THE STARTING 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game**1. 'MARCH' GOTTFRIED**

Now is the time of year when, if history is any indication, Mark Gottfried will have the Wolfpack at its best. Under the fifth-year coach, the Wolfpack boasts a 20-11 record during the month of March. That total includes five NCAA Tournament victories and seven ACC Tournament wins. Dating back to 2014, NC State has an 11-5 record in March contests.

2. CAT'S A FIRST TEAMER

After posting a season rarely seen in ACC history, Cat Barber was voted first team All-ACC by both the media and the conference's coaches. The 6-2 junior leads the ACC in scoring with 23.4 points per game (league-best 23.6 ppg in ACC play) and is on pace to become the second player in ACC history to average 23 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 4.0 apg (Kenny Anderson in 1990-91). Barber has a league-best eight games with 30 or more points, including six in ACC play. In NC State's last game against Wake Forest on Feb. 13, Barber exploded for a career-high 38 points. Additionally, he is also leading the conference in free throws made (226) and minutes per game (38.68) and is third in free throw percentage (.866) and seventh in assists (4.37).

3. IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT

NC State owns a 70-52 all-time record in the ACC Tournament, including an 8-4 mark in the tourney against Wake Forest. Mark Gottfried is 7-4 in the ACC Tournament as head coach at NC State and owns a career record of 21-15 in conference tournament play (OVC, SEC, ACC). The Pack has won two tournament games in three of Gottfried's four seasons.

4. THE WOLFPACK'S PATH INTO THE DANCE

In order to claim the ACC's automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament, the Wolfpack will have to win five games in five days. NC State's next three opponents are set. Should the Wolfpack advance past Wake Forest Tuesday at noon, the Pack will play Duke Wednesday afternoon. A win over Duke on Wednesday would put the Pack into a Thursday afternoon game against No. 4 seed Notre Dame.

5. NC STATE-WAKE FOREST, EPISODE 244

In its basketball history, the Pack has neither played nor beaten any team any team more than Wake Forest. Tuesday's tournament game will be the 244th meeting between the two schools, with NC State holding a 140-103 edge. The two rivals, located 104 miles apart, have played at least twice each year since the 1910-11 season except in 1929. This is the first time since 2006 NC State and Wake Forest will be meeting on a neutral court. Wake edged the Pack 82-71 in the 2006 ACC Tournament in Greensboro. The two teams also played in the 2005 ACC Tournament in Washington, D.C., with the Wolfpack winning 81-65.

- Won more games in his first 2 seasons with the Pack (48) than any coach in school history except Everett Case (55) in 1947 and 1948.
- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only 7 active coaches have taken 3 different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed 4 McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive NCAA tourney trips (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Voted 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.
- His 2003-04 Alabama squad advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, the longest tourney run in school history.

3 Seasons at Murray State (68-24 overall)

- Won an OVC title in each of his 3 seasons and was OVC Coach of the Year all 3 seasons.
- Led Murray State to 3 postseason appearances, including a pair of NCAA tourney berths.
- His 1997-98 team earned the highest NCAA seed in OVC history (#9 seed).

TOURNEY TIME IN THE NATION'S CAPITAL

This is the fifth time the Washington, D.C. area has hosted the ACC tourney. The event was held in Landover, Md., three times and once in Washington, D.C. In 1987, the Wolfpack was the No. 6 seed in Landover and **won three games to capture the league tournament title**. The last time the tournament was in Washington, D.C., was in 2005 and the Pack advanced to the semifinal before falling to Duke.

23 PPG / 4.5 RPG / 4.0 APG IN THE ACC

Cat Barber would be the second player in ACC history - joining Georgia Tech great Kenny Anderson - to average 23 ppg, 4.0 rpg and 4.0 apg in a season (assists became official stat in 1984):

CAT KEEPS GOING AND GOING

Cat Barber leads the ACC in minutes played and has been on the floor for 95.9 percent of NC State's available minutes, which **ranks second-highest in the nation**. Barber has **played 39 minutes or more in 22 games** and hasn't come out of 14 contests this season.

AT THE LINE SHOOTING 2...CAT BARBER

Wake Forest coach Danny Manning wasn't lying when he called Cat Barber a "tough cover." On Feb. 13, Barber slashed and darted around the Demon Deacons to the tune of 17-for-20 free throw shooting, including 17-for-18 in the second half. Barber has made 226 foul shots this season, a new single-season NC State record. His 226 made foul shots ranks fourth in the nation.

7TH IN THE NATION

Cat Barber ranks eighth in the nation in scoring and second among all players playing for Power 5 schools. **Only Buddy Hield of Oklahoma** (25.1) averages more points than Barber.

