- Clemson is coming off back to back wins for the first time in February, with home triumphs over Georgia Tech and Boston College.
- The Tigers overcame a halftime deficit in the win over the Eagles; it was their fifth win after trailing at the half this season, one shy of the Clemson record for a single season.
- Clemson has a 5-6 record in PNC Arena, which opened in 1999-2000. The Tigers won in Raleigh last season, 68-57.

TIGER TRACKS

- Clemson won its ninth ACC game last time out, marking only the fifth time in program history the Tigers have won nine of their first 14. The other seasons it was achieved was 1966-67, 1986-87, 1989-90 and 2007-08.
- Since the ACC expanded to a 16-game schedule in 1991-92, the Tiger record for league wins through 15 games is nine, set on three occasions.
- Saturday's game features the top two shot-blockers in the ACC in Clemson's Landry Nnoko and NC State's BeeJay Anya. The Wolfpack center has 63 blocks in 26 games, while Nnoko has 61 over the same number of games.
- Avry Holmes is coming off one of his best performances. The junior scored 17 points on 4-8 shooting and 7-8 free throws, but it was defensively where he made his mark. He helped limit Boston College's leading scorer Eli Carter to just 1-17 field goal shooting.
- Jaron Blossomgame scored a game-high 23 points in the win over BC.
- Jordan Roper reached the century mark for assists for the first time in the most recent game. He has just 32 turnovers in 863 minutes this season.

HEAD COACH BRAD BROWNELL

- Named the 21st men's basketball head coach in Clemson history on April 13, 2010.
- Is coaching his 14th season in Division I, having previously coached four years each at UNC Wilmington and Wright State before coming to Clemson.
- Set Clemson records for total wins (22) and ACC wins (9) by a first-year head coach in 2010-11.
- Led Clemson to first NCAA Tournament win in 14 years when the Tigers topped UAB in the first round in 2011.
- Took the Tigers to the 2014 NIT semifinals after his team was predicted to finish near the bottom of the ACC standings (Clemson finished sixth).
- Clemson's 2013-14 defense led the ACC and was eighth nationally in blocks per game (6.1).
- Has taken three different schools to NCAA Tournaments, one of only a few select coaches in the country to accomplish the feat.
- Coached K.J. McDaniels to ACC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2013-14; McDaniels went on to become Brownell's first player drafted into the NBA.
- Named Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2006. He coached CAA Player of the Year Brett Blizzard in 2002-03, his first season as a Division I head coach.
- Took over Wright State in 2006-07 and guided the school to a record 23 wins in his first season and an NCAA Tournament bid.
- Began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Evansville in 1991-92, helping that program to an NCAA berth.
- Served as an assistant coach to Jerry Wainwright at UNC Wilmington from 1994-2002.
- Played Division III ball at DePauw University in Greencastle, Ind.
- He and his wife, Paula, have two daughters, Abby (17) and Kate (15).

LITTLEJOHN UNDERGOING MAJOR RENOVATION

- Clemson Athletics made the decision to pursue a massive rebuild of Littlejohn Coliseum in its existing space.
- The \$63.5 million renovation began with the demolition stages shortly after the May 2015 graduation ceremonies.
- The new and improved Littlejohn is scheduled to open in November 2016 with the season opener against Georgia.
- The renovated Littlejohn will include new seating and concourse areas, as well as brand new operations areas for both the men's and women's programs.

TIGERS MAKE TEMPORARY HOME IN GREENVILLE

- Clemson is playing all 17 regular season home games for 2015-16 at Bon Secours Wellness Arena in Greenville.
- The Tiger program has played some games in the facility, though not since the 2004-05 season when it was still the Bi-Lo Center.
- Clemson first played in the arena in 1998, splitting games against Furman and Illinois.

THE INTERN

- Jordan Roper completed a 400-hour unpaid internship requirement toward his parks, recreation & tourism management degree last summer.
- The senior from Columbia, S.C., worked with Clemson's athletic communications office, focusing on digital and video content.
- Roper's final project for the internship was to film, edit and produce a five-minute feature on himself, focusing on the stroke he suffered following his freshman season at Clemson.

