After capturing a resounding win over No. 15/13 Miami, the NC State men's basketball team has a quick turnaround in a road challenge at Florida State. The Seminoles edged the Wolfpack 85-78 in Raleigh on Jan. 13. NC State won 72-63 in Tallahassee last season.

THE STARTING 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game**1. THE BIG CAT**

Cat Barber is having a season that would rank among the all-time great performances in school and ACC history. Barber is leading the ACC in scoring with 23.1 points per game while also leading the conference in free throws made (157) and minutes per game (38.5). He's fourth in both assists (4.6) and free throw percentage (.872). Saturday's 30-point effort vs. Miami was his ACC-best fifth game this season with 30+ points. Should his current averages hold, Barber would become the second player in ACC history to average 23 ppg, 4.6 rpg and 4.6 apg (Kenny Anderson in 1990). Over the last four games, Barber is averaging 29.0 points and 4.5 assists while shooting .506 from the floor, .462 from 3-point range and 32-for-32 at the foul line.

2. ROUND 2 vs. THE SEMINOLES

NC State scored 50 points in the second half and rallied late but Florida State edged the Wolfpack 85-78 back on Jan. 13 at PNC Arena. Maverick Rowan scored 22 points (18 in the second half) and Abdul-Malik Abu added 21 points and 13 rebounds for NC State, which grabbed 20 offensive rebounds against the Seminoles. FSU did manage to contain Cat Barber, as the star point guard scored 16 points on 6-for-14 shooting. FSU was led by Malik Beasley (22 points) and Devon Bookert (18 points).

3. QUALITY OPPONENT EVERY NIGHT

Florida State will be NC State's ninth straight opponent ranked in the top 75 of the ESPN.com Daily RPI. In ACC play, only Virginia Tech (117) didn't reach that ranking. The Wolfpack now owns wins over Miami (17) and Pittsburgh (31) in 11 contests against top 75 RPI teams. The Wolfpack also has a neutral-court win over No. 80 RPI LSU.

4. HEATING UP LATE

NC State shot better than 58 percent during the second half of Saturday's win over Miami, continuing a trend where the Wolfpack thrives after halftime. The Wolfpack averages 40.1 points on .446 shooting during the second halves of games this season, up from 34.0 points on .407 before halftime. NC State shoots .350 from 3-point range and .710 at the foul line in the second half compared to .322 and .668 mark in the first halves of games this season. Additionally, several late flurries have seen the Wolfpack catch fire late in games. For the year, Maverick Rowan is shooting 14-for-28 from 3-point range in the last five minutes of each game. Abdul-Malik Abu shoots 60 percent in the games' final five minutes this season.

5. BEATING TEAMS IN THE NATIONAL POLLS

Mark Gottfried's team owns three victories this season over teams who were ranked nationally at the time of the game, with all coming by double digits. In November, NC State defeated then-No. 22 LSU in the Barclays Center 83-72. Behind 31 point from Cat Barber, NC State went to Pittsburgh and beat a Pitt team ranked 20th in the coaches poll 68-51. Saturday's 85-69 win over No. 15/13 Miami was the third win over a ranked team and the Pack's first such victory at PNC Arena. Gottfried has coached the Wolfpack to 11 victories against teams ranked at the time of the game.

- Won more games in his first 2 seasons with the Pack (48) than any coach in school history except Everett Case (55) in 1947 and 1948.
- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Voted 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.
- His 2003-04 Alabama squad advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, the longest tourney run in school history.

3 Seasons at Murray State (68-24 overall)

- Won an OVC title in each of his 3 seasons and was OVC Coach of the Year all 3 seasons.

TERRY SLOWLY GETTING BACK

Terry Henderson, a transfer from West Virginia who was projected to play a significant role for the Pack this season, has slowly been improving his status after a major ankle injury. Henderson, who scored 11.7 ppg in 2013-14 at WVU, has been able to practice some shooting and agility drills. His timetable for a return is still unknown.

WOLFPUPS GAINING EXPERIENCE

The experience gained this season by the young Wolfpack squad could pay dividends for the program's future. According to the popular basketball metrics website KenPom.com, the **Wolfpack stands as the 305th most-experienced team** (or 46th least-experienced) in the country. The team, when minutes played are weighted by each player's eligibility class, averages just 1.27 years of experience. The national average is 1.70 and the average experience of the 15-team ACC is 1.48.