RECORD-BREAKING WOLFPACK

Sammy Ranzino made 224 foul shots in 1950-51, and that record stood until Cat Barber beat that mark with 226 this season. BeeJay Anya now owns 208 career blocked shots, passing Thurl Bailey's mark of 207 blocks. Anya collected his 208th block at the 12:53 mark in the second half against Boston College, his 99th career game.

STORIED CONFERENCE TOURNEY HISTORY

When the ACC was born, NC State was in charge. The Pack won the first three ACC titles (1954-56) and four of the first six. The ACC Tournament was held in Raleigh for the first 13 years of its existence. NC State has 10 ACC Tournament titles in its history, the last coming in 1987.

CAT'S CAREER

Cat Barber now has **1,427 career points**, lifting him to 20th in NC State history. He needs 40 points to tie Scott Wood for 18th on State's all-time list. Barber is **sixth among active players (and tops among non-seniors)** in the ACC in career scoring. He is also ninth in school history in career assists.

GOTTFRIED'S FIRST TEAMERS

With Cat Barber being voted first team All-ACC, NC State has now had **three first team all-league players** under Mark Gottfried. Richard Howell (2013), T.J. Warren (2014) and Barber have all been voted as first teamers. NC State had zero first team All-ACC players from 2005-2012.

CAT vs. WAKE FOREST

In six career games against Wake Forest, Cat Barber has averaged 20.8 points with .410 shooting from 3-point range. Barber began his sophomore-season renaissance with a standout 28-point effort last year. His career best of 38 points came in State's 99-88 win over Wake Forest last month.

"IN EVERY GAME"

After the game at Cameron Indoor, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski said Cat Barber "gives them a chance to win every game." Despite being 5-13 in league play, the Pack has been competitive almost every night. NC State has four league losses by five or fewer points.

LENNARD'S THE MAN OF STEEL

Lennard Freeman, a starter for 15 games, had successful surgery in May, and now has a **14-inch rod inserted in his lower right leg** to heal a fracture. He has a recurring stress reaction in his leg and will be available to play, but limited.

ACADEMIC ALL-ACC

Maverick Rowan, third on the team with 12.5 points per game, was voted Academic All-ACC this year. Rowan is the first Pack player in seven years to be academic all-league (Johnny Thomas, 2009).

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya has **lost nearly 75 pounds** since enrolling at NC State in 2013. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded for a non-7-foot player in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects. Only 7-6 Mamadou N'Diaye (UC-Irvine) has a longer listed wingspan.

THEY SHOULD STILL BE IN HIGH SCHOOL

Maverick Rowan, a 6-7 freshman wing, and reserve Shaun Kirk should both be preparing for their high school prom. Rowan and Kirk both classified up to the 2015 class, and could both be competing in high school ball.

'ROWAN-ISIMO'

Maverick Rowan, second on NC State in scoring as a freshman, is the son of Ron Rowan, who played in the 1980s for Notre Dame and St. John's and had a long pro career overseas. Maverick's family lived in Italy until Maverick was eight years old.

FIRST 'W' WHEN DOWN AT HALF

Down 35-31 at the half, NC State defeated Boston College on Wednesday night. It was the **first time this season the Pack overcame a halftime deficit to win**. The last time NC State trailed at half and won was in the 2015 NCAA Tournament against LSU.

BUZZER BEATERS

NC State won two games on buzzer beaters this season. Cat Barber hit a '3' at the horn to lift the Wolfpack past High Point in December. Against Boston College, Maverick Rowan made a lay-up as time expired to give the Pack its fifth ACC win.

WINNING LIKE IT'S THE 70s

Not since the NC State glory days of David Thompson has NC State won like it has the last four seasons. The Wolfpack was **92-52 in Gottfried's first four seasons**, which is the program's **highest win total for a four-year span since the Pack won 100 games from 1972-76**.

WOLFPUUPS GAINING EXPERIENCE

The experience gained this season by the young Wolfpack squad could pay dividends for the program's future. According to the popular basketball metrics website KenPom.com, the **Wolfpack stands as the 305th most-experienced team** (or 46th least-experienced) in the country. The team, when minutes played are weighted by each player's eligibility class, averages just 1.27 years of experience. The national average is 1.70 and the average experience of the 15-team ACC is 1.48.

NC State jumped from 25th nationally in 2014 to 12th last season in average men's basketball attendance. More than 300,000 Wolfpackers crossed the turnstiles at PNC Arena last season, the highest total since the building opened for the 1999-00 season. Notably, **the Pack saw the nation's largest attendance increase**, jumping from an average of 15,043 to 16,299.

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PACK ADDS TOP PG DENNIS SMITH, JR.