I'M YOUR CAPTAIN

- Jaron Blossomgame and Donte Grantham both attended the inaugural Captains Camp over the summer put on by Athletes in Action.
- The two players attended the camp May 14-17 in Xenia, Ohio, along with 20 leaders from various Division I teams.
- The players took part in classroom sessions, outdoor and experiential learning exercises, skill instruction and open gym competition.
- Featured guests at the camp included CBS basketball analyst Clark Kellogg and former Ohio State point guard Aaron Craft.

GAME NOTES & MISCELLANEOUS STATS

CLEMSON-NC STATE SERIES HISTORY

- Since Brad Brownell took over at Clemson in 2010, the Tigers are 4-4 in the series against NC State.
- The Wolfpack own a lopsided margin in the overall series, 100-60, including a gaudy 47-14 mark against Clemson in Raleigh.
- The Tigers won in Raleigh last season, 68-57, one of three big road wins for the 2014-15 team. It was Clemson's first win in Raleigh since 2010.
- Since Brownell took over, five of the eight games in the series have been decided by eight points or less.

WINNING IN THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA

- Clemson's Jan. 28, 2015 win over NC State was only the program's 18th win over a team in the Research Triangle (Duke, North Carolina, NC State).
- Fourteen of the Research Triangle wins have come over the Wolfpack.
- PNC Arena has been one of the most successful venues for the Tigers in recent years. Clemson is 5-6 all-time in the Wolfpack's home since 1999-2000.
- Last season's win over NC State was only the fifth double-digit win on Tobacco Road in 180 games.

NC STATE UPDATE

- The Wolfpack enter Saturday's contest with a 13-13 record, including a 3-10 ACC mark. NC State last played on Monday, a 73-53 loss at Virginia.
- NC State's biggest ACC win was against Miami on January 30, an 85-69 triumph for the Wolfpack on their home floor.
- The 'Pack have been led all season by guard Anthony "Cat" Barber, the ACC's leading scorer at 23.7 points per game. He also leads NC State with 117 assists and is one of the national leaders in free throws made (194).

VETERANS VS. NC STATE

- *Jaron Blossomgame (*Jr.)* — Averaging 6.7 points and 9.3 rebounds per game in three appearances.
- *Gabe DeVoe (So.)* — Appeared in one game in 2015, scoring 18 points in just six minutes at home.
- *Sidy Djitte (Jr.)* — Averaging 1.7 points and 2.7 rebounds per game in

three appearances.

- *Donte Grantham (So.)* — Averaging 10.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game in two appearances.
- *Landry Nnoko (Sr.)* — Averaging 4.6 points and 2.8 rebounds per game in five appearances; has added seven blocked shots in those games.
- *Jordan Roper (Sr.)* — Averaging 7.8 points per game in five appearances; posted 18 points in road win at NC State last season.
- *Josh Smith (Sr.)* — Averaging 2.0 points and 1.0 rebounds per game in three appearances.

LAST TIME OUT

- Clemson followed a similar formula that helped it win against Georgia Tech in the previous game, as the Tiger defense stiffened late to propel them to a 65-54 win over Boston College on February 17.
- The Tigers shot 52 percent after halftime, while limiting Eagles star guard Eli Carter to just 1-17 shooting.
- Jaron Blossomgame and Avry Holmes combined to score 40 points.

NINE ACC WINS OVER FIRST 14 GAMES

- This year's team joined exclusive company in Clemson lore by winning nine of its first 14 ACC games.
- It is only the fifth time in program history that a Tiger team has achieved nine wins in its first 14 ACC games. The other teams to do it were in 1966-67, 1986-87, 1989-90 and 2007-08.
- No Clemson team has won 10 of its first 15 ACC games in history.

ACC WIN TOTAL HIGHER THAN NON-CONFERENCE

- For only the fifth time in 63 seasons as a member of the ACC, Clemson will finish the regular season with more wins in conference play than out of conference.
- Clemson won its eighth ACC

11 STRAIGHT HOME WINS OVER GEORGIA TECH

• Clemson stretched its home winning streak to 11 consecutive over Georgia Tech, a stretch that began on Senior Day in 2006, with a 66-52 win on February 13.