CAT'S CAREER

Junior guard Cat Barber surpassed the 1,200-point mark last week and now has **1,239 career points**, ranking 36th in NC State history. He needs 11 points to tie Kevin Thompson for 32nd on State's all-time list. Barber is **seventh among active players (and tops among non-seniors)** in the ACC in career scoring. He is also now 11th in school history in career assists.

CAT AT THE FOUL LINE

Cat Barber enters Saturday's game having **made 34 straight free throws**. The junior guard **leads the ACC and ranks fifth in the nation** with 157 made free throws. Barber has 10 games with 8+ made foul shots and ranks fourth in the conference with an .872 free throw percentage.

CAT ROLLIN' ON 20s AND 30s

Cat Barber, the ACC's leading scorer, tops the conference rankings in game with 20+ points and 30+ points. Barber boasts **a league-high 14 outings with 20 or more points** in addition to having an **ACC-best five games with 30+ points**.

PACK SHOWING IMPROVEMENT

Cat Barber, Caleb Martin and Abdul-Malik Abu have three of the higher increases in scoring in the ACC. Barber ranks second with a 11.0-ppg increase from last year while Abu is sixth with an increase of 6.4 points per game. Caleb Martin is up 6.2 points per game, good for eighth in the ACC.

CAT'S SCORING IN STATE HISTORY

Should he maintain his current 23.1 points per game mark, Cat Barber's average **would stand ninth in NC State single-season history**. Rodney Monroe's 23.2 points per game mark in 1989-90 stands eighth. Additionally, Barber could **become the seventh player in NC State history** to lead the ACC in scoring.

BOARDS OFF THE BENCH

Lennard Freeman owns the **ACC's top two rebounding performances off the bench** this season. Freeman came off the bench at Pitt on Jan. 19 to grab 14 rebounds. He also pulled in 13 boards vs. Bucknell in December.

LENNARD'S THE MAN OF STEEL

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, is rounding into form after missing several months of the offseason healing a fracture in his lower right leg. He had successful surgery in May, and now has a **14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg** to heal a fracture.

LENNARD MAKES THE PACK GO

When Lennard Freeman plays and produces, the Wolfpack usually wins. Over the past two seasons, **NC State has a 16-8 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes. In games where the junior grabs eight or more rebounds, NC State is 20-5. The Pack is 11-0 in Freeman's career when he grabs 10 or more rebounds.

CODY IN FOR CALEB

Cody Martin has started the last four games, with his twin brother coming off the bench. Cody totaled 10 points and seven rebounds and was the main defender on UNC's Marcus Paige, who finished the day 1-for-9 shooting. Cody Martin scored 13 points on 6-for-8 shooting vs. Duke.

CODY IN LEAGUE PLAY

Cody Martin is **shooting .578 from the floor in league play** and has increased his scoring and rebounding. He has shot .500 or better in eight of the nine conference games, including a 6-for-8 mark vs. Duke. Additionally, he has made his first two career 3-pointers since ACC play began.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya has **lost nearly 75 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Diaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

BEEJAY REJECTING OPPONENTS

BeeJay Anya, the current ACC leader with 2.55 blocks per game, stands second on NC State's all-time career blocks list. He enters Tuesday with 193 career blocks, 14 short of the school record held by Thurl Bailey (1979-83):

...MORE ON ANYA'S BLOCK PARTY

BeeJay Anya swatted 91 shots last season, which was the second-highest total in NC State history. He is also **the ACC's active leader in blocked shots**, three ahead of Clemson's Landry Nnoko. Anya has 20 career games with four or more blocked shots.

TOP GUN

A late addition to the roster this summer was Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman wing. Rowan, whose father played college basketball at St. John's and **was a fan of the Top Gun movie**, is second on the team with 13.0 points per game. Rowan, who won a high school state title in both Pennsylvania and Florida, has scored in double figures in 17 times this season

NC State has plenty of help for next year wearing street clothes on the bench. In addition to **injured redshirt junior wing Terry Henderson** (11.7 ppg at West Virginia in 2014), the **Pack has Torin Dorn and Dennis Smith** ready to suit up next fall. Dorn, sitting out after transferring from Charlotte, was the Conference USA Freshman of the Year after scoring 12.0 ppg for the 49ers last year. Smith, from Fayetteville, is the **nation's top-ranked point guard** and No. 4 overall recruit in the 2016 class. He enrolled at NC State for this semester to rehab a torn ACL with NC State's medical staff.