NC State gained some momentum for the future when it signed Dennis Smith, Jr., the nation's top point guard, to a National Letter of Intent. Smith, from Fayetteville, N.C. is ranked fourth in the Class of 2016 by both ESPN.com and Rivals, sixth by 247Sports.com and eighth by Scout. Smith averaged 22.2 points per game as a junior at Trinity Christian School last year. Smith has enrolled at NC State and is with the Pack full-time now.

GOTTFRIED SIGNS EXTENSION

On the day of his fifth season at the school, Mark Gottfried and NC State announced a new contract that will keep the coach in Raleigh through the 2019-20 season. Gottfried's annual compensation increased from \$2.06 million to \$2.48 million.

OUT 3 MONTHS...AND A YEAR

Originally thought to be out for 6-8 weeks, Saturday will mark three months since Terry Henderson injured his ankle during the season opener. Henderson tore a ligament in his ankle seven minutes into the season, meaning he played just seven minutes after sitting out the 2014-15 season.

FOUR HALL OF FAME VICTORIES

Last season, in addition to the team's run to the Sweet 16, the Wolfpack defeated four coaches who are currently members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Victories over Duke and Syracuse at home and road wins at UNC Chapel Hill and Louisville made Mark Gottfried the nation's only coach to own four wins over Hall of Fame coaches last season.

WOLFPACK STAYS 3 STRIPE

Just as this basketball season tipped off, NC State Athletics announced a six-year extension with apparel company Adidas. The contract, which runs to July 2022, is worth \$38.7 million in footwear, apparel and other financial considerations.

NC STATE AND THE PROGRAM

When NC State had the instructors from The Program come to campus this fall, the Wolfpack players pushed themselves mentally and physically to their limits. At the end of the grueling two days, it was Caleb Martin who the instructors dubbed 'The Spartan Warrior'. Martin was lauded as the team's best leader during the two days and demonstrated teamwork and mental and physical toughness.

THE PROGRAM

Here are some of the physical activities the Wolfpack did with the military instructors from The Program:

- different series of exercises and drills conducted in perfect precision
- drills involving 50-lb. sandbags and 7-foot-long poles
- fireman-carry suicides for 21-, 41- and 61-yard lengths done only with teammate instruction
- individual and team drills in the pool beginning at 4 a.m.



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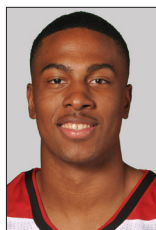
WHAT DID WE LOSE FROM LAST YEAR?

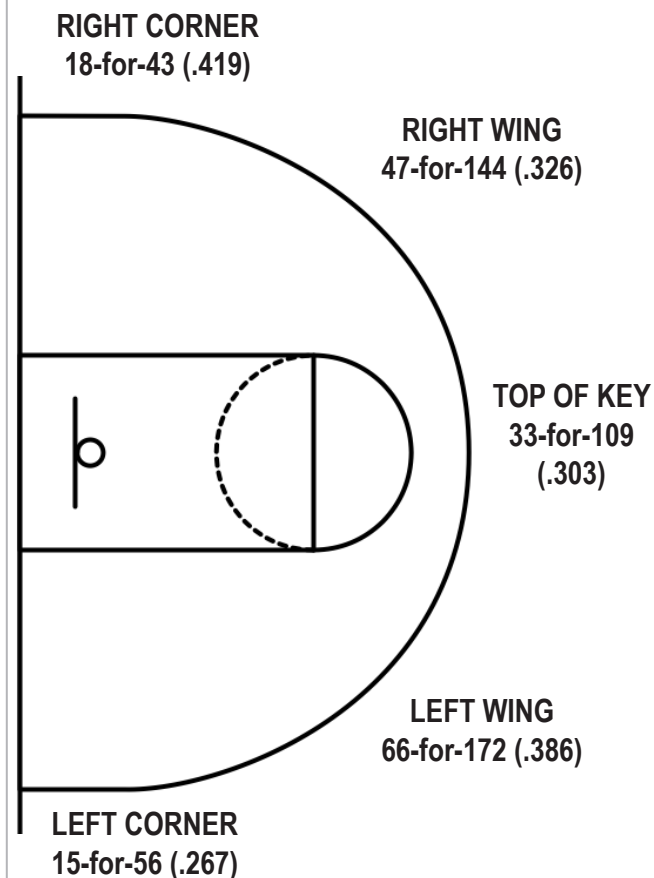

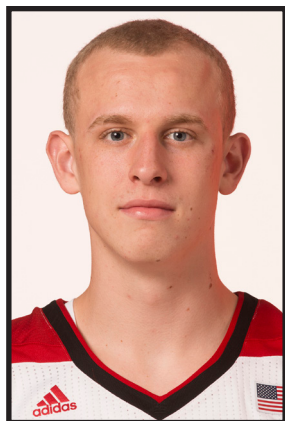