• The 11-game home winning streak is the longest in Clemson history over another ACC opponent. The second-longest stretch was eight wins in a row versus Virginia from 1959-66.

CLEMSON HAS WON 12 OF LAST 13 VS. GEORGIA TECH

• The Tigers' 66-52 win over Georgia Tech on February 13 gave the program 12 wins in its last 13 games versus the Yellow Jackets.

• That is the best stretch of any kind against an ACC opponent for the Clemson program since 1959-60 through 1965-66, when the Tigers beat Virginia in 12 out of 13 meetings.

TIGERS NAB RARE WIN IN WINSTON-SALEM

• Lawrence Joel Coliseum has proven to be a difficult place for the Tigers to win over the years, but Clemson has recently found success in Winston-Salem, N.C.

• Clemson won the first season the facility opened in 1989-90, but did not win again until Brad Brownell's second team won 78-58 on Feb. 11, 2012. That ended a drought of 18 consecutive losses from 1991-2010.

• Clemson won for a second time in the last five years on February 2, 76-62.

56 POINTS IN A HALF

• Clemson put together its best offensive half of play in some time on February 2 in Winston-Salem, N.C. The Tigers scored 56 after intermission in their 14-point win at Wake Forest.

• The 56 points were the most by any Clemson team in a half since Feb. 17, 2009, when Trevor Booker led the Tigers to a 59-point second half at home in a win over Maryland.

• Prior to the second half against Wake, Clemson's high mark in 184 games under coach Brad Brownell was 53 in the second half of a 2011 win over Georgia Tech, when his first team went 9-9 from three-point range.

• Last ACC season, the Tigers failed to score 56 in six different GAMES.

TIGERS WERE 6-3 IN FIRST HALF OF LEAGUE PLAY

• Clemson's 66.7 percent winning mark tied for third-best in program history over the first half of ACC play.

• The top mark in school history was in 1996-97, when Clemson was 6-2 (.750) at the midpoint of conference games.

• Brad Brownell now owns two of the top seven records over the first half of ACC games, as his 2013-14 team was also 6-3 after nine games.

• The school record for ACC wins in a season is 10, shared by the 1986-87, 1989-90, 2007-08 and 2013-14 teams.

TIGERS BEAT FOUR RANKED TEAMS IN JANUARY

• The January 27 game versus Pittsburgh was Clemson's fifth straight against a team ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll.

• Clemson went 4-1 through the stretch. It marked the first time in Clemson history the Tigers beat four ranked teams in the same month.

• It was the first time the Tigers faced five straight top-25 foes since Feb. 8-24, 1993, when Cliff Ellis' group took on Duke (3), Virginia (24), North Carolina (3), Florida State (9) and Wake Forest (12) in consecutive games.

• The Tigers went 6-2 overall in January, most wins in the month since Rick Barnes' team was 6-2 in 1996-97.

TIGERS BEAT HALL OF FAME COACHES BACK TO BACK

• Clemson coach Brad Brownell has guided the Tigers to wins over Hall of Fame coaches three straight seasons, including 2015-16.

• In 2013-14, his team defeated Duke by a score of 72-59. It was Clemson's first win over the Blue Devils in five seasons.

• In 2014-15, Brownell's Tigers took down Jim Boeheim and the Syracuse Orange in Littlejohn Coliseum, 66-53.

• Louisville coach Rick Pitino and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski were inducted in 2013 and 2001 respectively. Both lost at Clemson in the same week.

• In its history, the Clemson program has 19 wins over coaches who have been inducted into the Hall of Fame. Brownell has five, tied with Bill Foster for most in Clemson history over Hall of Fame coaches.

TIGERS ACHIEVE A FIRST

• Clemson knocked off top-25 opponents in three consecutive games, a first for a program whose inception dates to 1911-12.

• The Tigers are the first ACC team to defeat top-25 AP ranked teams in three consecutive games in the regular season since Wake Forest did it from Feb. 15-22, 2003.

• Clemson has now defeated eight top-25 teams in the Brad Brownell era (2010-present), following a 66-62 win over No. 16 Louisville, 68-63 over No. 6 Duke, 76-65 over No. 8 Miami, and 73-60 over No. 23 Pitt.

