THE STARTING 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game**1. WOLFPACK HONORING SPECIAL GUESTS**

NC State will be recognizing two notable basketball players from its past, as Al Heartley '71 and Trudi Lacey '80 will be honored during Saturday's game. Heartley was the first African-American basketball player at NC State. Heartley helped NC State with the ACC tourney title in 1970 and in 1971 he was voted by students as the winner of the Alumni Athletics Trophy, which recognized NC State's top athlete. Lacey was recruited to NC State by legendary coach Kay Yow. She coached several years in the WNBA and has her jersey honored by NC State. Lacey was selected to the ACC 50th Anniversary Women's Basketball Team in 2002.

2. HISTORIC SEASON FROM CAT BARBER

Cat Barber isn't merely having a great individual season, he's having one of historical significance. Barber is leading the ACC in scoring with 23.7 points per game and is on pace to become the second player in ACC history to average 23 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 4.5 apg (Kenny Anderson in 1990-91). Barber has a league-best seven games with 30 or more points, including five in ACC play. His 38-point effort last week against Wake Forest was a career high and featured 30 points in the second half. Additionally, he is also leading the conference in free throws made (194) and minutes per game (38.81) and is fourth in free throw percentage (.866) and fourth in assists (4.5).

3. BARBER IN LEAGUE PLAY

After 13 ACC contests, Cat Barber's production has continued to soar. Barber is averaging 24.4 points per game in league play, 3.9 more than the second-best scorer. He's shooting .414 from 3-point range and .892 at the foul line. While playing a league-high 39.2 minutes per game against ACC opponents and facing constant double teams and gimmick defenses, Barber leads the ACC in scoring and free throws made, second in free throw percentage and ninth in assists.

4. WIN NO. 100 OVER CLEMSON

A victory this Saturday over Clemson would be NC State's 100th win all-time against its long-time foe from South Carolina. NC State is 99-50 against Clemson, though the two schools have split the last 10 meetings dating back to 2010. The only school NC State has beaten 100 or more times is Wake Forest (140 wins). The Wolfpack also owns 99 wins all-time over Duke.

5. BEEJAY 200

In the final seconds of NC State's game at Virginia on Monday, BeeJay Anya swatted a shot by UVa's Jarred Reuter out of bounds. The rejection was the 200th of his career, making him the second player in NC State history to reach 200 career blocked shots. The school record for blocked shots is 207, held by Thurl Bailey (1979-83). Anya is currently the ACC leader in blocks per game (2.42), slightly ahead of Clemson's Landry Nnoko (2.35).

- Won 92 games in 4 seasons at NC State, the most at NCSU over a

four-year span since 1972-76.

- One of 4 all-time ACC coaches to lead his team to the ACC Tournament semifinal round in each of his first 3 seasons.
- Won more games in his first 2 seasons with the Pack (48) than any coach in school history except Everett Case (55) in 1947 and 1948.
- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Voted 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.
- His 2003-04 Alabama squad advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, the longest tourney run in school history.

3 Seasons at Murray State (68-24 overall)

- Won an OVC title in each of his 3 seasons and was OVC Coach of the Year all 3 seasons.
- Led Murray State to 3 postseason appearances, including a pair of NCAA tourney berths.
- His 1997-98 team earned the highest NCAA seed in OVC history (#9 seed).

THERE'S ONLY ONE CAT WITH 23.5 / 4.5 / 4.5

Cat Barber is the only player in the nation averaging at least 23.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game. In all of college basketball dating back to 1994, only three other players have reached those averages in a season:

- Charles Jones, Long Island (96-97, 97-98)
- Rodney Stuckey, Eastern Wash. (06-07)
- Billy Baron, Canisius (13-14)

23 PPG / 4.5 RPG / 4.5 APG IN THE ACC

Cat Barber would be the second player in ACC history - joining Georgia Tech great Kenny Anderson - to average 23 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 4.5 apg in a season (assists became official stat in 1984):

CAT'S CAREER

Cat Barber now has **1,348 career points**, lifting him to 26th in NC State history. He needs 11 points to tie C.J. Leslie for 23rd on State's all-time list. Barber is **sixth among active players (and tops among non-seniors)** in the ACC in career scoring. He is also now 10th in school history in career assists.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

NC State tied its season scoring high vs. Wake, tallying 99 points in the win last week. NCSU also scored 99 in December vs. Bucknell. The 99 points was the most in a league game since Jan. 22, 1992 when NC State beat UNC 99-88. Tom Gugliotta scored 36 points in that contest. The two games with 99 points are the highest outputs since the Pack scored 100 against ECU in 2004.