Chris Corchiani, Sr. played for Jim Valvano's Wolfpack squads in the late 1980s and graduated in 1991. He was the first player in NCAA history to record 1,000 career assists and is still NC State's all-time leader in assists and steals. His son, Chris Jr., is a sophomore guard on the Wolfpack team. NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, **the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase**, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

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PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is **ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout.** Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year. Smith **has enrolled at NC State** and is with the Pack full-time now.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

COME TO STATE, STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, **only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.**

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the **Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.** Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

NATIONALLY-RANKED IN 2014-15

After wins over LSU and Villanova landed the Wolfpack in the Sweet 16, NC State was listed in the season's final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. The Pack was ranked No. 24 in the final poll. It was the first time finishing the season ranked since the team's Sweet 16 run in 2012, which landed the Pack at No. 20 in the final ranking.

WOLFPACK STAYS 3 STRIPE

Just as this basketball season tipped off, NC State Athletics announced a six-year extension with apparel company Adidas. The contract, which runs to July 2022, with worth \$38.7 million in footwear, apparel and other financial considerations.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physically to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was **Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'.** Martin was **lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness.** That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 15.2 points per game and is fourth in the ACC in minutes played (36.2).

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.



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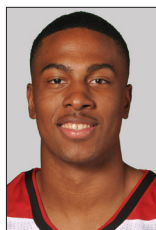
WHAT DO WE NEED TO REPLACE?

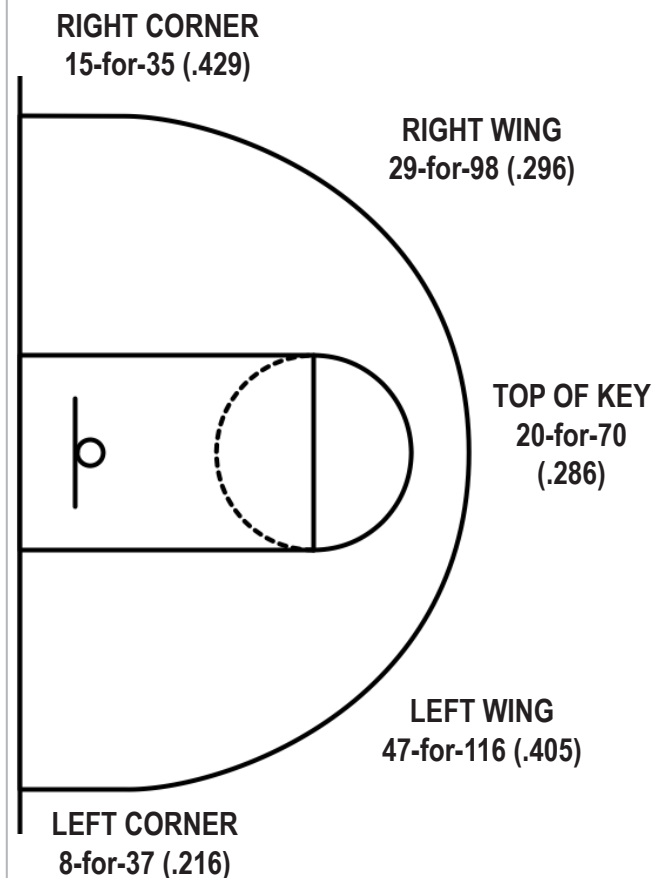

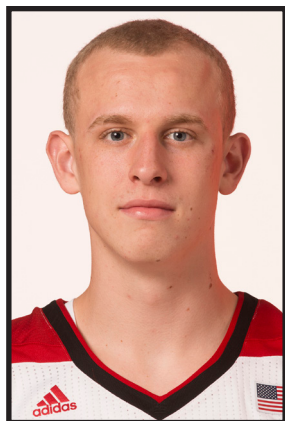