• All eight of the wins have come at home, while seven of the eight have come against ACC competition.

WINS OVER DEFENDING NCAA TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

- Clemson earned its seventh win over a defending NCAA Champion on January 13 when the Tigers knocked off Duke, 68-63.
- It was the program's first win over a defending national champion since an 83-64 win over North Carolina in 2009-10.
- It first took place in 1974-75 when the Tigers knocked off NC State, 92-70. The Wolfpack had ended UCLA's magical run of seven straight NCAA titles.
- Kentucky has been a victim twice as the defending NCAA Champion. The Tigers downed Rick Pitino's Wildcats in overtime, 79-71, to open the 1996-97 season.

LONGEST ACC WINNING STREAKS

- Clemson posted a five-game winning streak in conference play. During the stretch, the Tigers defeated Florida State, Syracuse, Louisville, Duke and Miami. The streak was snapped at No. 13 Virginia on January 19.
- The accomplishment was one of only six times in 63 ACC seasons that Clemson has compiled a streak of five wins or more. It was the longest streak by the program since the 1996-97 Tigers started 5-0.
- The longest winning streak in program history came in 1966-67, when Bobby Roberts' team won seven in a row — all in February.

- Only six schools have defeated Syracuse in football and men's basketball in the Carrier Dome in the same academic year since the facility first opened in the fall of 1980.
- Clemson became the sixth school to accomplish the "Dome Double" on January 5 with a 74-73 overtime win over the Orange. Dabo Swinney's Tiger football team won 37-27 in Syracuse on Nov. 14, 2015.
- The previous schools to complete the football and men's basketball double were Boston College, Miami, Cincinnati, Pittsburgh and Duke.

HISTORY MADE IN SYRACUSE

- Clemson's win on January 5 in the Carrier Dome was just the program's sixth in a conference road overtime game in the Tigers' 63rd season as a member of the ACC.
- The most recent win on an ACC opponent's home court prior to Jan. 5, 2016 took place in 1986-87 in Horace Grant's senior season. Grant made the only three-point goal of his career in that 94-90 victory at Virginia, one of two ACC road wins in overtime for Grant and the Tigers that season.

SPREADING THE WEALTH FROM THREE

- Perhaps the biggest statistical difference in this year's team versus the 2014-15 unit has been the three-point shot. Clemson has 194 makes beyond the arc this season, but had only 171 over 31 games in 2014-15.
- The distribution of makes is even more impressive. Four players have at least 30 three-point goals, the first Clemson team since 2005-06 that can make that claim.
- Donte Grantham, Avry Holmes, Jordan Roper and Jaron Blossomgame have all made at least 30. A fourth player, Gabe DeVoe, needs just four makes to push the number to five.

TIGERS MAKE HISTORY AT THE FREE THROW LINE

- Clemson had never shot 100 percent on free throws in a game, given a minimum of 15 attempts. That is, until Clemson went 15-15 from the stripe in a win over No. 8 Miami on January 16. The performance established a single-game record.
- Clemson made 36 consecutive free throw attempts from the first half of the win over Duke into the second half against Pittsburgh, breaking the school record. The previous mark was 24 in a row against Mercer in 1993.
- The Tigers are second in free throw accuracy in ACC games (.776).

CLEMSON LEADS ACC IN BLOCKS

- For the second time in three seasons, Clemson is No. 1 in the ACC in blocks per game. The Tigers average 5.4 swats per game.
- Clemson led the league in 2013-14 after K.J. McDaniels claimed the individual lead and teammate Landry Nnoko was third in blocks per game.
- Now a senior, Nnoko is second in the ACC in blocks per game, the primary reason the Tigers are again atop the statistic. Louisville (5.1) is second.

BROWNELL EARNS WIN NO. 100 AT CLEMSON

- Brad Brownell won his 100th game as Clemson's coach on January 10 when his Tigers defeated Louisville, 66-62.
- He became the fifth coach to achieve 100 wins at Clemson, joining Joe Davis, Bill Foster, Cliff Ellis and Oliver Purnell.

