth in the league.**

LET'S MOVE TO PITTSBURGH

NC State might be ranked No. 1 if PNC Arena moved to Pittsburgh. Mark Gottfried has coached the Pack to a 4-0 mark in the western Pennsylvania city. The Pack has won at Pitt twice and won both of its NCAA Tournament games in Pittsburgh last March.

10 WINS OUTSIDE OF LEAGUE PLAY

NC State won 10 non-ACC games for the fourth time in five years under Mark Gottfried. The Wolfpack won 11 non-conference games in each of the coach's first two seasons and won 10 in 2013-14, his third season. Last season, NC State won nine non-ACC games and a rare early ACC game with Wake Forest last December to reach 10 wins before the calendar turned to 2015.

BEEJAY REJECTING OPPONENTS

BeeJay Anya, the current ACC leader with 2.78 blocks per game, stands second on NC State's all-time career blocks list. He enters Tuesday with 187 career blocked shots, 20 short of the school record held by Thurl Bailey (1979-83):

RIVALS AND NEIGHBORS

It's well known the Research Triangle region owns a rich college basketball history, primarily due to the schools' proximity to each other. PNC Arena and Cameron Indoor Stadium are **located 22.6 miles apart**.

CODY IN FOR CALEB

Cody Martin has started the last two games, in place of his twin brother. Cody totaled 10 points and seven rebounds and was the main defender on UNC's Marcus Paige, who finished the day 1-for-9 shooting. NC State is allowing just 64.0 points per game with Cody in the starting lineup.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya is one of the largest players in college basketball. He's actually trimmed down considerably, having **lost nearly 75 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Ddiaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

LENNARD'S THE MAN OF STEEL

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, is rounding into form after missing several months of the offseason healing a fracture in his lower right leg. He had successful surgery in May, and now has **a 14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg** to heal a fracture.

LENNARD MAKES THE PACK GO

When Lennard Freeman plays and produces, the Wolfpack usually wins. Over the past two seasons, **NC State has a 16-6 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes. In games where the junior grabs eight or more rebounds, NC State is 20-5. The Pack is 11-0 in Freeman's career when he grabs 10 or more rebounds.

TOP GUN

A late addition to the roster this summer was Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Rowan, whose father played college basketball at St. John's and **was a fan of the Top Gun movie**, is second on the team with 13.3 points per game. Rowan, who won a high school state title in both Pennsylvania and Florida, has scored in double figures in 15 of the first 19 games of his college career.

TERRY AND AMILE

One reason why both NC State and Duke are so thin is injury. In the season opener, Terry Henderson went down with an ankle injury and is still recovering. Duke's Amile Jefferson has missed the last 10 games with injury.

WAITING IN THE WINGS

NC State has plenty of help for next year wearing street clothes on the bench. In addition to **injured redshirt junior wing Terry Henderson** (11.7 ppg at West Virginia in 2014), **the Pack has Torin Dorn and Dennis Smith** ready to suit up next fall. Dorn, sitting out after transferring from Charlotte, was the Conference USA Freshman of the Year after scoring 12.0 ppg for the 49ers last year. Smith, from Fayetteville, is the **nation's top-ranked point guard** and No. 4 overall recruit in the 2016 class. He enrolled at NC State for this semester to rehab a torn ACL with NC State's medical staff.

GOTTFRIED'S DRIVE FOR FIVE

Head coach Mark Gottfried can accomplish something only one other coach in ACC basketball history has matched. Gottfried has led his program to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first four seasons, **which has only been accomplished by Skip Prosser (first 4 years) and Roy Williams (first 6 years).**

WINNING LIKE IT'S THE 70s

Not since the NC State glory days of David Thompson has NC State won like it has the last four seasons. The Wolfpack was **92-52 in Gottfried's first four seasons**, which is the program's **highest win total for a four-year span since the Pack won 100 games from 1972-76.**

WOLFPACK FATHERS & SONS

Chris Corchiani, Sr. played for Jim Valvano's Wolfpack squads in the late 1980s and graduated in 1991. He was the first player in NCAA history to record 1,000 career assists and is still NC State's all-time leader in assists and steals. His son, Chris Jr., is a sophomore guard on the Wolfpack team. The Corchiani father-son duo is the fourth father-son combo in NC State basketball history: *(h/t Tim Peeler)*

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, **the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase**, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

Basic Athletic Measurement (BAM) Testing is the official athletic testing organization for the NBA Draft Combine, the Portsmouth Invitational, Adidas Nations and several other athletic events. The testing consists of five tests: **Standing Vertical Jump; Approach Vertical Jump; 3/4 Court Sprint; Reaction Shuttle; 4-Way Agility Drill.**

PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout. Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year. Smith has enrolled at NC State and is with the Pack full-time now.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

COME TO STATE, STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

NATIONALLY-RANKED IN 2014-15

After wins over LSU and Villanova landed the Wolfpack in the Sweet 16, NC State was listed in the season's final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Pack was ranked No. 24 in the final poll. It was the first time finishing the season ranked since the team's Sweet 16 run in 2012, which landed the Pack at No. 20 in the final ranking.

WOLFPACK STAYS 3 STRIPE

Just as this basketball season tipped off, NC State Athletics announced a six-year extension with apparel company Adidas. The contract, which runs to July 2022, with worth \$38.7 million in footwear, apparel and other financial considerations.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physically to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'. Martin was lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness. That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 15.2 points per game and is fourth in the ACC in minutes played (36.2).

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.