CAT LIVING AT THE FOUL LINE

Wake Forest coach Danny Manning wasn't lying when he called Cat Barber a "tough cover." Barber slashed and darted around the Demon Deacons to the tune of 17-for-20 free throw shooting, including 17-for-18 in the second half. His 20 attempts tied for fourth in school history. Earlier this season, he had a 19-for-22 effort at the foul line against Winthrop. Barber **owns three of the ACC's top four free throw shooting performances** (19-22 vs. Winthrop, 17-20 vs. Wake Forest, 14-14 at Pittsburgh). As a team, the Wolfpack attempted 45 free throws, which is the second-most attempts in a game in the ACC this season (Virginia Tech shot 50 on Nov. 24).

"IN EVERY GAME"

After the game at Cameron Indoor, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski said Cat Barber "gives them a chance to win every game." Despite being 3-10 in league play, the Pack has been competitive almost every night. NC State has four league losses by five or fewer points.

With one more healthy player or a bounce here and there, NC State's season could be much different. Here are some notable halftime scores:

LENNARD'S THE MAN OF STEEL

Lennard Freeman, NC State's leading rebounder, is rounding into form after missing several months of the offseason healing a fracture in his lower right leg. He had successful surgery in May, and now has a **14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg** to heal a fracture.

CODY IN LEAGUE PLAY

Cody Martin is **shooting .570 from the floor in league play** and has increased his scoring and rebounding. He has shot .500 or better in 12 of the 13 conference games, including a 6-for-10 mark at Virginia. Additionally, he has made his first two career 3-pointers since ACC play began.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya has **lost nearly 75 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Ddiaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

THEY SHOULD STILL BE IN HIGH SCHOOL

Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman wing who starts, and reserve Shaun Kirk should both be preparing for their high school prom. Rowan and Kirk both classified up to the 2015 class, and could both be competing in high school ball.

'ROWAN-ISIMO!'

Maverick Rowan, third on NC State in scoring as a freshman, is the son of Ron Rowan, who played in the 1980s for Notre Dame and St. John's and had a long pro career overseas. Maverick's family lived in Italy until Maverick was eight years old.

LENNARD MAKES THE PACK GO

When Lennard Freeman plays and produces, the Wolfpack usually wins. Over the past two seasons, **NC State has an 18-8 record** when Freeman played 24 or more minutes. In games where the junior grabs eight or more rebounds, NC State is 20-5. The Pack is 11-0 in Freeman's career when he grabs 10 or more rebounds.

FOUL SHOOTING RECORDS

Here are some updates on NC State's and Cat Barber's prolific free throw shooting:

- Barber is tied for third in school history (Mel Thompson 53-54) with 194 made FTs. The single-season school record is 224.

- The school record for foul shot attempts in a season is 335. Barber is currently 10th with 224.

- Cat Barber has tied the school record for free throws made by a junior (194).

WINNING LIKE IT'S THE 70s

Not since the NC State glory days of David Thompson has NC State won like it has the last four seasons. The Wolfpack was **92-52 in Gottfried's first four seasons**, which is the program's **highest win total for a four-year span since the Pack won 100 games from 1972-76.**

WOLFPUUPS GAINING EXPERIENCE

The experience gained this season by the young Wolfpack squad could pay dividends for the program's future. According to the popular basketball metrics website KenPom.com, the **Wolfpack stands as the 305th most-experienced team** (or 46th least-experienced) in the country. The team, when minutes played are weighted by each player's eligibility class, averages just 1.27 years of experience. The national average is 1.70 and the average experience of the 15-team ACC is 1.48.

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, **the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase**, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

Basic Athletic Measurement (BAM) Testing is the official athletic testing organization for the NBA Draft Combine, the Portsmouth Invitational, Adidas Nations and several other athletic events. The testing consists of five tests: **Standing Vertical Jump; Approach Vertical Jump; 3/4 Court Sprint; Reaction Shuttle; 4-Way Agility Drill.**

PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout. Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year. Smith has enrolled at NC State and is with the Pack full-time now.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

OUT 3 MONTHS...AND A YEAR

Originally thought to be out for 6-8 weeks, Saturday will mark three months since Terry Henderson injured his ankle during the season opener. Henderson tore a ligament in his ankle seven minutes into the season, meaning he played just seven minutes after sitting out the 2014-15 season.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

WOLFPACK STAYS 3 STRIPE

Just as this basketball season tipped off, NC State Athletics announced a six-year extension with apparel company Adidas. The contract, which runs to July 2022, is worth \$38.7 million in footwear, apparel and other financial considerations.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physically to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'. Martin was lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness. That has translated onto the court for the 6-7 sophomore wing, who is averaging 15.2 points per game and is fourth in the ACC in minutes played (36.2).

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.