BROWNELL CLEMSON'S CAREER LEADER VS. THE ACC

- Clemson coach Brad Brownell is the program's leader in career winning percentage versus ACC competition.
- Given a minimum of three years experience, Brownell is 51-56 (.477) all-time as Clemson's coach against ACC schools. The record includes games in the ACC Tournament.
- Brownell's 47 wins were the most through 100 ACC games of any coach in Clemson history. Oliver Purnell was the previous leader with 43.
- Under Brownell, Clemson has posted at least eight ACC wins in five out of six seasons.

BLOSSOMGAME JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Jaron Blossomgame became Clemson's 38th and newest member of the 1,000-point career club.
- He needed 15 points against Georgia Tech on February 13 and scored 17 points. His roommate Jordan Roper needs just 47 to join him on the list.

GAME NOTES

BLOSSOMGAME'S CONSISTENCY

- Jaron Blossomgame leads all Tigers with 12 different 20-point games, despite entering his junior season with only two in his career. He is a big reason the Tigers are averaging 69.4 points per game, up seven points from last year's average.
- Blossomgame's consistency has been a major theme. He leads all Tigers in double figure scoring games (22) and scoring average in ACC play (19.4).
- He has averaged 19.4 points per game in ACC play this season. That figure is on pace to be the fourth-best scoring average in conference play by a Tiger in the last 30 years. Horace Grant's 22.3 clip in 1986-87 is the best.
- The only other players to sport higher averages in ACC games are Will Solomon (21.3) in 1999-00 and Elden Campbell (19.9) in 1989-90.

BLOSSOMGAME SHOOTING CAREER-BEST FROM THREE

- Jaron Blossomgame's biggest statistical jump this season has been from behind the three-point line.
- He entered the season 27-109 over his first two seasons from three, or 24.8 percent overall.
- Through 26 games, Blossomgame leads Clemson with a 41.1 percent clip (30-73). He has three more makes in 36 less attempts than he had entering his junior campaign.
- Blossomgame's career-long 10-game streak with at least one three-pointer ended in the win over Georgia Tech on February 13.

BLOSSOMGAME POSTING McDANIELS-LIKE NUMBERS

- Jaron Blossomgame's junior season has been very similar to that of former Clemson great K.J. McDaniels, who was first-team All-ACC in 2013-14.
- Through the first 26 games, Blossomgame sports a slightly higher scoring average, and holds the edge in field goal and three-point percentage as well.
- It is interesting to note that Blossomgame already has 12 games with at least 20 points this season, just one shy of matching McDaniels' mark.
- McDaniels made 84 percent of his free throws and 154 total, one of the top-five single season marks in school history. But Blossomgame has been more effective from three, converting 41.1 percent.

BLOSSOMGAME POSTED FIVE STRAIGHT 20+ POINTS

- Jaron Blossomgame scored 20 or more points in five straight games for the Tigers from January 16 to February 2. The streak ended February 6 at Virginia Tech.
- He was the first Tiger since Horace Grant in 1986-87 to score at least 20 in five straight ACC games.

BLOSSOMGAME NAISMITH, ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Jaron Blossomgame averaged 21 points and 6.5 rebounds per game in wins over Duke and Miami on his way to earning Naismith Trophy and ACC Player of the Week honors on January 18.
- Blossomgame was the first Tiger to be named ACC Player of the Week since Jordan Roper shared the honor last February.

BLOSSOMGAME POSTS CAREER HIGH 30 POINTS

- Jaron Blossomgame became the first Clemson player to score 30 points in a game since K.J. McDaniels in the 2014 NIT against Georgia State.
- After hitting a career-best 13 field goals (including 2-3 from three) and 2-4 free throws, Blossomgame scored 30 in the loss to Notre Dame on February 8. Coincidentally, it was the most by a Tiger in an ACC game since McDaniels also scored 30 against Notre Dame in a loss in 2014.
- The 30 points and 13 field goals both tied highs in 188 games under head coach Brad Brownell.

ROPER EARNS CLEMSON DEGREE

- Jordan Roper achieved a milestone on December 17 when he earned his undergraduate degree in parks, recreation & tourism management after just three and a half years.
- Roper is the first Tiger to play with a degree already in hand since 2011-12, when both Bryan Narcisse and Tanner Smith earned December degrees that season.

ROPER EARNS ACC POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

- Jordan Roper was named one of three student-athletes from Clemson to earn a Weaver-James-Corrigan postgraduate scholarship from the Atlantic Coast Conference.
- Roper will receive \$5,000 toward his master's degree pursuit in athletic leadership. Roper has expressed interest in a career in athletic administration.
- The other two athletes honored from Clemson were Anna Skochdopole (rowing) and Tristen Dewar (women's tennis).
- He is the first Clemson basketball recipient since Tanner Smith in 2012.

ROPER MAKES SEVEN THREE-POINT GOALS VS. FSU

- Jordan Roper had the top shooting performance of his career in the Tigers' ACC home opener against Florida State.
- He made 7-10 three-point goals in the win on January 2, helping the Tigers to an 84-75 victory over the Seminoles.
- Roper's seven threes matched Andre Young for the most by a Tiger in 187 games under coach Brad Brownell. Young previously did it as a senior in 2011-12 against Georgia Tech.

ROPER POSTS 10 ASSISTS AT SYRACUSE

- Jordan Roper had played 110 games in his Clemson career prior to the January 5 game at Syracuse, but never recorded more than seven assists.
- That changed quickly as the Tigers shot over 50 percent for the game, with Roper contributing a career-high 10 assists. He was two shy of Clemson's ACC road game record of 12 set by Mike Eppley at Duke in 1981-82.
- As a team, Clemson posted 22 assists. It was the most by a Tiger team in an ACC road win since an 82-52 victory at Virginia in 2007-08.

ROPER RATIO AMONG CLEMSON'S BEST

- The improved ball-handling displayed on the perimeter has been a key to success this season, and Jordan Roper's play exemplifies it.
- Roper has 100 assists compared to only 32 turnovers, a 3.12 assist-turnover ratio that ranks fourth-best in the ACC.
- If the season ended today, Roper's ratio would be the best in Clemson history. Grayson Marshall owns the mark with a 2.99 ratio in 1986-87.

ROPER IN ELITE COMPANY

- Jordan Roper is the eighth player in Clemson history with at least 900 points, 125 three-point goals, 200 assists and 100 steals in a career.
- The others that achieved the benchmark in all four statistical categories are Merl Code, Cliff Hammonds, Terrell McIntyre, K.C. Rivers, Shawan Robinson, Will Solomon and Andre Young.
- Roper did it with his steal in the win over Pittsburgh on January 27.

GRANTHAM LEADING CLEMSON FROM THREE

- On the season, sophomore forward Donte Grantham leads the Tigers with 47 three-point goals. Grantham is one of only two players in Clemson history 6-8 or taller (Andrius Jurkunas) to lead the Tigers in three-point goals over a season (he had 41 as a freshman).
- No player 6-8 or taller has led the Tigers in three-point shooting more than once. Grantham leads the team in threes and is trailed closely by Avry Holmes (41) and Jordan Roper (38).

GAME NOTES

NNOKO THE PROTECTOR

- Landry Nnoko has picked up where he left off from 2014-15. He has produced 61 blocked shots through Clemson's 26 games, putting him second in the ACC at 2.4 per game.
- Nnoko was third in the ACC in blocks per game the past two seasons, posting 63 in 2014-15.
- Nnoko has passed a trio of former Tiger shot-blocking greats on the Clemson career chart so far this season in Sharrod Ford, K.J. McDaniels and Jerai Grant.
- He moved into sole possession of sixth in Clemson history by attaining his 200th career block on Feb. 8, 2016 against Notre Dame.
- Nnoko needs nine blocks to pass Dale Davis for fifth all-time.

- Landry Nnoko swatted eight Virginia Tech shots on February 4, his personal high and most by any Tiger in an ACC game since Trevor Booker had eight against North Carolina as a freshman in 2007.
- His block count was the most in any game by a Tiger player since Jerai Grant had eight in a win over East Carolina in 2010-11.
- Nnoko is one of only five players in Clemson history to record at least eight blocks in an ACC game, joining Booker, Tree Rollins, Sharone Wright and Sharrod Ford.
